window of his vehicle, NJ/SAH67L, had been broken by someone throwing a rock. Mr. Eosso stated that the window was broken sometime between 1930 hrs and 2100 hrs while he was coaching a football game. This officer observed the rear window of the vehicle which was completely broken out and a small rock in the back of the vehicle. Mr. Eosso stated that he was told by Sunshine Johnston that [REDACTED] had information about who may have thrown the rock. [REDACTED] told his mother that his friend [REDACTED] had seen a blonde hair boy throw the rock at the window. Mr. Eosso stated that he was going to attempt to speak with the parents of children that were present to get more information.

On the above date and time I was dispatched in unit 16 to 2 Allison Court to Assist a Citizen.

Upon arrival I met with the callers, Linda and Timothy Eosso. Mrs.

Eosso explained that at approximately 2000 hrs this evening [REDACTED] was conversing with a subject by the name "superbowl.studios" on Instagram. Mrs. Eosso stated that [REDACTED] and the subject were trading "skins" for football player backgrounds. Mrs. Eosso stated that the subject sent a striped background and then a picture of a young black female cheerleader to [REDACTED]. Mrs. Eosso stated that [REDACTED] responded "what the hell" but it was in response to the striped background that he did not like, not the photo of the cheerleader. Mrs. Eosso stated that the subject became upset and told [REDACTED] that the girl in the photo was someone named "Shanell" who was going through a tough time because her mother "Mrs. Daneuryius" died. The subject told [REDACTED] that he felt disrespected and threatened to report him to the group supervisor if he didn't re post a picture of Shanell with the hash tag #ripmrstdaneuryius. [REDACTED] apologized and explained that he did not mean to be disrespectful. The subject then stated that he was thinking about showing what [REDACTED] wrote to his discussion group unless he re posted the picture.

Later in the conversation the subject tells [REDACTED] that he reported him to the group. He then tells [REDACTED] that they calculated his location to be in New Jersey and are deciding whether or not to come "have a talk." Mrs. Eosso stated that the last message sent by the subject stated that they knew he was near Schoolhouse Road in Monroe. Mrs. Eosso stated that she then deleted [REDACTED] Instagram account. See attached screen shots of the Instagram conversation. Mrs. Eosso stated that she was unable to obtain a copy of the last message. Mrs. Eosso stated that they do not have any other information about the subject other than his user name.

Mrs. Eosso was concerned for their safety and did not know how the subject knew they were in Monroe or where Schoolhouse Road was. I explained to Mrs. Eosso that Monroe may have been obtained from one of [REDACTED] friend's profiles on Instagram. I further explained that when you Google Monroe on a map it focuses on the area of Thompson Park which Schoolhouse Road runs along on the south side near the Monroe Twp. High School. I advised Mrs. Eosso that if they are concerned for their safety they should keep all doors to their home locked and call 9-1-1 if any suspicious individuals come to their residence.

Mrs. Eosso and I then explained to [REDACTED] the dangers of talking to strangers on the Internet and emphasized that should be more careful in the future. I then provided Mrs. Eosso with a blue Citizen Information Card and explained the process for obtaining a copy of this report.

On the above date and time, Ofc. Brandt and I responded to the area of Dante Road regarding multiple 911 calls from 12 and 13 Dante Road. While responding, Ofc. Brandt and I were advised that there were approximately three to four males wearing black ringing the doorbells of the residences. Officers responding were also advised that the callers identified as Karen Bryan and Carol McGowan were scared after noticing the subjects on their property.

Upon arriving on Dante Road, I observed four juveniles identified as [REDACTED] running from my marked unit. Exiting the vehicle, I was able to observe the juveniles hop a fence (11 Verdi Road).

At 11 Verdi Road, I was given permission by the homeowner to enter the rear of her residence. In the backyard, I observed the juveniles and ordered them over. Asking the juveniles if they resided at 11 Verdi Road, they stated, "No". Ofc. Brandt and I then walked the juveniles to my patrol unit and they called their parents to come and pick them up.

The juveniles advised me that they only rang the doorbells at 12 and 13 Dante Road and stated that they were just playing, "Ding Dong Ditch". I was later able to determine that there wasn't any property damage to 12 and 13 Dante Road. They stated that they ran away from me because they didn't want to get in trouble.

The juveniles parents arrived on scene and I advised them of the incident. The juveniles were then turned over to their parents. I spoke with [REDACTED] identified as Agnes on the telephone and she stated it was okay that [REDACTED] father could take custody of [REDACTED] because she was stuck at work. After they signed off on juvenile report's, the children left the scene.

At 12 and 13 Dante Road, Ofc. Brandt and I spoke with the residents. They advised me that there didn't appear to be any damage to the property. Ofc. Brandt and I then cleared the scene.

On June 9th 2017 at approximately 1440 hours I was dispatched into the lobby of the Monroe Township Police Department for an assist citizen.

I spoke with the reporting person, Timothy Eosso, who wanted to speak to me about alleged improper acts by board members of the Monroe Township Diamond Club. Eosso went onto explain to me that the Monroe Township Diamond Club is made up of parents of Monroe Township High School

baseball players and other supporters. This Diamond Club is independent from the school, but is supposedly under the Booster Club.

