11. Narrative

Northvale units responded to 246 Livingston St, the Shoprite of Northvale, on the report of a shoplifter near the self-checkout area of the establishment. Patrol spoke with the on-scene Loss prevention employee who advised he observed the defendant fail to pay for approximately \$67.56 worth of various grocery items. While speaking with employees on scene they were able to print a receipt for the aforementioned items, the defendant was then advised that he was being placed under arrest for shoplifting. He was placed into handcuffs by P.O. Milordo #33 then placed into the rear of car 202 and advised of his Miranda rights. Northvale units transported the defendant back to NVPD HQ without incident. While in HQ the defendant was advised of his Miranda rights again, fingerprinted, photographed and given a copy of complaint summons 0240-S-2023-000045. While being processed the loss prevention employee from Shoprite responded to complete a voluntary statement form.

The defendant was advised of his virtual court date of 11/13/2023 and was also given a notice of trespass, verbally, for the Shoprite of Northvale, 246 Livingston St. The defendant was given a courtesy transport by P.O. Milordo #33 in car 202 back to the Shoprite of Northvale to retrieve other items he had already purchased from the Shoprite and was sent on his way.

11. Narrative

Northvale police responded to 254 Livingston Street (ShopRite Liquors) on a report of a theft that occurred in the past. Police arrived on scene and met with an employee who advised a group of six individuals came into the store around 2045hours on Tuesday 10/24/2023 and stole three items worth \$133.97 from the store. These items consisted of one 750ml bottle of Casamigos tequila, one 750ml bottle of Espolon tequila, and one 750ml bottle of Chinola passionfruit liqueur. Employee stated that six African American males entered the store placed the mentioned bottles underneath their clothing and then exited the store without paying. Employee further states that these parties left in NY registration GBV1180.

Video footage of the shoplifting parties is stored in a flash drive along with this report. A copy of the receipt listing the stolen goods is attached to this report. Detective Bureau was notified.

Northvale police responded to 250 Livingston Street (Phillips 66 Food Mart) on a report of a burglary. 11. Narrative

Northvale police responded to 246 Livingston Street on a report of a shoplifter being held at the customer care counter. Police arrived on scene and met with the witness, a loss prevention officer for ShopRite, who advised PD that the defendant had walked past all points of sale with merchandise concealed. PD then spoke with the defendant who confirmed the same. Defendant was then placed in handcuffs and transported by P.O. D.Leenas in Unit 202 to police headquarters to be processed.

Defendant arrived at headquarters and was processed. Defendant was charged with 2C:20-11B(1) Shoplifting by concealing merchandise totaling \$93.03. Defendant was provided with all necessary paperwork and provided a courtesy transport back to 246 Livingston Street by P.O. D.Leenas in Unit 202. Transport was completed without issue and the defendant's shopping bag was retrieved from ShopRite and returned to him.

Defendant was verbally advised that he could no longer return to the Northvale ShopRite and that returning to the store at any time would be considered trespassing.

