NARRATIVE

On Tuesday 12/14/2021, I Detective Scott Luks # 410 was assigned as the School Resource Officer for Edison High school. I was contacted by School Principal/Victim Charles Ross in regards to a student that was found to be in possession of suspected marijuana. A school investigation yielded the following:

At approximately 10:05 hrs, School Security Officer/Witness Santeagro Brown noticed that adult student/suspect Adonnis James "Smelled like weed". He was escorted by school Security to the Administration Offices and was subsequently found by the school's Administration to be in possession of a purple "EcoPow UGO-V3" the vape pen with brown liquid in the cartridge, a pink and black "REV flair" vape pen labeled with "Pink lemonade 5%", and a purple plastic envelope with a picture of an astronaut on the sides containing suspected marijuana. All those items were found within a US Postal Service bubble mailer envelope. The school administration secured the contraband and contacted suspect James' guardian Witness [REDACTED] to respond to the school.

Upon her arrival to the school at approximately 11:15, Witness [REDACTED] met with suspect James in the main office. During the conversation, she took his phone away. Once [REDACTED] took suspect James' phone away from him, he became extremely irate, began to have a tantrum and was shouting and angry. During this behavior, while in the main office of the Edison High School, suspect James picked up an antique wooden table/school desk worth approximately \$100.00 and threw it onto the ground breaking it into pieces. The antique school desk belonged to School Principal/victim Charles Ross. Once suspect James broke the desk, he punched the glass pane of the main office door causing it to smash into pieces and fly into the hallway and office vestibule. Suspect James then fled the school. As a result of the glass

getting punched and broken, School Assistant Principal/victim Aurora Loufek who was standing next to the door when it was punched, sustained a laceration on her left forearm near her wrist. The glass door pane is worth approximately \$350.00. This all occurred in the main office of the school in front of staff and other students.

Upon my arrival, I observed the broken desk, and shattered glass as well as the bleeding coming from victim Loufek's arm. I was given the contraband and I spoke with witness [REDACTED] and Victim Loufek about the incident.

The purple "EcoPow UGO-V3" the vape pen with brown liquid in the cartridge, the pink and black "REV flair" vape pen labeled with "Pink lemonade 5%", the purple plastic envelope with a picture of an astronaut on the sides containing suspected marijuana, and the US Postal Service bubble mailer envelope were all entered into evidence.

After speaking with the school Administration, they wish to have criminal complaints signed in this matter. I completed complaint summons # 1205-S-2022-000012 for NJS 2C:17-3A(1) criminal mischief and 2C:33-2A(1) disorderly conduct. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The total amount of damage is approximately \$450.00.

[REDACTED] I served suspect James with his copy of the summons and advised him how to contact the Edison Municipal Court.

Nothing further to report. Case closed by Complaint.