Eosso had numerous emails and copies of by-laws for the organization. He expressed his frustrations about several things involving this organization. A lot of the things that we discussed were not criminal matters and we spoke in length about different options he and others can do to address their issues with the organization.

The main reason why Eosso came into headquarters on this date was to discuss an issue with a supposed purchase by the board and possible impropriety by the Treasurer, Mike Peto. Eosso stated that the treasurer's report for May 2017 noted an expense of \$810.00 for baseballs that Eosso stated are unaccounted for. He stated that himself and others have been trying to ascertain where the baseballs are and he feels that he is getting the run-around from the board. He stated that he and others have reached out to the school as well about these baseballs and still has not gotten a clear answer on where these baseballs are. Eosso stated that members of this Diamond Club give money to the organization and he wants to ensure that the organization is not improperly handling their funds. I spoke to Eosso in length about his allegations and went over options with him that he should do going forward that could reveal information that would either confirm or dispel his beliefs. Eosso agreed that he could inquire more at their next board meeting which is next week.

I gave Eosso a citizen information form and he left the lobby.

I cleared, no further information at this time.

On the above date and time I was dispatched to police headquarters to speak to a subject in the lobby in reference to a harassment complaint.

I arrived on location and met with Maria Facciponti, who stated that she received a harassing phone call. Facciponti explained that she is running for

PTO president. On this date, Facciponti received a call on her cell phone from a subject who identified himself as Timothy Eosso, who asked if Facciponti would speak to him about the PTO. Facciponti agreed to speak to Eosso, who began to tell Facciponti about all of the problems he has with the current PTO president. Eosso continued telling Facciponti that he feels the current vice president of the PTO should become the next president, and that Facciponti "better not run." Facciponti explained that Eosso was getting loud on the phone, which she felt was an attempt to intimidate her.

Facciponti explained that she was able to get a word in while Eosso was talking, and told him that she does not personally know the current board members. Eosso stopped, and began apologizing to Facciponti because he thought that the current PTO president was encouraging Facciponti to run against the current vice president.

Facciponti contacted the PTO after receiving the phone call from Eosso, and was advised to obtain a police report to document the incident. I asked Facciponti if she wanted me to contact Eosso, however she did not at this time. Facciponti stated that the PTO meeting was scheduled for April 17th, 2018, and if she encounters any further problems, she would contact this department again.

I provided Facciponti with a blue Citizen's Information Card containing information on how to obtain a copy of this report.

On the above date and time I responded to police headquarters and spoke with Rupa Siegel regarding what she explained as, cyber bullying.

Once speaking with Rupa in the interview room she explained that Timothy Eosso, a member of the Monroe Twp. Middle School PTO, posted an unflattering Facebook post, which she believes "defamed" her. Rupa expressed concern over the post because Timothy posted her real name, rather than referring to her as "PTO President" which is the position she currently holds. (See attached picture of post). Rupa explained that Timothy disagrees with her decision making which is why he is making posts involving her.

Rupa also explained that the PTO Vice President, Christine Skurbe, sent an e-mail to members of the PTO which contained content that was not true. Rupa believes this was sent because Christine is conspiring to have her removed as PTO President after disagreeing with decisions made within the organization. (See attached picture of e-mail).

At this time no physical threats have been made to any involved party and Rupa wished to document the incident incase things escalated. Rupa has also made the Superintendent and Principal of the Middle School aware of the situation and they plan on addressing the matter as well.

Rupa did not wish for this officer to contact any involved party at this time.

Prior to clearing the scene Rupa was provided with a Citizen's Information Card with the 2C charge for Cyber Harassment (2C:33-4.1) and explained on how to sign complaints via Municipal Court.

Scene cleared. No further information at this time.

On 09/18/2019 at approximately 1500 hours I was advised that the Siegel family was in the lobby of police headquarters looking to report a harassment between their son, [REDACTED] and an adult, Mr. Timothy Eosso.

Once I met with the Siegel's, I escorted them to the conference room so that I could obtain their statements in regards to this matter. I introduced myself to [REDACTED] (juvenile), Mrs. Rupa Siegel (mother) and Mr. Paul Siegel (father). I then asked Paul and Rupa if I was free to speak openly with [REDACTED] at this time. Both parties agreed to allow me to do so in their presence. I then asked [REDACTED] what had transpired, prompting him to report the incident to police headquarters.

At this time, prior to [REDACTED] advising me of his story, Paul asked if he could give me an abbreviated story of a decade of incidents that had occurred leading to the present situation. I agreed to allow Paul to tell me what has been transpiring.

Paul advised me that there has been on going tension between Timothy, other players on the baseball team and parents for numerous years. Paul also advised me that he has heard Timothy make anti-Semitic comments referring to his religion and has made comments about women of Indian decent being submissive towards men. This offended both Paul and Rupa due to the fact that Paul is Jewish and Rupa is of Indian decent. When I asked Paul what anti-Semitic comments Timothy has made to him in the past, he stated that Timothy has implied that [REDACTED] pays half price to play baseball because Paul "Jews" the price down. Paul went on to advise me that the main issue with [REDACTED] and Timothy arose last Spring baseball season. Paul advised me that Timothy's son, Lucas Eosso was removed

from the starting third base position and replaced by [REDACTED]. This made Timothy irate and an increased level of hostility towards [REDACTED] became noticeable.

