Toms River Police Department Investigation Narrative

On Monday, 07/22/2019 Mr. [REDACTED] responded to the lobby of District One to file a harassment report. [REDACTED] stated that he is being harassed by a former student, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that he is a professor at Ocean County College and he is being harassed by a former student, [REDACTED] was [REDACTED] faculty advisor and the two had maintained a professional relationship after [REDACTED] finished his time at OCC. [REDACTED] reported that on 04/19/2018, [REDACTED] entered [REDACTED] classroom while class was in session. [REDACTED] appeared to be "High as a kite." disrupted the lecture and made everyone feel uncomfortable. [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] that he non longer wished to maintain a professional relationship due to [REDACTED] erratic behavior.

Since the incident, [REDACTED] has continued to call and show up at [REDACTED] office unannounced and unwanted. [REDACTED] has filed reports with OCC security as well as the college's human resources department. As a result of the harassment [REDACTED] was informed that he is no longer permitted in the Ocean County College Gateway Building. [REDACTED] was provided with a letter issued by the college.

[REDACTED] provided this officer with copies of all internal e-mails pertaining to [REDACTED] as well as the trespass notice. Those documents are added to the case file.

[REDACTED] was advised of complaint procedures, and stated that he did not wish to sign complaints at this time, however he might in the future.
