Narrative

On 05/07/2021, at approx. 1145, Warren Point School after school aide Charlene Flatley, age 58, DOB [REDACTED], ([REDACTED]) of [REDACTED], Hackensack, NJ advised me that while she was outside in the playground in the rear do the school on May 6, 2021, a male had driven his bicycle directly through the playground by her, almost knocking a child down. Ms. Flatley said she told the male he could not be there, but he continued to ride around the school property, onto the blacktop before leaving. Mrs. Flatley believed the incident occurred around 3:30pm. Mrs. Flatley further advised me that she believed the male was the person was in the Tier Two sex offender information bulletin confidential for school and institution bulletin use which was issued on April 15, 2021. The male, Dany Denho, age [REDACTED], age 28, of [REDACTED], Clifton, NJ is employed at UBC Distributors, 17-09 Zink Place, Fair Lawn, NJ. MS. Flatley had seen the form as a school employee. I asked Ms. Flatley if she was sure it was the same male and she said it was. Warren Point School Principal, Ms. Sue Gons was advised of what Ms. Flatley stated. I then contacted D/Capt. Patterson and advised him of the matter. Det. Censulo contacted me and I advised her of the matter as well.

At approx.. 1225 hrs., a second after school aide who was outside with Mrs. Flatley when the incident occurred, Lenore Rodriguez, age 61, DOB: [REDACTED] of [REDACTED], Fair Lawn, NJ had arrived at work and I spoke with her about the matter. I showed Ms. Rodriguez the picture and she advised me that it was not the same person. Ms. Rodriguez, advised me that she had seen the person on the bicycle before, and she was sure it was not the same person.

I contacted Det. Censullo and advised her of what Ms. Rodriguez said. I also advised Ms. Gons of what Ms. Rodriguez said.

I then reviewed the video surveillance cameras from the date and time of the incident. Ms. Rodriguez and Ms. Flatley brought the children out to the playground out at 3:07pm. I initially observed a male individual at 4:00 riding his bicycle in the playground area, but this person appeared to be young, possibly a teenager. I then observed at 4:29pm, a male ride his bicycle onto the school property from Rosalie Street, through the playground onto south side of the property, ride directly into the playground area with the woodchips where the children were playing, almost knocking into Ms. Flatley, and she appears to say something to him, then continue off the woodchips where he almost runs into a child and into a sign. The male continues through the baseball field, then comes back around riding through the blacktop area of the playground, past Ms. Flatley, Ms. Rodriguez and the children, then off the school property onto Rosalie Street. After viewing the video, the male involved in this incident does not appear to be Mr. Denho. I advised Ms. Flatley and Ms. Rodriguez to contact the Police Department if this occurs again.

On Fri. May 7, 2021 while assigned to the DB and on duty I was asked by Capt. Paterson to call SRO B. DiPsquale #712 regarding a suspicious incident possibly involving a Megan's Law Offender.

SRO DiPsquale relayed to me that one of the after school aides, Charlene Flatley age 58 told him that on Thurs. May 6, 2021 a male drove a bike through the school yard, specifically near the children and through the play area nearly hitting a child and she believed him to be a Megan's Law Offender specifically Dany Denho. She stated she recognized the photo/notice that was on the principals desk (Mike Weaver). The school received a notice in the beginning of the week as did we relaying that Dany Denho is working in Fair Lawn.

He also spoke to another aide, Lenore Rodriguez, age 62 who saw the man as well, however she stated that it was not Dany Denho. She also stated that she had seen this man before riding his bike.

I called Det. Cynthia Henriques, 973-837-7692 whose name was on the notice. She advised me to call Clifton PD and speak with Det. Son. I then called Det. William Son, 973-470-5879 who handles Megan's Law in Clifton, NJ where Dany Denho resides. He told me that he has had no problems with Dany except for minor motor vehicle violations. I then went into Offender Watch and looked Dany up. I found that it was already documented that he was no longer working in Fair Lawn and is now working in Seacacus, NJ. I also got a number for his PSL, Flor Raiz, [REDACTED] in case I needed to call her. I then called UBC Distributors in Fair Lawn where Dany worked and spoke to Lisa Issa, [REDACTED] who works in human resources and confirmed that Dany has not worked there since Oct. 30, 2020.