At this time, Paul felt that he provided me with a sufficient background and advised [REDACTED] to proceed with the incident that occurred on 09/08/2019 at the Oak Tree Baseball Field.

[REDACTED] stated that the Monroe Township High School Baseball Team was playing a baseball game against the Belleville High School Baseball team. I was advised that certain parents were volunteering as coaches because due to NJSLAA rules, the High School coach cannot actually coach the team until the Spring season. During the game, Timothy was located just outside of the dugout, sitting on a five gallon bucket, observing the game. During the second inning of the baseball game, [REDACTED] advised me that he was warming up his batting swing just outside of the dugout in close proximity to Timothy. When [REDACTED] realizes that he will not be getting up to bat and his team is retaking the field, [REDACTED] walks towards Timothy to retrieve his baseball glove and [REDACTED] alleges that Timothy sticks his foot out in front of where [REDACTED] is walking in an attempt to trip [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] proceeds past Timothy and finishes the inning on the field.

At the bottom of the third inning, [REDACTED] advised me that Timothy approached him and stated, "People of your kind shouldn't act/speak like this". [REDACTED] also stated that Timothy called him a "cunt". [REDACTED] then called Timothy a "fucking asshole". At this time, Lucas hears that [REDACTED] calls his father a derogatory term and approaches [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that Lucas begins to push him with his hands in the face and chest. [REDACTED] alleges that he pushes Lucas off him. Once both parties are standing, [REDACTED] advised me that Lucas attempted to punch him. Due to the fact that numerous players are attempting to break the altercation up, Lucas did not effectively strike [REDACTED]. At this time all players are separated. [REDACTED] then sits on the dugout bench and while Timothy is leaving the dugout he calls [REDACTED] a "little faggot".

An exchange of words then ensues between Paul and Timothy outside of the dugout. Timothy approaches Paul and attempts to reprimand him because [REDACTED] called him a "fucking asshole". At no point did the exchange of words become physical and both parties were separated by other adults present.

I waited until all three parties provided me with all pertinent facts and ended the taped statement. (See DVD recording for further information).

At this time, I asked the Siegel's how they would like to pursue this matter. The Siegel's advised me that at this time, they would just like to have the incident documented which I agreed to do. Rupa and [REDACTED] then provided me with the names of three other juveniles who observed the altercation. I was also provided with the contact numbers of the parents for each individual.

I then provided Rupa and Paul with my business card with the case number of the incident written on the back of it. The Siegel's were then escorted out of police headquarters.

I proceeded to my office in an attempt to make contact with the other three witnesses of the incident: [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Once I was finished contacting all the parents of the witnesses, [REDACTED] was the only willing witness to provide me with a statement at this time.

On 09/18/2019 at approximately 1830 hours, I was advised that Mr. John Albrecht Sr. (John Sr.) and [REDACTED] were at police headquarters to provide me with a statement.

At 1836 hours, I began to take a statement from John Sr. and [REDACTED] John Sr. allowed me to speak freely with [REDACTED] in his presence in regards to this matter. During the course of the interview, [REDACTED] advised me of the tension between Timothy and [REDACTED] portrayed Timothy and Lucas as the aggressors in the incident that occurred on 09/08/2019. [REDACTED] also confirmed that Timothy called [REDACTED] numerous derogatory terms during the course of the game on 09/08/2019. During the interview John Sr. expressed that Timothy is also fabricating lies about him to other parents and is becoming noticeably more hostile towards him through text message. John Sr. began to show me an array of text messages from Timothy which I advised him to e mail to me so that I could attach them to this report. Once I felt that I had obtained all the pertinent and necessary facts from John Sr. and [REDACTED] I concluded the Interview. (See DVD recording for further information).

The Albrecht's were provided with my business card, with the incident number for this matter, and escorted out of police headquarters.

Once the Albrecht's left police headquarters, I completed a property report for both statements so that they could be logged as evidence.

This investigation continues pending the submission of any further

statements.

On the above date and time, I was dispatched to Police Headquarters for an assist citizen report.

Dispatch advised me that a male subject stated that false allegations were made against him and he wanted to report it.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the male subject identified as Timothy Eosso and his son Lucas Eosso. I then advised them to enter the Interview Room. I then asked Timothy what brought him to Police Headquarters and he stated that false allegations were made against him and he wants to report his side of the incident that took place on 09/08/19 at around 1130 hours at Applegarth School Baseball Field (see incident # 19030824). Linda Eosso arrived shortly thereafter at Police Headquarters to make statements as well.

Timothy then advised me that there has been ongoing tensions between his family and the Seigel family for a while. Timothy then stated that he was at the baseball game trying to assist the Monroe Baseball Team and he saw that [REDACTED] (juvenile) was swinging his bat near the dugout when the team rules are that the players are not supposed to swing the bat near the dugout. Timothy then stated that he told [REDACTED] "Bring your bat away from the dugout." Timothy then stated that he told [REDACTED] "I will bring your bat over to where it is supposed to be." Timothy then stated that [REDACTED] then stated, "Really why don't you get the fuck out of here."

