On November 8, 2008 at 1857 hrs, Ofc. S. Dessicino was dispatched to 108 N. Iowa Ave. in reference to a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, we were met by the victim, later identified as [REDACTED] who was bleeding from the mouth and nose. There was a strong language barrier. We advised Ofc. Vadell, who came to the scene to translate.

[REDACTED] had been in a fight with her boyfriend. He was identified as Emiliano Carrillo. He was described as a tall, heavy set hispanic male with a light complexion. He was wearing blue shorts and a black short sleeve shirt and had left the scene 10 minutes prior to our arrival.

[REDACTED] stated that she wanted to sign a complaint on Mr. Carrillo. I then transported her down to the Detective Bureau and the case was turned over to Det. P. Aristizabal.

On this date of November 8, 2008 Officer Shelly Dessicino brought in victim [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] in regards to a Domestic Assault. Officer Dessicino explained that the victim does not speak English and the Suspect, identified as Emiliano Carrillo, had fled the scene.

Detective Paul Aristizabal then translated for the undersigned at which time the victim explained that her boyfriend of (2) months whom she resides with, Emiliano Carrillo, came home intoxicated. While home her boyfreind continued to drink. According to the victim she told the Suspect Carrillo to stop drinking or she was going to leave, however he continued to drink. The victim then told Detective Aristizabal that her boyfriend then punched her in the face (3) times and left the premises.

The victim then told Aristizabal that she then called the Police. The victim stated that neighbors had also come over to her apartment to see if she was okay and had heard the argueing. The victim then told Aristizabal that she grabbed her 3 year old son, [REDACTED] and left the premises. According to the victim her boyfriend is a Dishwasher at Bally's Park Place at Johnny Rockets. She explained that she is not employed.

The victim at this time did not want a Restraining Order, however she did state that she would be staying [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] This writer then photographed the injury to the victims lip, which has been marked NK08-146011 for identification purposes and placed into Property and Evidence. Copies of the photos have been made for the case file for review.

The victim was then taken [REDACTED] to get her belongings by Officer Dessicino. A wanted Warrant was then issued for the arrest of Emiliano Carrillo for simple assault.