Narrative

On 06/03/2021, at approx. 0835 hrs., Warren Point School Principal Sue Gons advised me that she had received an e-mail from Jill Cottrell advising her of a situation that occurred on school grounds on 6/2/21 at approx. 2:30pm. Ms. Gons provided me with the e-mail in which Ms. Cottrell said that she was on the playground with her Girl Scout Troop, when she and another parent noticed a man sitting on the benches near Rosalie Street who was not there with a child or anyone else and that he was staring intently at the playground. Ms. Cottrell further wrote that one of her Girl Scouts got dropped off and had to walk past him to get to their group and as soon as they got by them, she said that the guy was weird and that he said "Hey, What's up!" to her all weird. Another parent notified the police department, and when the police car arrived, they moved the girls out of sight. About thirty minutes later, she noticed that the male was gone. At approx. 6:15pm, she returned to the school for her son's baseball game and noticed the male again walking away from the school quickly. She then saw a dad looking concerned and he told her the man was at the school around kids just staring and walked off when the parents approached him and according to another parent, this man was around the school a few days ago blowing cigarette smoke in peoples faces and knocked a woman down.

I then completed the stand by for student drop off and the school perimeter/door check when another parent, Kelly Apap approached me and told me that she had observed the male yesterday walking away from the school, and that she has seen in the past on several occasions walking near the school recently. Ms. Apap further advised me that she had contacted the police department about this male a

few weeks ago when she saw him walking near the school on Rosalie Street right after student drop off.

I contacted D/Sgt. Snyder and advised him of the matter.

I reviewed the school security cameras and observed the male at 1425 hrs walking east on Rosalie Street and walk onto school property and sit on the benches near Rosalie Street where the volleyball court is. The male sits on the benches by himself until 1505 hrs when he leaves, walking west on Rosalie Street, crossing 30th Street and walking out of the camera view. The male is wearing a yellow or gold colored sweatshirt and grey pants.

I then saw the same male again at 1823 hrs walking east on Rosalie Street, then turn north on 31st Street out of camera view at 1825 hrs. The male did not walk onto school property during this time frame.

On Friday June 4, 2021 I was dispatched to Warren Point School, 30-07 Broadway, on a report of a suspicion. Upon arrival I met with SRO DiPasquale who informed me that an individual on a bicycle entered school property and interrupted an out door gym class. SRO DiPasquale stated an similar incident occurred earlier this week which he documented where the same individual watched a Girls Scouts class that occurred after school.

After conducting an area search [REDACTED] located the bicycle matching the description I relayed to the surrounding units in front of [REDACTED] belonging to a Mr. Aidan Bazakian. Mr. Bazakian is known to me because of previous encounters with him as an emotionally disturbed person. Aiden confirmed he was indeed on school grounds twice this week. I informed Aiden in front of his father that he was not allowed to be on Warren Point school grounds at any time or he would be charged with trespass.

I informed SRO DiPasquale of my discovery in the event that Aiden returns to school property. I responded to Warren Point to speak with the Principal and advised her of the disposition.

Narrative

On Tuesday, July 27, 2021, while operating in a plain clothes detective position, I was in the area of River Road and Berdan Avenue when I observed a white male, later identified as Colin McCann, wandering in the area with what seemed to be any purpose to be there. McCann appeared to be homeless as he was extremely dirty and disheveled. I began to watch McCann as he appeared that he might start panhandling at the surrounding businesses.

As I continued to observe McCann, he exited the parking lot of 12-06 River Road (7-11 Convenience Store) and began to head south. McCann walked approximately 100 feet then turned back to head north on River Road. McCann walked north to Fair Lawn Avenue and began walking west. As McCann got near the Fair Lawn Avenue Bridge, he then turned south on 2nd Street. McCann then turned west on Lambert Road and walked to 12-00 1st Street (Memorial Middle School). I then observed McCann in the front parking lot of the school and enter the driver's side door of a silver Honda Accord NJ Reg: Y41LGH and rummage through the vehicle. After approximately 30 seconds, McCann exits the vehicle and walks south on 1st Street. I then stopped McCann, advised him of my observations and placed him under arrest.

Sgt. Yuskitas and PO Hintzen arrived on scene to assist.

McCann was searched and found to have a large amount of change in a bag that he was carrying. McCann was then secured in RMP 904. McCann was transported to FLPD HQ and secured in the processing room. A back seat search of RMP 904 was conducted prior to and after transport with negative results.

I spoke with the victim and owner of vehicle, Kaitlyn Cohen, who was working at the school and advised her of the incident. Cohen confirmed that she had change (totaling \$6.61) in the driver's door compartment and that it was missing. Cohen confirmed that the change belonged to her as there were two charms with the letters "E" and "H" mixed with the change. All the money and charms were returned to Cohen.