Timothy then stated that he then told [REDACTED] you should not talk to an adult like that. Timothy then stated that his wife Linda Eosso then went to notify [REDACTED] dad identified as Paul Seigel that [REDACTED] was using profane words against Timothy and that she wanted Paul to talk to [REDACTED] about using profanity towards adults because it is not respectful nor is it tolerable. Linda then stated that while she was talking to Paul he stated that he would talk to [REDACTED] about the incident.

Lucas then stated that as he was watching Linda walk away it appeared as if Paul was not happy about Linda coming over to talk to him about [REDACTED] Lucas then stated that he then heard [REDACTED] say, "What a fucking asshole, get this guy out of here." Lucas then stated that he believed that [REDACTED] was referring those comments towards Timothy so he then confronted [REDACTED]

about it. Lucas then stated that he then put his hands on [REDACTED] chest and stated what did you say about my dad and [REDACTED] did not say anything. Lucas then stated that Timothy grabbed him and the team broke [REDACTED] and Lucas away from each other to prevent them from fighting. Lucas then stated that they later continued on with the game with no further problems.

Timothy then stated that he then advised the Baseball Head Coach identified as John Albrecht about what started the altercation between Lucas and [REDACTED] because he was not aware since he was busy coaching the game. Timothy then stated, "At no time did I ever call [REDACTED] a cunt." Timothy then stated, "At no time did I ever make Anti-Semitic comments about anyone which was reported in the previous incident report." Timothy then stated that at this time he just wanted to document that the allegations made against him in the previous incident (incident #19030824) were false.

I then provided Timothy with a Citizen's Information Card and advised him on how to retrieve a copy of this report.

Timothy stated the he wanted to file a report regarding Lucas being harassed by a fellow Monroe Recreation Basketball player, [REDACTED]. Timothy explained that they have known [REDACTED] and his father, Scott for sometime as Scott runs the recreation league. Lucas stated that there has been tension between him and [REDACTED] in the past which came to a head following a basketball game on 01/25/2020. After the game ended, in which [REDACTED] team lost against Lucas's team, the police were called due to the possibility of a fight between the teams. When this happened Lucas said to his teammates "You have to be a pussy to call the cops if are afraid of me." Lucas believes that [REDACTED] mother, Melissa Lebow, heard the comment because of her proximity to the conversation and told [REDACTED] what he said. Later that evening [REDACTED] allegedly posted a private story on his Snap Chat that Lucas could not see. A friend of Lucas's saw the story and sent the screen shot to Lucas. The story stated "1. ur the biggest fucking pussy ever 2. ur dad is fucking scared of my family 3. don't call me unsportsmanlike after u continue to taunt me u fucking shitfuck 4. don't EVER say anything to my fucking mom fucking dicklicker. don't fucking ever do that ever again. 5. don't blame me for having the cops be there bc i didn't fucking call them. ur the one that didn't want to fight which most likely means ur the one who fucking called them u premature fuck. 6. just go back to ur 3 fucking friends and have a nice little jerk circ" See attached copy of screen shot.

Timothy was concerned because he feels the Snap Chat story is being used to provoke a fight between Lucas and [REDACTED]. I asked Timothy if he would like me to contact [REDACTED] parents regarding this incident due to him being a juvenile. Timothy objected stating that he felt contacting [REDACTED] parents would only make the situation worse. Timothy stated he only wanted the incident documented at this time in case something happens in the future. I then explained the process for signing Juvenile Complaints for Harassment 2C:33-4. I provided Timothy with a blue Citizen Information and explained the process for obtaining a copy of this report.

Upon arrival, I was met by Melissa Lebow (parent), Scott Lebow (parent), and [REDACTED] (juvenile). Scott began speaking about an incident that occurred in January (see incident #20006624). Scott stated that Timothy Eosso (parent) and his son, Lucas Eosso (involved party), came into Headquarters and reported that [REDACTED] was harassing Lucas. Scott stated that he read the report and would like to give his side of the story of what transpired that day.

Scott began to tell me that the incident occurred on 01/24/2020, not 01/25/2020 as stated by Lucas in the previous report. Scott then stated that it was reported that police officers arrived after the basketball game had ended, which Scott stated was false. Scott, Melissa, and [REDACTED] agreed that there was a police presence prior to the game starting. Melissa then began to tell me that after Lucas made his comment, "You have to be a pussy to call the cops if you are afraid of me.", Lucas made another comment afterwards and stated to his friends, "Does he really need his mommy at the game?" Melissa stated that she heard Lucas say that so she informed [REDACTED] of what Lucas said.

Since the incident, Scott advised me that Lucas has made several comments about [REDACTED] to his friends. [REDACTED] informed me that on 02/28/2020 at approximately 10:45 AM while he was at lunch in the high school, his friend told him that Lucas called him a "pussy" and that [REDACTED] wouldn't come within 5 feet of him. Scott added that Lucas is trying to provoke [REDACTED] into an altercation.

Melissa and Scott both informed me that they wanted to report this because they were afraid that Timothy would bring the previous report to school and try to use it against [REDACTED]. Both Melissa and Scott stated that they just want their family to not be bothered.

