NARRATIVE
SYNOPSIS: The following report will detail this writer's participation during the execution of a Court authorized search warrant for the vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM. DETAILS: On Wednesday, November 5th, 2025, I, as well as other members of the Barnegat Police Crime Reduction Unit (CRU), assisted in the execution of a Court authorized search warrant for the vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM. Subsequent to the search warrant execution, I was deemed Custodian of Evidence (COE). Present during the searches were Sgt. Nowak, Det. Martinez, Det. Halliday, Det. Moran, and I of the Barnegat Police Department. Det. Martinez was the Applicant for the search warrant. All officer's had Body Worn Cameras (BWC's) which were recording and in good working order. A search of vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM was conducted, and the following items were recovered as evidence: 1. Loose rock / powder located between the drivers seat and the center console, found by Det. Martinez (SW #1)....

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2. One (1) backpack containing two (2) bags containing loose rock / powder, one (1) straw, one (1) pill bottle containing approximately fifty (50) round grey pills marked "A 215", one (1) pill bottle containing approximately eleven (11) blue oval pills marked "GG 258", approximately thirty (30) white rectangle pills marked "Y 21", and one (1) bag containing approximately fifteen (15) round grey pills marked "A 215", located in the backseat, found by Det. Martinez (SW #2).

3. One (1) pill container containing approximately nine (9) round grey pills marked "A 215", located in the center console, found by Det. Halliday (SW #3).

4. Two (2) credit cards marked "Michael Kahlbom" located in the back pack mentioned in SW#2, photographed and left on scene (SW #4).

5. One (1) black iPhone in a black case located on the drivers side floorboard, found by Det. Martinez (SW #5).

6. One (1) round grey pill marked "A 215" located in the wallet mentioned in SW#2 and SW#4, found by Det. Simko (SW #6).

I took and retained custody of all items seized. Copies of the search warrant and search warrant return were left in the vehicle (See attached search warrant return for further information). Utilizing the Drugs.com Pill Identifier tool I positively identified the approximately seventy five (75) round grey pills marked "A 215" (suspect oxycodone hydrochloride) as suspect oxycodone hydrochloride, the approximately eleven (11) blue oval pills marked "GG 258" (suspect alprazolam 1mg) as alprazolam 1mg, and the approximately thirty (30) white rectangular pills marked "Y 21" (suspect alprazolam 2mg) as alprazolam 2mg. Utilizing a field test kit I positively identified the loose rock powder (suspect cocaine) as cocaine. The drug evidence was initialed, dated, packaged, sealed, photographed and placed into the Evidence Room, pending transportation to the OC CSI Lab for analysis.

NARRATIVE
SYNOPSIS: The following report will detail this writer's participation during the execution of a Court authorized search warrant for a 2020 Land Rover bearing NJ REG: GN56RM, as well as the arrest of Michael Kahlbom for possession of cocaine, possession of oxycodone, possession of oxycodone with the intent to distribute, possession of alprazolam (2 counts), possession of alprazolam with the intent to distribute (2 counts), and possession of drug paraphernalia (1533 S 2025 335). DETAILS: On November 5th, 2025, at approximately 1300 hours, a briefing was held at the Barnegat Township Police Department. Present at the briefing were Sgt. Nowak, Det. Simko, Det. Halliday, Det. Moran, and I of the Barnegat Police Crime Reduction Unit (CRU). At this briefing, it was explained that I was granted a search warrant by the Honorable David Fritch J.S.C., for a 2020 Land Rover bearing NJ REG: GN56RM. It should be noted, the aforementioned vehicle was seized on November 4th, 2025, and was currently secured inside the secured Impound Sally Porte of the Barnegat Township Police Department. Additionally, Det. Simko was assigned as Custodian of Evidence. At this time, Sgt. Nowak, Det. Simko, Det. Halliday, Det. Moran and I activated our BWC's, which remained...

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activated during the duration of the execution of the search warrant. I executed the search warrant on the vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM, at approximately 1317 hours. Members of CRU conducted a systematic search of the vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM and located a quantity of suspect cocaine, approximately thirty (30) white rectangle pills marked "Y 21" (suspect alprazolam 2mg), approximately sixty five (65) round blue pills marked "A 215" (suspect oxycodone), approximately eleven (11) blue oval pills marked "GG 258" (suspect alprazolam 1mg), as well as one straw containing residue (suspect cocaine). Refer to Det. Simko's Custodian of Evidence Report for further details.

Upon completion of the search, the vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM was secured at approximately 1407 hours. The vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM was then towed by Jersey Shore Towing to their secured impound lot. Additionally, a copy of the search warrant, as well as a copy of the search warrant return were left inside the vehicle. Refer to Investigative Report for additional information.