McCann was secured in the processing room. A personal search was conducted by PO Hintzen with negative results. A property report form was completed, McCann could not sign due to his condition of drug withdrawal, a copy is attached to this report.

McCann was charged with 2C:20-3A, theft. Summons #: 0217-S-2021-0000129 was issued for this charge with a scheduled court date of August 4, 2021.

McCann stated that he was ill due to having withdrawals from drug addiction and wished to be transported to the hospital. FLVAC 933 was dispatched and arrived at FLPD HQ. McCann and his belongings were transported to New Bridge Medical Center without incident.

All officers cleared without further incident.

On this date January 20th 2022 at 8:30a.m. I was assigned to Thomas Edison Elementary as School Resource Officer Unit#716. During the course of this day there were questions by teachers and staff on the origin of 2 large carnival size stuff animals(one Pink Teddy bear and one blue frog)that were placed inside in front of the receptionist's desk. These two stuff animals appeared to have been used and showed signs of wear. I asked around to all the teachers and staff if they had any knowledge of someone donating these stuff animals and no one knew any information. I reviewed the security footage and found the following, On Sunday January 16th, 2022 at 725pm a Red 4Dr. SUV pulled up and parked in front of the school with two occupants. The driver was a white male with a beard wearing a face mask, a black knit hat, black jacket, grey sweatpants, black and white sandals in his 30's years of age. The passenger was a white female wearing a beige knit hat and scarf, black jacket, red pants and black boots, shoulder length brown hair, in her 30's years of age. As they exited the red SUV, they each placed a stuff animal outside the front door of the school, then returned to their vehicle and left the school property.

On the following day, Monday January 17th, 2022 at 6:50am the video captures Thomas Edison Elementary Female Custodian(Julia) bringing inside the stuff animals and placing them in front of the receptionist's desk. I asked Julia the school custodian if she had any knowledge of who may have dropped the stuff animals in front of the school and she stated she did not know. It is unknown on the intent of these individuals who placed these stuff animals in front of the school's main door.

Fairlawn Board of Education Security Director Robert Licamara was notified. The stuff animals were immediately removed and discarded from the premises. Phillip Freels from the IT Dept. was informed to secure the video footage for future reference.

On March 18, 2022 I was assigned to Thomas Jefferson Middle School as the School Resource Officer.

At about 1038 hours I exited the school at exit 6c which is in the new building.

From that exit I am able to see the dirt section of Dorothy Street, the baseball field, the pump house, tennis courts, and the wooded area. I noticed a white male who was wearing a light colored tee shirt and a pair of dark shorts which were similar to tennis shorts. It was difficult to tell his age due to the distance, but he appeared to be 30 years old or less. This male was just about at the end of the dirt roadway and was facing Thomas Jefferson Middle school. He stood there for a few seconds, turned around and walked toward Morlott Avenue. I left the area where I was and walked over to the dirt road. (This is part of my normal patrolling of the school property). When I arrived at the end of the dirt roadway, I noticed the male had crossed Morlott Avenue and continued onto the paved section of Dorothy. He was not jogging or walking fast, he was walking fairly slow.

While I looked around the area of the dirt roadway, I noticed a used condom on the ground in the middle of the roadway in the same area the male was standing. The condom was not dirty from ground dirt, had not been trampled on, and appeared to have been recently placed there. This area is frequented by the children from the middle school all day long. So the children were not exposed to it, I removed it and disposed of it in a garbage can. The fluid in the condom, which appeared to be semen, was not coagulated, it flowed freely as I removed the condom to the trash.

I reviewed the video from the school and noticed that that male had walked from Morlott Avenue to the dirt section of Dorothy to the end where I found the condom. It is not known at this time if the condom was from this male.

I notified the two Vice Principals of the school and the sector car.

On February 7, 2022 I was assigned to Thomas Jefferson Middle School as the School Resource Officer.

While at the location I was approached by the school nurse, Tiffany Schindler. Tiffany advised me that when she checked her school voicemail messages today she came across two that were disturbing. The voice message system at the school identifies if the call comes from within or outside the school. The two messages she received came from within the school and were made on Wednesday February 2. The call details were: 1807 hours from room 218 and 1820 hours from room 219. These two rooms are located in the old building on the second floor. The nature of the two calls were sexual, made by what appeared to be a male voice, who may have a very strong accent. The caller states, "Hello nurse?, pussy, thank you, (moaning) have a good day, bye bye, (the sound of a kiss, pussy". The other call appeared to be made from the same person and was difficult to understand.