I then supplied Melissa with a Citizen's Information Card and advised her on how to obtain a copy of this report.

The scene was then cleared.

On the above date and time, Ofc. Seiden and I received a walk-in report of harassment. We spoke with Melissa Lebow, Scott Lebow and Ryan Lebow in the interview room.

Scott and Melissa advised us that Timothy Eosso is harassing their 18 year old son, Ryan. The Lebow's stated they believe the issue with Timothy began about 8 years ago when they removed Ryan off of a travel baseball team which was coached by Timothy because they did not agree with the way he coached and the way he treated the young players.

This past winter during a basketball game, Ryan and Lucas Eosso (Timothy Eosso's son) had a verbal argument. After the game, Ryan posted a picture on his Snapchat story about the incident saying to leave him and his family alone and stating that someone was a "pussy" for what happened and that this post was not directed to a specific person. Ryan stated that this was about the incident with Lucas but did not actually use Lucas' name in the Snapchat story. At this time, a bullying case was opened up through the Monroe Township High School. Their investigation determined that there was an issue between the two but believed nothing further would happen and the investigation was closed. This incident occurred towards the end of 01/2020.

On 06/22/2020 Ryan was selected to play in an all-star baseball tournament on The Monroe Twp. High school Team but Lucas was not selected for the team. Scott stated Timothy had contacted the team's coach, the athletic director and the principal about getting Ryan kicked off of the team. They stated that they were told by the school that Timothy felt Ryan was not the best person to represent the Monroe Township High School because he had bullied his son a few months ago.

Scott stated that on 07/01/2020, his son Ryan was contacted by the Rutgers University admissions office. Scott stated they wanted to speak to Ryan about an incident that happened during the school year with Ryan bullying Lucas. Scott stated Rutgers received a screen shot of Ryan's Snapchat post, he also said Rutgers confirmed it was sent to them by Timothy Eosso. On 07/07/2020, Ryan had a virtual meeting with staff members from Rutgers University. Ryan stated he received no disciplinary action from Rutgers regarding the bullying incident in high school. They stated Lucas Eosso recently had his college admission revoked for posting racist statements on social media. Scott and Melissa believe Timothy sent that to Rutgers in an attempt to have Ryan's admission revoked or to slander him.

Tonight, there is a separate senior baseball game being hosted in North Brunswick. Scott and Melissa are worried Timothy is going to show up and cause problems for their family. Timothy has no reason to be at the game since Lucas was not selected to play. They requested we contact North Brunswick Police and advised them of the situation and that there might be a possible incident at the game. At 1700 hours I was able to make contact with North Brunswick PD, they were made aware of all pertinent information.

The Lebow's were provided with a Citizen Information Card. We advised them how to obtain a copy of the report and they were provided with the statute for harassment (2C:33-4), they were also advised of how to sign a complaint against Timothy through the Monroe Township Municipal Court. Scott advised us that he sent an e-mail to Rutgers that detailed this series of events and stated that he would e-mail it to my departmental e-mail to attach with this report and to help with the time line of events. As of this time I have not received the e-mail.

Ofc. Seiden and I then cleared from the incident.

Timothy stated that sometime between the end of the meeting on Monday and Tuesday morning there was a Facebook post made about him and about [REDACTED] The Facebook post was made by Sarah Aziz. I have been sent a copy of the post provided by Timothy via e-mail (see attached). In the Facebook post, Sarah stated that one of the LWV members discovered [REDACTED] and asked why he was unmasked and at the meeting. Timothy was concerned with the fact that one of the LWV members knew about [REDACTED] Timothy felt harassed by this post as it was directed at his family. Upon arrival I met with the victim, Patricia Lang. Lang stated that sometime during May of 2021, Timothy Eosso, began harassing her by publicly accusing her of not paying her taxes.

Lang stated that in June of 2021 there was a League of Women Voters (LWV) meeting at the Municipal Building where Eosso stood up and stated that people who don't pay their taxes shouldn't be a member of their organization. During the exchange another member asked Eosso why he wasn't wearing a mask after [REDACTED] Lang stated that Eosso believed that she supplied the members of the LWV with the information about [REDACTED]

Lang stated that Eosso then continued speaking about her to various people in town via Facebook and email. Lang stated that what prompted her to come in today was a series of e-mails she received from Eosso this morning. In the e-mails Eosso refers to a letter that was sent to a college regarding his son, Lucas Eosso, about having his scholarship revoked. Eosso advises Lang that if she has any information regarding the letter to come forward as they are very close to determining who sent it. Lang asks Eosso to stop threatening her to which Eosso replies back that he is not threatening and just asking if she has any information.

Lang stated that she does not know Eosso's son and never sent any letters about him to anyone. Lang stated that she wants Eosso to stop contacting her and spreading lies about her to other people. I advised Lang that I could speak to Eosso and advise him to stop contacting her. Lang agreed. I then provided Lang with a Certification of Probable Cause Form and the statute for Harassment 2C:33-4. I explained to Lang the process for signing complaints if she chooses to do so and how to obtain a copy of this report.

