11. Narrative

While within the CITGO gas station located at 258 Livingston Street, 231 observed the above victim place several \$100 dollar bills into a Bitcoin Machine located within the business. As this officer is aware of common scams associated with parties utilizing the machine within the CITGO, contact was made.

While making contact, this officer asked if all was ok as the victim was observed on his cellphone and appeared to be uneasy. The victim advised he was called from a (305)334-0122, and (217)408-9376 while in the library of the Westpoint Academy and was advised by "DEA Agents" that he was currently under investigation and had warrants for his arrest for the crime of drug trafficking. The victim was advised to immediately hang up the phone and cease placing anymore cash into the machine as this was a common scam. When asked if any personal information was given over the phone, the victim alleged that the only voluntarily given information was his name and address. A total amount of \$8,100 dollars was place into the machine, but the victim was unable to cancel the transaction. The victim stated he was in possession of a total of 25 thousand dollars in cash, \$8,100 of which was entered at the request of the unknown "agents". A receipt was obtained on scene and all information was obtained from the Bitcoin machine with options for the victim. The victim was also advised to contact his commanding officers, and or local police that oversee the Westpoint Academy as the initial contact occurred within their jurisdiction.

A copy of the Bitcoin receipt was also scanned into this entry.

11. Narrative

Northvale units responded to 191 Paris Ave, Biddy O'Malley's, on the report of keys and a vehicle that were stolen by an ex-employee. Patrol arrived on scene and spoke with the involved party who alleged while working his shift the ex-employee "Kevin" came into the establishment and took the keys to NY reg KFX1074 and now was in possession of the keys and vehicle. A family member of Kevin reached out to the involved party and stated that Kevin was arrested in upstate NY. Patrol advised county communications to contact the NY state police to see if they were in possession of the vehicle which they advised they were not. While speaking with the involved party he advised he was not the RO and had no further information to provide at this time. Kevin is believed to live on Veterans Dr, but no further pedigree information could be gathered due to the owner of Biddy O'Malley's being on vacation who has possession of the information.

232 responded to the RO's address in Tappan, NY and requested the assistance of Orangetown PD. 233 checked Veterans Dr for the vehicle which yielded negative results. Patrol spoke with the RO and advised him the vehicle would be reported as stolen and was asked if he had any questions to which he replied no. The vehicle was entered as stolen into NCIC (NIC/V125552937). Detective Bureau to be notified of same.

11. Narrative

Northvale units responded to 153 Paris Avenue (Il Giardino) on a report of a window that was broken by a male party who fled the scene. Upon arrival 233 spoke with the caller and witness while 232 and 217 searched the area for the actor. The actor was described as a white male wearing a black jacket and dark colored shorts. The witness was unable to provide any further clothing description but did advise that the male party was on a cellular phone and seemed to be frantic. The male party was then observed to have fled the area on foot traveling North on Livingston Street. The witness advised she was in the rear of the restaurant working when she heard three loud bangs at which point one of the large glass window pains in the front of the restaurant was broken.

232 then advised he was out with the involved party matching the description of the actor in the area of Cleatus Farm (236 Livingston Street). A photo of the involved party was then shown to the witness who confirmed the individual as the actor. The involved party was asked what had occurred to which he stated he went to sit down on the bench in front of Il Giardino and when he sat down the bench went through the window. The involved party then contacted his father and became overwhelmed at the situation which is why he fled the area on foot.

The caller and witness were advised the Incident would be documented along with their right to sign a complaint against the involved party and provided a copy of the complaint signing forms.