Principal Weaver was notified as well as the head of school security, Robert Licamara.

I was able to look back at the video on the date and time the calls were made. It appeared the only person within the two rooms was a person identified as Ardian Husi. The identification was made by an employee of the Fair Lawn BOE John Yobs and an Aramark supervisor, Gene Frangipane. Ardian is a custodian with Aramark the company contracted to clean the school.

At this time the Board of Education will be handling the incident in house. Robert Licamara also advised me that on January 26 and 28, 2022, there were a total of three other calls made to another individual outside of the school. January 26: room 223 at 1628.34 and 1652.22. January 28 room 6223 at 1618.01. These calls appeared to have been made by the same person and that person uttered similar words including, "pussy". We reviewed the cameras on those dates and found it appeared that Ardian Husi was again the only person in the room during those calls. Licamara will advise the complainant if they would like to come forward to report these incidents they can contact the police department.

FLHS Principal Paul Gorski, emailed me stating that Ocean Dou (actor), has contacted a teacher at the high school through messaging system. Dou writes in his message,

"Hello Mr. Coesfeld. I've been trying to reach you for a very long time. I need to ask you something. I was in your biology class. And one day you said in a low volume in class: "Your purpose in life is to reproduce." My memory is fuzzy so I need you to tell me if you actually said that. I take biology very seriously. I tried very hard in class to impress you but I suffered from mental illness. This is very important to me. Please email me back at "[REDACTED]" or call me on "[REDACTED]". Thank you."

Ocean Dou has been advised before not to have any contact with Fair Lawn School District Staff or to be on any Fair Lawn School property (see 19-16398). On 09/18/2019 Ocean Dou came to Fair Lawn High School and was then arrested for trespassing (see 19-16470). It was reiterated at that time again, that he was to have no contact of any kind with FL school staff.

At 1000 hours I spoke to Ocean Dou and his mother, Jennifer Hong, about the incident and reminded them that there is no contact of any kind with the school and it's staff. Ocean expressed confusion over the statement and replied that he thought he was only not allowed to come to the high school. I repeated no contact of any kind again and he seemed to understand, explaining that he would seek answers elsewhere.

I informed Principal Paul Gorski and District Security Supervisor Robert Licarmara, that a report would be on file and how to file charges if they choose to do so.

Narrative

On Friday January 14, 2022 at approximately 1200 hours I was notified by an adult student who stated that he lost his wallet in the school yesterday. I was assigned to Fair Lawn High School (14-00 Berdan Ave) as the SRO and utilized RMP SR1.

The student, Abdullah Rashid (victim, eighteen years old), stated that he lost his wallet in the high school yesterday (01/13/2022) sometime after school. Rashid and I watched the school's security camera footage and observed him dropping the wallet at 1513 hours on the 1st floor D Wing. An Aramark custodian, Margie Henry, is near the wallet when it is dropped and picks it up approximately 30 seconds later when she sees it. Margie Henry is then seen on video opening up the wallet and looking through it. A few minutes later Margie Henry takes a rolling cart into a nearby closet and cannot be seen on camera. Margie Henry exits the storage closet with a plastic bag, which was on the cart, and throws it into the garbage. Margie Henry then appears to take another bag of garbage, which was already in the garbage, and place it on top of the one that she just put in.

I informed Gene Frangipane (Aramark General Manager) of the incident, showed him the security footage, and asked him if he could help locate the wallet. Frangipane stated that he looked in the possible areas where it should have been or stored, but could not find anything. Frangipane stated that he and Julius Cayruth (Aramark Nighttime Custodial Manager) then called Margie Henry and asked her if she found a wallet and she said no. Frangipane and Cayruth, then reviewed the security footage and confirmed the incident. Frangipane stated that they would check again with Henry when she arrived at work. Upon Henry's arrival, she changed her statement and stated that she did find a wallet, but that she left it on the cart. Frangipane stated that when they asked why she didn't turn it in or notify anyone, she did not give a response. Cayruth stated that he reported the incident to the Aramark Human Resources Department.

The victim was updated on the findings and advised that a report would be on file. The victim was given a Voluntary Statement Sheet, which he could complete if he chose to do so. The victim stated that his wallet was a Louis Vuitton wallet (approximately \$400), which contained approximately \$80-\$100 in cash, two \$25 gift cards (Dunkin, Nike), his driver's license, a Chase debit card, a Hollister employee ID, and his Fair Lawn Library Card. The security footage of the incident was burned onto a DVD which was entered into the Spillman System. The FLHS Principal (Paul Gorski) and the FL District Maintenance Supervisor (John Yobs) were notified of the incident and that a report would be on file.