I then contacted Timothy Eosso via telephone and explained to him the above. Eosso denied telling anyone that Lang does not pay her taxes and maintained that he was attacked at LWV Meeting. I then asked Eosso about the letter regarding his son. Eosso stated that he knows that Lang sent a letter to the Monroe Twp. Board of Education advising them that Lucas' scholarship was revoked for "racial comments." Eosso stated that since she sent that letter he wanted to know if Lang had information about the letter sent to Lucas' school. Eosso stated that he never threatened Lang in the e-mails and the exchange stopped when she told him to stop e-mailing her. Eosso stated that he felt the basis for Lang's report today was politically motivated and frivolous. Eosso was then provided with the incident number of this report for his records.

I then contacted Lang and advised her of the outcome.

Lastly, Eosso stated that he has never spread lies to people about Lang. Eosso stated that it is public record that at one time Lang did not pay her taxes.

I advised Eosso that the police report number for this incident would remain the same and a supplement would be completed documenting the above.

On 10/16/2021 I was dispatched to headquarters for a walk in assist citizen report. Dispatch advised that the reporting party stated that he witnessed people stealing political signs.

Upon my arrival I met with the reporting party, Patrick Coveny. Patrick had with him a co-worker, for moral support, that he requested be in the interview room with him. I advised that she can enter the room with him if he wished. Patrick advised me that he works for the "Mayor Dalina Campaign". Patrick stated that he observed a political opponent, Timothy Eosso, removing a "Dalina" sign and replacing it with a "Bohra, Fabiano, Rattner" sign, on the northbound side of Applegarth Road, near the bus stop that is approximately 600 feet north of the railroad tracks. I asked when he saw this occur, to which he stated 10/07/2021, at approximately 3:10PM.

Patrick showed me two videos that he recorded. In the first video Patrick was traveling south on Applegarth Road, recording, where I observed a black Ram truck (registration not legible), and a man standing in front of the truck, near a "Dalina" sign. Moments later the video ends as Patrick is no longer in sight of the black truck. The second video Patrick was traveling north on Applegarth Road, recording, where I observed a black Ram 1500 bearing NJ Reg: H69JJM (registered to Timothy Eosso), parked in the same location as described above. There was nobody near the vehicle at this time. As Patrick continued north, I observed a "Bohra, Fabiano, Rattner" sign, where the "Dalina" sign was previously. At no time in either video did I observe Timothy removing the "Dalina" sign, or placing the "Bohra, Fabiano, Rattner" sign. I supplied Patrick with my department email address (nlafata@monroetwppolice.org) and requested that he send me the videos he has. As of writing this report, I still have yet to receive an email from Patrick containing the videos.

Patrick advised that he saw Timothy remove the sign, and place it into the bed of his truck. I advised Patrick that he could complete a Certificate of Probable Cause form for theft, and submit it to the Monroe Township Municipal Court. Patrick advised that he would like to do so. I supplied Patrick with a Certificate of Probable Cause form, the statute for theft

(2C:20-3A), and advised him how to complete the form and return it to the Municipal Court. Patrick was also supplied a citizens information card and advised how to obtain a copy of this report. It was at this time that Patrick and his co-worker asked if I could terminate my body worn camera. I terminated my body worn camera at this time. With my body worn camera off, Patrick and his co-worker asked if there was anything that could be done about this. I advised them that they could continue to report the incidents and complete Certificate of Probable Cause forms. I advised them that evidence would be needed showing him taking the signs to pursue this further. Both parties left headquarters at this time.

I cleared the scene at this time. No further information.

On 10-18-2021, I was assigned to investigate a report that was received on 10-16-2021 which referenced the theft of political campaign signs. I was advised the reporting party had video footage of an individual, identified as Timothy Eosso, removing the campaign signs that were placed along the curb line of Applegarth Road and replacing it with a "Bohra, Fabiano, Rattner" Board of Education sign.

To continue with this investigation, contact was made with the reporting party and a copy of two short videos were received as well as three still shots that were apparently taken on 10-7-2021.

The first video clip begins with the reporting party filming as he is travelling south bound on Applegarth Road. A short time later, a black Ram pick-up truck comes into focus and appears to be parked. In front of the Ram pick-up truck, is a blue campaign sign that is a clearly visible as well as a male subject standing next to the truck.

The second video clip, which is now being filmed as the reporting party is travelling north bound, again shows the Ram pick-up truck parked in the same location. As the video is analyzed further, the registration affixed to the truck comes in focus and is identified as a black 2017 Ram 1500 bearing NJ registration H69JJM. NJ DMV revealed that this vehicle is registered to Timothy Eosso of 53 West Granada Drive in Brick, NJ.

In addition to reviewing the videos, I had the reporting party respond to Police Headquarters to obtain an official L3 taped statement. During this statement, the RP stated that they observed a political opponent, who he clearly identified as Timothy Eosso, removing a campaign sign from the ground and throw it in the back of a black Ram pick-up truck.

During this conversation, I asked the RP why his attention was drawn to the side of the roadway where the vehicle was parked to which he responded that multiple campaign signs have been stolen over the past few weeks and he wanted to make sure they were not being stolen or vandalized.

At this time, I asked the RP if he was familiar with Eosso. He responded by saying "Yes, he is our opponent in the second ward". I then asked him if he

knew exactly what the opponent looked like and if he was familiar with the physical features to which he responded "Yes".

