Narrative

Toms River Police Department Investigation Narrative

On 10/3/18, at approximately 0943 hours, I responded to Parking Lot 2 of Ocean County College (1 College Drive) on the report of a criminal mischief. Upon arrival, I met with the victim, Anthony Koletis, who advised that his vehicle (NJ Registration [REDACTED]) was damaged by an unknown suspect.

Koletis stated that on 10/3/18, at approximately 0745 hours, he parked his vehicle on the south-west side of Lot 2 of Ocean County College. Koletis advised that he then went to his class and returned to his vehicle at approximately 0945 hours. Koletis stated that upon returning to his vehicle, he found two fresh large horizontal scratches on his driver side front and rear doors. The scratches appeared to have been caused by an unknown sharp object.

Koletis could not provide an estimate of the approximate damage at this time. There is no further information at this time.