Soon after the completion of the search of the vehicle and the discovery of the listed evidence seized, I along with Det. Simko and Det. Halliday responded to 5 Sloop Court, Barnegat NJ and placed Kahlbom under arrest in reference to the evidence located. Ptl. Amirr arrived on scene and assisted with transport.

I placed Kahlbom in hand cuffs (double locked) and searched his person with nothing of evidential value recovered. Kahlbom was secured and seat belted in the rear of Ptl. Amirr's patrol vehicle and transported to the Barnegat Police Department. An inspection of the rear compartment of the patrol vehicle was done prior to and after his removal.

At the Barnegat Police Department, Kahlbom was secured in a visually and physically inspected holding cell #1. An Individual Property Inventory form was completed, and all property was secured in an individual Property Locker. Kahlbom was processed as per departmental policy and procedure.

Kahlbom was served with a complaint / summons for possession of cocaine, possession of oxycodone, possession of oxycodone with the intent to distribute, possession of alprazolam (2 counts), possession of alprazolam with the intent to distribute (2 counts). and possession of drug paraphernalia (1533 S 2025 335). Kahlbom was then released from custody.

NARRATIVE SYNOPSIS: The following report will detail this writer's participation during the motor vehicle stop of the vehicle bearing NJ REG: GN56RM, being operated by Michael Kahlbom, and the arrest of Daniel Woods for contempt of court (W#A49324 - \$550.00 and W#E25701 - \$500.00) DETAILS: On Tuesday, November 4th, 2025, I along with Det. Simko and Det. Moran, of the Barnegat Police Department Crime Reduction Unit (CRU), acting in an undercover capacity were conducting surveillance in the area of Bowline Street / Nautilus Avenue, an area known for CDS activity. More specifically, members of CRU have executed numerous Court authorized search warrants on residences on Bowline Street, Nautilus Avenue, and Sextant Drive, as well as numerous street operations in that specific neighborhood where CDS was ultimately recovered. Members of CRU observed the following: A black Land Rover bearing NJ REG: GN56RM (herein referred to as the captioned vehicle) occupied by an individual I positively identified as Michael Kahlbom as it was traveling through the intersection of Bowline Street and Nautilus Avenue. It should be noted members of CRU are aware of Kahlbom as a known distributor of CDS. More specifically, during the month of May 2024, members of the CRU were contacted by detectives of the Ocean County Prosecutors Office Narcotics Strike Force, advising they have received C.I. information from a C.I. who has previously been proven reliable that identified Kahlbom as a distributor of cocaine. Subsequently, surveillance was initiated on Kahlbom and the captioned vehicle. Det. Simko was positioned behind the captioned vehicle as it traveled from Village Drive to Barnegat Blvd. As the vehicle proceeded to make a left turn onto Barnegat Blvd from Village Ave, the captioned vehicle failed to utilize a turn signal as it made the left turn. Additionally, while traveling on Barnegat Blvd near Bayside Ave, the vehicle failed to maintain its lane of travel on two (2) separate occasions as both the vehicle's...

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front and rear passenger side tires crossed completely over the fog line and proceeded to travel in the shoulder of the roadway for approximately three (3) seconds before returning to its correct lane of travel. It should be noted, I did not observe any obstructions in the roadway in the aforementioned area, nor did any other vehicles traveling in that area fail to maintain its lane of travel.

The captioned vehicle traveled directly to the parking lot of Nationwide Insurance Company, located on Rt. 9 in Lacey, NJ where the vehicle parked and I observed the following: Kahlbom exited the vehicle and entered the business. There were three (3) individuals that appeared to be standing at the businesses front door awaiting Kahlbom's arrival. Kahlbom quickly exited the business then handed an unknown white male (FNU LNU #1) an unknown object(s) in return for an unknown object(s) which he received from FNU LNU #1. FNU LNU #2 approached Kahlbom and handed him an additional unknown object(s) at which time Kahlbom began to scan the immediate area, in a possible attempt to detect any onlookers / police presence and then look down at and manipulate the object(s). Kahlbom opened the rear drivers side door of the captioned vehicle and proceeded to put the unknown object(s) in the rear driver's side seat of his vehicle. Furthermore, Kahlbom opened the rear hatch of his vehicle and began manipulating unknown objects while reaching into the rear area of the captioned vehicle as he again continued to scan the area. A short time later, Kahlbom entered the driver's seat of his captioned vehicle as an unknown Hispanic male entered the passenger side of the captioned vehicle. The vehicle then proceeded to leave the area as it traveled on Rt 9 southbound into Barnegat Township. It should be further noted, the captioned vehicle had tint on the front side driver's and passenger side windows. The tint was dark enough that I was unable to see through the side windows to see inside of the vehicle or a silhouette of persons inside of the vehicle.