We next spoke about the vehicle that was parked on the side of the road. He described it as a black truck with a big bed in the back. He also added that it had the "firefighter plate" on the back of the truck and he, referring to Eosso, is a firefighter. Let it be noted that the video shows what appears to be a firefighter placard on the rear driver's side window and a firefighter bumper sticker.

The RP then stated that he conducted a U-turn with the intentions to see exactly what he was doing. By the time he got back to the area, all the "blue / Dalina signs, were replaced by his white signs".

Upon completion of taking this statement, I reviewed the video that was provided by the RP once again. The first video shows the "blue signs" still in the ground, where as in the second video it shows a "white sign" in place where the "blue sign" was in the first video.

Lieutenant Banos, who was assisting in this investigation, made contact with the Middlesex County Prosecutors Office. He was advised that they would not be getting involved with this case and that the Monroe Twp Police Department could move forward without their assistance.

To continue this investigation, I attempted to contact Mr. Eosso via the telephone. I retrieved two phone numbers from the initial report taken by Ofc Lafata. I attempted to call the cellular number first but there was no answer and the voicemail was full. I next tried the home phone number. This number appeared to go directly to a fax machine.

At approximately 1700 hrs, Lieutenant Banos and I responded to # 2 Allison CT. Monroe Twp NJ. in an attempt to make contact with Mr. Eosso. Upon arrival, Mr. Eosso met us at the front door and invited us into his residence. Lieutenant Banos now began explain to Mr. Eosso that a complaint was made against him for taking signs. Lieutenant added that video was submitted to us and if he would like come to Headquarters, we would gladly show it to him. Eosso responded that he would come down and view the video right now. As Lieutenant Banos and I were walking out the door Eosso stated the he was going to call his attorney first.

While awaiting the arrival of Mr. Eosso at Police Headquarters, I received a call. Mr. Eosso advised me that he spoke to his attorney and he would not

be responding tonight.

The facts of this case were then presented to A.P. Snyder. Upon being advised of the above statement and an explanation of the video, he agreed that the charge of Theft would be in order. On 10-19-2021, a complaint summons was completed. Complaint # 1213 S 2021 000187

Investigation to continue.

On 10/19/2021, a completed summons was provided to Adam J. Elias, at Police Headquarters to be forwarded to his client. Elias was advised that Mr. Eosso still needed to be processed for Summons # 1213 S 2021 000187 for Theft.

At approximately 1400 hours, Mr Eosso arrived at Police Headquarters to be processed. Det. Sgt. Saloom and I began to escort Mr. Eosso into the process room. While doing so, I explained to him that the process would be quick and we just need to take some pictures, ask some basic questions, and he would be released. Mr. Eosso immediately said no pictures and he wanted to call his attorney. He added that he did not want his pictures taken and was here to just pick up a summons. He was advised that the summons was given to his attorney this morning.

Mr. Eosso stated that he wanted to wait till he received a response from his attorney. Mr. Eosso was given the opportunity to wait in the lobby or remain in the interview room. Mr. Eosso chose interview room. He was then escorted into the interview room where he was afforded the opportunity to contact his attorney. He made a brief call and he advised us that his attorney would call him back. While waiting for the return phone call, Eosso requested business cards from both Det. Sgt Saloom and I. At this time I went to retrieve a business card and Det. Sgt Saloom retrieved a cup of water for Eosso as per his request.

When I returned, Det. Sgt Saloom began to advised Eosso the procedure of being processed, Eosso stated that he wanted to record this. He pulled out his cellular phone, scrolled through the screen, began recording, and laid it on the table. At this time Det. Sgt. Saloom advised him that once he goes into the processing room he was not allowed to record. He questioned "Why Not? So, you're telling me, I can't process, I can't have my own recorder in the processing". He continued to ask " So is there something in writing for that? Or is it just the law?" Det. Sgt. Saloom and advised him that it was the Policy. Eosso questioned him again by asking again "Is it Policy or the law?" Saloom once again advised him that it was Policy. Eosso then stated "So I'm not allowed to have any phone conversation or any recording device inside while I'm being processed?" Saloom advised him

that this whole interaction was being recorded by the body worn camera and the entire process was being recorded anyway, and you were just not allowed to have personal items while your being processed and that procedure is for everyone.

After Mr. Eosso was explained this procedure in detail, he reached into his pocket and pulled out two Business cards. He slapped them on the table in front of Det. Sgt. Saloom and I. He stated " I don't know if you guys are Monroe residents?" As I reached to retrieve the card, he pulled it away from me, picked it up, held it in front of my face and said "That's my picture. Just so you know it's me".

Eventually he received a phone call back from his attorney and agreed to have his picture taken. During the process procedure, I began to ask Mr. Eosso general questions in order to complete the processing procedure. After asking pedigree questions, he only answered them by stating "Under the advice of my attorney I do not want to answer any questions".

After filling out the booking form to the best of my ability, Mr. Eosso was then escorted out of the processing area and back out into the lobby. It was at this time he stated "Have a good day and good job". As Mr. Eosso began to exit the door way he turned around, held out his hand and said "Take care see you soon".

