Investigation Narrative

On August 1st, 2018 at approximately 0036 hrs, I responded to Donovan's Restaurant at 1900 SH 70, for the report of an unconscious male in the restroom. Upon arrival with Manchester First Aid personnel I observed a male, later identified as [1], lying on his side supported by patrons who were rendering aid. [2] breathing was agonal and his pupils were constricted indicating an overdose on heroin or other opiate based CDS. I administered a 2mg dose of Nalaxone into [3] nostrils while EMS personnel continued to treat and evaluate his condition. MONOC paramedics responded and assisted Manchester First Aid in treating the patient. They administered additional doses of Nalaxone intravenously and [4] became responsive shortly thereafter. When asked, he did not say what he had ingested. [5] was transported to Community Medical Center for further treatment. No CDS or paraphernalia were recovered from the restroom or from [6] person.

While on scene I spoke to a male identified as [7]. [8] stated that he first observed [9] lying unresponsive on the restroom floor with his head extending out from under the stall. After a failed attempt to wake him, [10] sought assistance from other patrons and the restaurant staff called 911. [11] further advised that he observed [] sitting at the bar by himself prior to entering the restroom and did not see anyone enter afterwards.

I completed the NJ Attorney General's Nalaxone Administration Reporting form and forwarded it to the designated recipients as per policy.
