145. Crash Description/Narrative

The driver of vehicle one, Randy Nesbitt, was backing from a parking space, located at Wawa, 418 West Rio Grande Avenue. Vehicle one was backing West bound from the parking space. The driver of vehicle two, Ryan Hodder, was backing from a parking space, also located at Wawa, 418 West Rio Grande Avenue. Vehicle two was backing East bound from the parking space.

The driver of vehicle one stated as he was backing from the parking space when he heard a vehicles horn, then a bang. Vehicle one had collided with vehicle two. Vehicle one sustained scratches to the rear bumper.

The driver of vehicle two stated she had begun to back from the parking space, when she observed vehicle one also begin to back from a parking space. The driver of vehicle one stated she had begun backing first, and stopped when she observed vehicle one begin to back from the parking space. The driver of vehicle one then sounded vehicle ones horn, but vehicle one continued backing, and collided with vehicle two. Vehicle two sustained minor damage, with scratches and dents to the rear bumper and rear hatch/tailgate.