Narrative

On 3/16/22 at 0918 hrs. I was informed by Chief Cauwels of a suspicious incident at Fair Lawn High School. Fair Lawn School's Superintendent Nicholas Norcia contacted the Chief and informed him that a teacher may have been surreptitiously filming students at Fair Lawn High School.

D/Lt Leitman, D/Sgt Snyder, and I responded to the high school and met with Superintendent Norcia, Principal Paul Gorski, and Security Supervisor Robert Licamara. Mr. Norcia informed us that teacher, Andrew Temme, (suspect) is assigned to the FLHS Planetarium. On 3/15/22 Mr. Norcia was made aware from a teacher, Jeanmarie Anicito that Temme was filming students which is against school policy.

On 3/15/22 at 2230 hrs. Mr. Norcia responded to the planetarium along with Mr. Gorski. Once inside the room, they observed a camera mounted on the ceiling to the right of the door and one mounted under a film projector in the middle of the room. Both cameras were facing the middle of the room where seats are located for students. Mr. Norcia is unsure if the cameras were purchased by the Board of Education but did state that cameras are not to be utilized in classrooms. Once Mr. Norcia observed the cameras he contacted Fair Lawn Teacher's Union Representative Troy Knudsen. Mr. Norcia instructed Mr. Knudsen that Tamme was immediately placed on administrative leave and was not to enter the school. Shortly after speaking to Knudsen, Tamme arrived at the planetarium. Mr. Norcia asked Tamme why he was there and he informed Mr. Norcia that he wanted to make sure that his plants weren't over watered. Mr. Norcia ordered Tamme to leave the school which he did. Mr. Norcia also informed me that Tamme had remotely gained access to the school's computer system on 3/16/22 at 0430 hrs.

Mr. Norcia turned over the following items,

- 1- Apple Laptop serial # C02W10GPJ16C
- 2- Amcrest 2K cameras
- 1- Apple Laptop serial # D25HXDP8DHJT
- 1- Dell Hard drive BOE # 20162102
- 1- Apple Laptop serial # C02H75BMDJGR

I responded to Thomas Jefferson Middle School and spoke to witness, Jeanmarie Anicito. Ms. Anicito stated that on 3/15/22 she took a group of middle school students to the high school planetarium for a field trip. Once in the planetarium she observed Tamme seated behind a computer and the students watched a presentation. During the presentation Ms. Ancito walked past Tamme and observed a recording of several students in the class on his computer screen. Ms. Ancito thought nothing of it at the time but walked past Tamme's computer several minutes later. This time when Ms. Ancito walked by she observed Tamme's computer screen was zoomed in onto a female student. The screen showed the area of the female's chest to her knees. When Tamme noticed Ms. Ancito he quickly pulled up another application to remove the view from the screen. Ms. Ancito informed me that she thought this was suspicious and notified Mr. Norcia through her chain of command.

I contacted the Bergen County Prosecutor's Office and spoke to Det. McCann.

I informed Det. McCann of the circumstances of this case and he instructed me to return the computers to the Fair Lawn Board of Education to have their IT department view the contents of the computers.

D/Lt Leitman, D/Sgt Snyder, and I returned all of the above equipment to Mr. Norcia. On 3/16/22 at approx. 1400 hrs. Mr. Norcia informed me that as of then they have found only videos and photos of clothed students.

On Monday March 21, 2022 at approximately 1030 hours I was notified of backwards swastikas found in a Fair Lawn High School restroom (14-00 Berdan Ave). I was assigned to the high school at the time and utilized RMP SR1.

FLHS Principal Paul Gorski stated that a parent of student Benjamin Garfinkle (adult) reported to the school's main office that there were swastikas found in the B Wing 1st Floor Boys Room. Gorski explained that a friend of Benjamin Garfinkle's had reportedly observed the swastikas sometime last week, possibly Wednesday March 16, 2022, and notified him of the issue. Gorski stated that he checked the bathrooms and found backwards swastikas (sauwastikas) faintly carved in two of the stall doors. The bathroom was then locked and secured until the damage is remedied. It is unknown how long the damage has been there or who did it.

Images of the swastikas on the stall doors was entered into the Spillman System. I advised Gorski that a report would be on file and cleared the scene without further incident.
