Dear Anonymous:

This office is in receipt of your request for records under the New Jersey Open Public Records Act (OPRA). Please be advised that, at this time, this office is not in possession of CAD entries, audio of 911 calls or an arrest report in this matter. You may wish to submit your request for these records to the Little Egg Harbor Township Police Department

Please be further advised that police/incident reports are considered criminal investigatory records that are exempt from disclosure under OPRA, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1, et seq. Therefore, your request for these reports is denied.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at Government.Records@dca.nj.gov or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

With this letter, the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office considers your OPRA request to be fulfilled. Should you disagree with our decision, please contact us in writing with your concerns

so that we may consider them. If I can be of further assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me.
