On January 27, 2020, at approximately 1240 hrs, I responded to the Ocean County Library; 101 Washington St for report of a theft.

Upon arrival I spoke to [REDACTED] who reported that his bicycle was stolen from the bicycle rack on the west side of the library. [REDACTED] related that the bicycle was not locked and was last observed in the rack at approximately 0800 hrs on this date. The bike was described as a blue mountain bike with a value of \$100.00. He was unable to relate the brand of the bike or any further specifics about it. He was advised to e-mail a photo of the bike to me should he be able to locate one. He was issued a report information card and advised to contact this agency with any further information in regards to the theft.

Contact was made with the Ocean County Library security who was able to show me surveillance video of the incident. While watching the video I observed two black males exit Dunkin Donuts into the library entry way and then exit the library via the west doors. The above listed suspect then walked up to the bicycle, checked the tires and then removed it from the rack at approximately 0930 hrs. Surveillance photos of the suspect were electronically attached to the case file.

Later in the day I was contacted by library security who advised me that possible suspects from the theft were inside the library. Contact was made with Davion Sullivan who was identified as being the second individual that was observed with the suspect. Davion indicated that he did not know the suspect and was uncooperative during my investigation.

Contact was also made High School South SRO Putkowski #349 who indicated that the suspect in surveillance photos resembled a Jahim Sanders, who is an associate of Daivon Sullivan. He indicated that Sanders is a high school drop out and bounces around from place to place. No contact has been made with Sanders at this time.
