Upon arrival of the first aid, the victim who was in the vehicle, was removed and attended to by medical personnel. At this time, the subject was identified as Edward Hept of 41 Calliope Rd., Sayreville, N.J., DOB 11-27-67. At the same time other workers were attempting to remove the driver, who was identified as [REDACTED] 2 Joanne Court, Sayreville, N.J. DOB 5-14-71, from underneath the vehicle. Once removed, the driver was airlifted by helicopter to Robert Wood Johnson Hospital. Mr. Hept was transported by S.E.S. to South Amboy Hospital where he was pronounced dead at 2218 hrs. Upon arrival of Ptl. Gottstine and Inv. Rich Leatherow of the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office, this officer assisted with the investigation. Found in the vehicle was a 6-pack carrier (empty) from Budweiser beer along with broken beer bottles in and around the vehicle. Investigation showed the vehicle was travelling east on Cheesequake Rd. and for no apparent reason left the roadway, travelling approximately 35' sideways before striking a tree and rolling over onto same. Apparently at this time, [REDACTED] was ejected from the vehicle. The vehicle then went back onto its wheels, pinning the subject under the left front tire. There were no skid or tire marks on the roadway. Also when this officer arrived on the scene the vehicle's headlights were on and the ignition was on but the vehicle was not running. This officer shut off both the lights and the ignition to prevent any possible hazards. After clearing the scene, this officer accompanied Ptl. Gottstine and Inv. Leatherow to Robert Wood Johnson Hospital. At this time the driver was in X-ray however these officers were advised that the victim was suffering from internal head injuries as well as lung injuries and a fractured left scapula. As these officers were leaving the hospital we spoke with Mr. & Mrs. Lukowitz who stated that their son had left the residence at approximately 1915 hours this date, 2-10-93 to pick up a friend identified as Scott Conover from work at Home Depot. After speaking with Mr. & Mrs. Lukowitz these officers cleared the hospital. Vehicle was towed by Sayreville Auto Body. For further information regarding this incident refer to reports of Ptl. Anderson and Ptl. Gottstine.