Northvale police responded to 119 Paris Avenue (Kearny Bank) on a report of a fraud. 237 arrived on scene and spoke with an employee of Kearny Bank who advised that an unknown male party had entered the bank on Wednesday 10/18/2023 at approximately 1406 hours and cashed a check for \$2000. Employee further states the unknown male party provided a credit card and driver's license to the bank teller that matched the name on the check. 11. Narrative				
Northvale Units responded to [REDACTED] Snedecker Place for the report of a possible burglary that occurred in the past. The caller reports arriving at the residence around 1900hrs and observing the living room window on the east side of the home had been broken, and a secondary window was observed ajar. The time frame in which the residents had not been home was believed to be 0750hrs-1900hrs on today's date. It was observed that jewelry cases and bags were dumped out and gone through in the bedrooms located on the second floor. A single office on the first floor was also observed to have bookshelves rummaged through and items scattered throughout. 231 and 236 conducted an interior check of the home as 526 of Harrington Park stood at the rear exterior of the home. The results were negative for any suspects within. Bergen County Sheriff's Department was contacted by County Communications to request a Crime Scene Investigation Unit. BCSO Detective Mike Vermeylen #1639 arrived and processed the scene (Case#2023-0971). In processing the scene, Det. Vermeylen was unable to obtain any manipulation marks on the entry points and or within the bedrooms as no prints were obtained from any surfaces. At this time, it was believed that a brown Louis Vuitton wallet valued at \$800dollars was taken from the 2nd floor of the home. The wallet was said to have contained \$100 dollars in cash and a Wells Fargo Debit card which was immediately cancelled (No activity observed on card). A secondary item believed to have been taken was a pearl ring from the owner bedroom valued at 2 thousand dollars (No photo available of ring). The surrounding area was canvassed for surveillance footage, and any resident home at the time of canvassing was advised to forward any suspicious vehicles/persons found on their camera. Det. Bureau to investigate further. On 10/16/23 at approximately 10:05 AM the victim contacted patrol and advised that she had discovered some other items that were missing from her residence from the burglary that occurred. The victim stated that she was also missing a diamond necklace valued at approximately \$1500.00 and approximately \$2,000.00 in US Cash.

11. Narrative

Shop Rite Liquors contacted Northvale HQ reporting a shoplifting that occurred on 10/5/23. Shop Rite Liquors staff provided this officer with surveillance footage showing three male parties entering the store, appearing as if they were shopping for alcoholic beverages. Two of the three male parties take a bottle of alcohol to the counter and attempt to purchase same. While the two male parties are at the counter (subsequently being denied the purchase due to neither of them having identification on their persons) the third male party is observed on camera placing a \$34.99 bottle of Asbury Park Distilling Co. Espresso Lemoncello in his pants. After the two male parties were denied the purchase, they return the bottle to the shelf and all three males exit the store. Employees on scene, however, were able to take a picture of the license plate of the vehicle the three males arrived and departed in (see above).

A copy of the receipt was scanned into this entry, and video footage was provided to PD via USB. TOT Det. Bureau.

11. Narrative				
Northvale units responded to [REDACTED] Woodland Avenue for report of a possible burglary that occurred in the past. The caller reports arriving at the residence to check on the home for his step-father, who is the home-owner. The resident was taken by the caller to have a medical procedure done on 09/26/2023 at approximately 10AM at Hackensack University Medical Center. This is the first time they returned home to check the mail and grab belongings. It was reported that jewelry cases were dumped out and gone through in the bedrooms. 220 and 223 conducted an interior check of the home. It was reported that the rear door has difficulty closing and remaining secure which is believed to be the entry point. The witness stated he saw the rear door left ajar when they were inside the home. Bergen County Sheriff's Department was contacted by County Communications to request a Crime Scene Investigation Unit. BCSO Detective Carla Ham #1801 arrived and processed the scene (Case#2023-0932). In processing the scene, Det. Ham was able to determine that the actor(s) had used gloves in the commission of the burglary as she was able to lift material prints from some of the surfaces. The caller stated that his step-father hadn't told many people of his recent surgery and that his step-father rarely has any guests in and out of the house. At this time, between jewelry and cash, proceeds stand at approximately \$1000. The surrounding area was canvassed for surveillance footage, and any resident home at the time of canvassing was advised to forward any suspicious vehicles/persons found on their camera. Det. Bureau to investigate further. On 10/16/23 at approximately 11 AM the victim arrived at HQ and advised that he had determined that some more items from his residence were missing. The victim stated that he was missing various gift cards in the amount of approximately \$500.00, approximately \$15,000.00 in gold coins, half of a bottle of Wiskey, a small box of miscellaneous jewelry with an unknown value, an unknown amount of cash out of his deceased wife's wallet, some boxes full of unknown items on the top shelf in his closet, approximately \$1900.00 in cash, approximately 5 Two