At this time, this Det. Simko executed a motor vehicle stop on the captioned vehicle for failure to maintain lane and improper tint violations. Det. Simko made contact with Kahlbom (driver) and the front passenger, who members of CRU positively identified as Daniel Woods at that time. It should be noted, members of CRU are aware of Woods as a known user / distributor of CDS. More specifically, members of CRU, as well as myself, have arrested Woods on multiple occasions for CDS possession / distribution offenses in the past. More specifically, Woods was arrested by members of this department approximately six (6) times for CDS related offenses during the years of 2015, 2017 (3 separate incidents), 2018 and 2021.

Present at the time of the motor vehicle stop was Det. Simko, Det. Moran, and Sgt. Nowak. Officers on scene identified themselves as police officers with badges visibly hanging around our necks from raid chains. In addition, all officer's body worn cameras (BWCs) were activated during the interaction.

Det. Simko advised Kahlbom of the aforementioned motor vehicle violations and Kahlbom apologized, advising that he was eating a pretzel and became distracted. Det. Simko requested dispatch to check both individuals for warrants and dispatch replied, advising Woods had two (2) active arrest warrants out of Ocean Township and Barnegat Township (W#A49324 - \$550.00 and W# E25701 - \$500.00).

I requested Kahlbom to exit the vehicle and Kahlbom complied. I advised Kahlbom of the observed suspicious activity who advised he was moving items into his office. I requested to conduct a consent search of the captioned vehicle, which Kahlbom denied. I then explained to Kahlbom that a K9 will be requested to conduct an exterior sniff of the vehicle for the presence of narcotics odor. Subsequently, Det. Wiatrowski, of the Stafford Police Drug Enforcement Unit (DEU) arrived on scene with his K9 partner Venus. Utilizing his K9 partner, Det. Wiatrowski conducted an open-air sniff of the exterior of the captioned vehicle for the presence of narcotics odor. After the sniff was complete, Det. Wiatrowski advised that his K9 partner Venus gave a positive indication for the presence of the odor of narcotics. Refer to Det. Wiatrowski's supplemental k9 report for additional details.

I advised Kahlbom of his Miranda Rights, which Kahlbom verbally related he understood and was willing to speak with officers. An interview was conducted with Kahlbom, from Miranda on, who related the following: There is a two (2) mg Xanax pill in the back passenger seat which he does not have a prescription for. This is the only CDS inside the vehicle. Based on my training, education and experience, suspects will not tell the truth of the amount of the CDS at the location and suspects will downplay the quantity of CDS in an attempt to thwart law enforcement from continuing their CDS investigation. Furthermore, K9 Venus is imprinted on various types of narcotics, however Xanax (alprazolam) is not one of the imprints. This further leads me to believe there is further CDS inside of the vehicle and/or on the person of Kahlbom. Due to the probable cause provided by the positive K9 indication on the captioned vehicle, Kahlbom's admission that there was alprazolam within the vehicle which he did not have a prescription for, and the necessity to prevent the disappearance of evidence as well as the insufficient time to obtain a search warrant for Kahlbom's person, I conducted search

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of Kahlbom's person which yielded nothing of evidentiary value.

Sgt. Cranmer arrived on scene to assist with transport.

Woods was placed under arrest, in reference to his outstanding warrants. I conducted a search of Woods, yielding negative results. Woods was secured in hand cuffs (double locked) by Det. Moran. Woods was secured and seat belted in the rear of Sgt. Cranmer's patrol vehicle. A visual and physical inspection of the vehicle was done prior to and after his removal. Sgt. Cranmer was then transported Woods to the Barnegat Police Department.

I advised Kahlbom that his vehicle is impounded pending application for a search warrant and Kahlbom advised he understood. Ptl. Summer's of BTPD responded to the scene and provided Kahlbom with a transport back to his residence.

Subsequently, Jersey Shore Towing responded on scene and took possession of the captioned vehicle, which was towed to the secure holding facility of the Barnegat Township Police Department pending application for a search warrant. Det. Simko followed the tow truck transporting the captioned vehicle, which was ultimately secured in this agencies impound Sally Porte.

At the Barnegat Police department, Woods was secured in a visually and physically inspected holding cells #1. Woods was processed as per departmental policy and procedure. Woods received ROR's for both of the aforementioned arrest warrants and was given a copy of same with new court dates. Woods signed same and both were returned to their respective courts via email. Woods was released on his own recognizance and given a ride to his residence. Stafford Police Communications Bureau handled all necessary teletypes concerning the warrants.
