On this date and time, this officer received copies of a "Bitcoin" scam letter that was turned over to this agency by Chief Kerr for Christopher Fitzmaurice of 2 Warren Avenue.

The letter contains wording found on letters that have been posted online as warnings to potential recipients, *(I know about the secret you are keeping from your wife. More importantly, I have evidence of what you have been hiding. I won't go into the specifics here in case your wife intercepts this, but you know what I am talking about. . .*

It is just your bad luck that I stumbled across your misadventures while working a job around Spring Lake. I then put in more time than I probably should have looking into your life. . .) which the author gives options to follow, Option 1 ignore the threat and the evidence will be sent to your wife or Option 2 is payment of \$7,500.00 through bitcoin.

This officer was advised by Chief Kerr that Mr. Fitzmaurice was aware that it was a scam and that we should have a copy of same. See File for copies of letter received with the envelope along with print outs of online postings containing letters of same verbage.

06/03/2017 (0809hrs) At this time this officer was dispatched to 2 Warren Avenue in reference to a trespasser who was at the residence at 0306hrs on this date. Dispatch further indicated that the trespasser was not at the residence at this time.

At my arrival, this officer met with the homeowner, Christopher Fitzmaurice. Mr. Fitzmaurice advised that around 3am he heard a door open on the first level of his home. Mr. Fitzmaurice went to the first level of his home and confronted a white male subject who was in the kitchen area of his residence. Mr. Fitzmaurice did not know this subject and questioned him on why he was inside his home. The subject identified himself as "Alex" and advised "They said I could sleep here". Mr. Fitzmaurice advised the subject that he could not sleep in his home. The subject then stated, "Ill go out the way I came in " and exited the residence through a west side porch door. Mr. Fitzmaurice indicated that the subject was young and appeared under the influence of alcohol.

This officer questioned Mr. Fitzmaurice as to why he did not contact the police at the time of the incident. Mr. Fitzmaurice stated he did not want to bother us so late at night. This officer advised Mr. Fitzmaurice that the police department is a 24 hour operation and going forward he should contact us at any time of the day in a similar situation.

Mr. Fitzmaurice has video surveillance on the door that the subject entered into his residence. The time of the video indicated the time of the incident was 0306hrs. This officer and Ptlm. Ryan Reiff viewed the video of the incident. The involved subject is described as a white male, with medium length brown hair and a thin build. The subject appeared to be in his late teens or early twenties. The subject was wearing a light blue t shirt, dark blue shorts and dark colored shoes. The subject entered the residence from a door off of the west side porch. The subject exited from the same door.

Mr. Fitzmaurice stated that he and his wife checked the residence and nothing appears to be missing. This officer requested a copy of the video surveillance and if still photographs of the subject could be created. Mr. Fitzmaurice advised that his video system is brand new and he could not provide video or photographs, but he will contact the company that installed it and after meeting the company, he will provide the requested items.

On 5/26/06, I was dispatched to 2 Warren Avenue for a report of harassing phone calls. Upon arrival, this officer was met by the homeowner, Christopher Fitzmaurice, who stated that at 0716 hours, his wife (Alison Fitzmaurice) received a phone call on the house land line (██████████) from an unknown party. The caller ID feature showed the calling number as 277-915-8346 with no name given. The male voice on the line stated to Mrs. Fitzmaurice "I wanna fuck you." After that comment Mrs. Fitzmaurice hung up the phone. One minute later at 0717 hrs, the same number called back, this time Mr. Fitzmaurice answered the telephone. The caller immediately hung up without saying a word. Mr. Fitzmaurice activated the Call Trace feature #57 after this second call. Case forwarded to DSgt. Coyle #109 for further investigation.

A search of several internet databases in an attempt to reveal what service provider issued the phone number came back negative. The area code 277 is not issued in this country. The number was more than likely spoofed to defeat caller identification. Mr. Fitzmaurice was advised of this and reported that he will be working with Verizon to add a service whereby callers must identify themselves prior to his answering the calls. To date victim reports no further calls.
