On 3/24/2026 at 1929 hours, I reported to Police Headquarters to take a walk in report regarding a neighbor dispute. Upon arrival, I spoke with the reporting party, Brittany Zultanky, in the front lobby. Brittany		



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explained that she has been having ongoing issues with her neighbors at 189 Main St. Rennie Desantis and Rennie Desantis Jr. Brittany explained that during the last snowstorm, Rennie and Rennie Jr. would push the snow that she shoveled back in front of her driveway. Brittany stated that they did this twice after she entered her residence and came back out to shovel again. Brittany added that she believes Rennie Jr. turns on the gas-powered leaf blower at 7am just to harass her. I advised Brittany on the process of signing a complaint with the court and supplied her with a business card. I also showed Brittany the self-reporting system on the Sayreville Police Department website if these issues were to continue. Nothing further.

OFFICER REPORT NARRATIVE		
On June 18, 2025 approximately 1957 hours, I, Ptl. Salvatore, was dispatched to police headquarters for a walk-in report of harassment. Upon arrival, I met with Brittany Zultanky, the resident of 193 Main Street. Brittany advised she feels harassed by her neighbors at 189 Main Street, one of whom is identified as Rennie DeSantis. According to Brittany, she purchased her house in early 2023 and since approximately June 2023, these same neighbors have been giving her issues. Brittany advised the neighbors have called the police and/or CODE Enforcement on her and her family numerous times since they moved in and every time the police or CODE Enforcement		



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respond, the complaints are unfounded.

It should also be noted, Brittany advised the state of the yard at 189 Main Street has attracted rodents and pests to her yard, despite numerous efforts to curb the issue, including building a fence around her yard.

Another issue Brittany raised is having to walk her 8-year-old son to Borough Hall Park, approximately four houses down because the neighbors at 189 Main Street yell obscenities at her and her family. Due to this, she is concerned they may cause an issue or due harm to her son if he is left alone.

Furthermore, the issue that Brittany wanted to report today was that the neighbor has been posting on Facebook stating that she and her family are using a plastic decoy owl to film children inside of 189 Main Street, calling Brittany a pedophile. They also claimed that the owl is being used to starve the area birds and squirrels. It should be noted, Brittany stated the owl is just a decoy, there is no camera and furthermore it is being used to keep birds from defecating on her vehicles, not to starve any animals.

Brittany advised the totality of the issues has caused her annoyance and inconvenience.

An evidence.com link was sent to Brittany to upload screenshots, photos or anything else related to the harassment claims. As of the completion of this report, nothing had been uploaded to evidence.com. I also provided Brittany with a case number and advised her on the process to retrieve a copy of her report and sign her own complaints against the neighbors.

Nothing further at this time.