Mr. Eosso the left the building. A copy of the footage recorded on my body worn camera was entered into evidence accordingly. No further information at this time.

Upon further review of the video in enhanced quality, I revealed a discrepancy from the original video that was provided. The original video provided and viewed on 10/18/2021 in conjunction with the statement made by the reporting person, makes it appear that the backdrop scenery is the same in both videos, leading to believe the location of the incidents being filmed was the same. This is due to poor video quality and poor pixilation in the video. Let it be noted that this enhanced video was not received until 10/19/2021, due to issues with the department e-mail firewall. This forwarded video is of higher quality than the initial video that was received on 10/18/2021.

During the course of reviewing the enhanced five-second-long video on 10/29/2021, which begins with the reporting party travelling south on Applegarth Rd, shows the suspect's vehicle (a black Ram Pick-up truck) parked on the side of Applegarth Road in the shoulder cut out of the roadway. In front of this vehicle, there appears to be several blue "Dalina" campaign signs affixed in the ground. The backdrop scenery in this video shows a grass area, green foliage, multiple trees, the curb line and power lines high above the vehicle described above.

As video #2 was reviewed further in the higher quality version, it shows the reporting party traveling north on Applegarth Rd. Eventually the Ram pickup truck comes into view. It shows the same vehicle parked in a shoulder cut out along Applegarth Road. Next to the pickup truck, the backdrop scenery shows a grass area, the curb line, green foliage, multiple trees. The video also shows multiple white "Republican" campaign signs affixed in the ground.

The enhanced versions of the videos shows a reduce speed ahead sign and intersection crossing sign present in Video #2. These signs are not seen in Video #1. Considering that these signs are somewhat permanently affixed into the ground, it can now be determined that the two videos show the pickup truck in two separate shoulder cut outs along Applegarth Road.

With these new facts, it now shows an inconsistency with the statement that Patrick Coveny provided to me on 10/18/2021. Now knowing that the

pickup truck was filmed in 2 separate locations, the videos no longer corroborate the removal of the Democratic campaign signs as claimed by the reporting party.

As previously stated in supplemental report #2, the first video shows democrat signs and the second video shows republican signs. Being under the impression that the vehicle was in the same location it would confirm the statement made by Coveny, being that democratic signs were removed and subsequently replaced by republican signs. Now as the background on a larger scale is meticulously analyzed, his statements cannot be confirmed. At this time, I can now say that I can not confirm nor deny the statement made by Coveny.

Upon noticing this discrepancy, I immediately made contact with Lt. Banos and advised him of my findings. Together we reviewed the footage and he confirmed my findings. Lt. Banos next made contact with Middlesex County Assistant Prosecutor Santos at 1340 hours. He briefed AP Santos on the new information regarding this case. Under her guidance it was suggested to have this summons dismissed and have the reporting party sign the complaint himself. Lt. Banos made contact with Monroe Township Prosecutor Jennifer Burgess to advise her of the new findings and that the Summons needed to be dismissed.

I next contacted the reporting party Patrick Convey to advise him that the summons issued by the Monroe Township Police was being dismissed and if he wished to continue with signing charges, he needed to fill out a Probable Cause form and submit it to the court accordingly.

I next completed a "Request To Dismiss Or Void Complaint" form requesting to have summons 1213 S 2021 000187 dismissed and left in records so it could be submitted to the court accordingly.

No further information at this time.

On the above date and time I was dispatched to police headquarters for a report of harassment. Mr. Peter Piro and his wife Christina came in to report multiple incidents of harassment they have been subjected to by Mr.

Timothy Eosso.

Mr. Piro explained that he has been harassed by Mr. Eosso numerous times both in person as well as on social media. He explained that on 6/8/2021, while at Mr. Piro's house, Mr. Eosso made several alarming comments. According to Mr. Piro, Mr. Eosso attempted to start a political conversation with him. Mr. Piro stated he politely tried to tell Mr. Eosso he doesn't get involved in politics. According to Mr. Piro, Mr. Eosso then stated "You better get on the right team if you're going to work here." Mr. Piro felt this comment was in reference to his employment with the Monroe Township School District.

Mr. Piro then stated that on 7/3/2021 and 8/22/2021 Mr. Eosso made public Facebook posts about him as well as his wife. According to Mr. Piro, in these posts, Mr. Eosso accuses Mr. Piro of "double dipping" the state pension system as well as other accusations regarding Mr. Piro's township salaries. Mr. Piro stated that when his wife attempted to post in the comment section of the post she was then accused of being a liar.

Mr. Piro then stated that on 11/2/2021 he was attempting to vote at the Oak Tree Elementary School along with his wife. While waiting on line, he took note that Mr. Eosso was standing behind the poll workers with a clip board and appeared to be interacting with residents coming to vote. Mr. Piro felt this was a violation of the election rules so he began to record Mr. Eosso's actions to document them. During the video process, Mr. Piro stated that Mr. Eosso pointed at him as well and winked at his wife. Mr. Piro, as well as Christina, felt harassed by these actions.

As Mr. Piro got closer he heard Mr. Eosso ask "Do you have any duct tape?" Mr. Piro felt this comment was directly related to his mailbox recently being vandalized since it is currently being held together by duct tape.
