Narrative / Additional Charges: On Saturday, February 1, 2020, I (Police Officer Matthew Lyle #305) was assigned to the uniform patrol division in the Borough of Fort Lee, utilizing marked police unit #474. While on patrol, in the area of Arcadian way and Bluff road, I observed a Black 2012 Chrysler 300 bearing NJ registration U97LCM, traveling southbound on Bluff road at an abnormally slow speed....

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Additionally, the vehicle, had dark tinted front driver and passenger side windows. It should be noted that the vehicle was traveling as though it had no destination, down residential side streets at significantly below the posted speed limit. Through my training and experience as a police officer, I know these driving characteristics are consistent with an operator who is intoxicated.

Upon observing the Chrysler make a right turn onto Arcadian Way from Bluff Road, I positioned my vehicle behind the Chrysler. The Chrysler then made a left turn onto Route 5, at which time I activated my emergency lights initiating a motor vehicle stop on the Chrysler. At that time, I notified the Fort Lee Communications Center (Com-Cen) advising them of my motor vehicle stop and location. As GOODEN pulled his vehicle to the right of the roadway, he rode up on the curb with his front right tire, nearly onto the sidewalk. I exited my marked unit and approached the passenger side of the Chrysler. At the passenger side window, I spoke to the driver later identified as, Dwight GOODEN. I requested that GOODEN provide his license, registration and proof of insurance, at which time GOODEN provided his NJ driver's license. It should be noted that while speaking to GOODEN, he appeared disheveled and had a hoarse, raspy tone of voice. The interior compartment of the Chrysler was in disarray, with a profound odor of urine emanating directly from within. Through my training and experience as a Law Enforcement Officer, I know these characteristics to be consistent with narcotics use.

I asked GOODEN where he was traveling to and where he was traveling from. GOODEN stated that he was traveling from West New York, to his destination on River Road in Edgewater. The direction of travel of GOODEN to where he was coming from, and going to was implausible, as he was traveling in the opposite direction. It became apparent that GOODEN was obviously disoriented and confused. At this time, I advised GOODEN to exit the vehicle and step to the rear, to which he complied.

Upon GOODEN exiting the vehicle, he was staggering and nearly falling into the street near oncoming traffic. I grabbed GOODEN to support him and helped him to the rear of the Chrysler. I asked GOODEN if he ingested anything, which he replied "no". Once at the rear, GOODEN immediately leaned on the trunk of the Chrysler for balance. GOODEN stated that he had been drinking earlier in the day.

At this time, I advised GOODEN that I wished to conduct field sobriety tests, to ascertain if he was capable of operating a motor vehicle, to which he agreed. SGT Valacer deactivated the front flashing lights of my marked police vehicle. With the use of my flashlight, I observed that GOODEN's eyes were glassy, bloodshot, watery, and slow to react to changes in light conditions. Through my training and experience as a Law Enforcement Officer, I know that these are common characteristics of someone who is under the influence of a controlled dangerous substance or an alcoholic beverage. I informed GOODEN that I would explain and demonstrate the field sobriety tests, and that I did not want him to conduct the tests until I had fully explained and performed each, at which time I asked if he understood and could perform the tests. GOODEN acknowledged verbally that he understood. I asked GOODEN if there were any medical conditions that I should be aware of that would prevent him from completing a few tests. GOODEN stated [REDACTED] Sgt Valacer asked GOODEN if he had any ailments which would prevent him from taking 10 or so steps, to which he stated that he did not. I conducted the standardized field sobriety tests. Utilizing my pen as a stimulus, held slightly higher than eye level and approximately twelve (12) to fifteen (15) inches from his person, I conducted the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I observed GOODEN's eyes and found his pupils to be equal size, slow but reactive, found no resting Nystagmus, and equal tracking in both eyes. I observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. GOODEN's eyes were unable to remain on my Stimulus, and would only track for a short period of time then bounce back to looking straight ahead continually.

I informed GOODEN that I would explain and demonstrate a few more field sobriety tests, and that I did not want him to conduct the tests until I had fully explained and performed each, and to not begin the test until told to do so. I conducted and explained the walk and turn test. While conducting and explaining the starting position for the test, GOODEN leaned on the trunk of the vehicle for balance. I informed GOODEN that he could not lean for balance, at which time he was unable to get into the starting position for the test. After GOODEN was given several attempts, I ended the test for safety due to GOODEN staggering on the brink of falling down. GOODEN was unable to perform this test. The next test I conducted and explained was the one leg stand.

I'm looking for the following clues:

1. Drops foot to ground
2. Swaying
3. Hopping
4. Lifts arms higher than six (6) inches

I explained to GOODEN that he could use either leg for this test and to stand with one leg of his choosing, raised approximately six inches off the ground. GOODEN started the test prior to me telling him to multiple times. Once I told GOODEN to begin the test, he kept using his arms for

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balance and put his foot down continuously. GOODEN was swaying dramatically both while I explained the test, and during the test. GOODEN also lifted his arms higher than six inches.

Based on my observations GOODEN was placed under arrest for DWI. I secured him in handcuffs, double locked them and checked for tightness. PO Diaz then placed him in the rear of vehicle #460. It should be noted that the rear of unit #460 was searched both prior to and after the transport, yielding negative results for any contraband. GOODEN was transported to headquarters for processing, in the rear of the same, PO Diaz and PO Avella. ABC towing responded and towed the Chrysler from the scene as per John's Law.

At headquarters, GOODEN had his property logged, signed for and placed in men's property locker #1. PO Avella read GOODEN his rights as per Miranda VS Arizona which he acknowledged in both verbal and written form. GOODEN agreed to submit samples of his breath for the purpose of testing. PO Avella removed all electronic devices, checked GOODEN's mouth for any foreign bodies or items, and conducted the twenty-minute observation between 2256 hours and 2316 hours with continued observation up to, and throughout, the operation of the Alco test. Utilizing a new mouthpiece with ever provided breath sample.

NJ State Alco test results yielded a 0.00 BAC level. A copy of the Alcohol Influence report was then given to GOODEN and placed into his property, along with the drinking and driving questionnaire. PO Cabrera responded to the cell block area for Drug recognition expert (DRE) testing of GOODEN. For further see PO Cabrera's DRE report of his findings under case #I-2020-007801. Upon completion of DRE testing, GOODEN was placed in cell #1 while awaiting his summons.

At approximately 0135 hours, Luis Ortiz, was provided the Potential Liability Form to which he agreed to in both verbal and written form. GOODEN was provided with his copy of all summonses listed above. GOODEN signed for and had his property released to him at which time he was released into the care of Luis Ortiz.
