reporting party and victim, Ms. Christine Skurbe of the Oak Tree Parent Teachers Association.

While speaking to Ms. Skurbe, she stated that she has been harassed by a fellow PTA member, Ms. Ivelisse A. Miranda-Holmes. Ms. Skurbe reported that she is the president of the PTA and Ms. Miranda-Holmes is the second vice president. Ms. Skurbe states she has been harassed as far back as January of 2011. Ms. Skurbe states that Ms. Miranda-Holmes has sent her harassing e-mails and has harassed her in person. Ms. Skurbe further stated that on 4/14/2011 the harassment became physical. Ms. Skurbe stated that while arriving at Oak Tree Elementary School she was confronted by Ms. Miranda-Holmes. Ms. Skurbe stated that during the encounter she was grabbed on her arm. (See attached written statement)

Ms. Skurbe stated that she wanted to sign complaints for the harassment as well as the simple assault. I supplied Ms. Skurbe with the appropriate statutes and explained her the process for completing the complaints. I did not contact Ms. Miranda-Holmes about the matter at the specific request of Ms. Skurbe. Ms. Skurbe was also advised to furnish a copy of the e-mails to be added to this report.

On May 5, 2011 at 2150hrs, I responded to police headquarters for a harassment report.

Upon arrival, I was met by the reporting person, Ivelisse Miranda-Holmes. Ms. Miranda-Holmes explained that she is the vice president of the Oak

Tree Elementary School PTA, and has been having problems with the PTA president, Christine Skurbe. Ms. Miranda-Holmes alleges that Ms. Skurbe has been harassing her via text messages and emails. Ms. Miranda-Holmes also alleges that Ms. Skurbe has been spreading rumors around the PTA, including a rumor that Ms. Ivelisse had attempted to run her over with her vehicle, and another rumor that Ms. Miranda-Holmes assaulted her in the Oak Tree Elementary School parking lot on April 14, 2011 at approximately 7:15 P.M. Ms. Miranda-Holmes believes Ms. Skurbe is spreading rumors in order to ruin her chances at winning an upcoming PTA election.

Ms. Miranda-Holmes explained that she has spoken with Principal Ventrello in an attempt to resolve the problem, but was unsatisfied with the outcome. Ms. Miranda-Holmes states that she has had to block Ms. Skurbe's phone number to prevent Ms. Skurbe from making further harassing communications. I advised Ms. Miranda-Holmes of complaint signing procedures and provided her with statute 2C:33-4.C for harassment. I cleared from the scene.

Nothing further at this time.

On the above date I responded to police headquarters to take a report of harassment. Upon arrival, I met the reporting person and the victim Mr.

Michael Gorski. Mr. Gorski stated that he was made aware that someone made threatening comments about him during a holiday party that took place at Oak Tree Elementary School on 12/22/2011. Mr. Gorski reported that he was advised by several people that Ms. Kimberly Chaves stated, "I hate him" "I want him dead" and "I want to kill him". These comments were reportedly made in a public place where all who were able to could hear them. Mr. Gorski was told that Ms. Christine Skurbe heard these comments made directly and told others about them, and that is how Mr. Gorski found out. It was further reported that on 12/14/2011, at a public board meeting, Ms. Skurbe was heard saying, "He doesn't know who he is dealing with" in reference to her relation with Mr. Gorski.

Mr. Gorski stated the the conflict between he and Ms. Chaves stems from her discontent with decisions the Board of Education has made regarding student pick up and drop off in her development. Based on Mr. Gorski's role as a member of the Monroe Township Board of Education, I immediately notified Sgt. Spence. It was determined that this incident required a detective's input. Detective Dziomba and Detective Winn were then briefed on the situation and began to speak to Mr. Gorski. I then turned the call over to them.

On Friday, December 23, 2012 at approximately 14:00 I was informed that Ofc. Vella was currently taking a report regarding threats that were made.

Ofc. Vella briefed Det. Winn and I of the facts he had obtained thus far. Ofc. Vella stated that the reporting person, Mr. Michael Gorski is an employee with the Monroe Township Board of Education. Ofc. Vella stated that Mr. Gorski had been made aware that a comment was made by a parent to another parent stating to the effect that she wanted to kill Mr. Gorski. Mr. Gorski was not present at the time the comment was made.

In speaking with Mr. Gorski, it was learned that he was dealing with a parent, Mrs. Kimberly Chaves, regarding an issue she was having with the school buses. Mr. Gorski stated that Mrs. Chaves has written several letters and E-mails to him and attended board meetings in an attempt to voice her opinion on the issue of the courtesy late bus that is provided to Monroe Township High School students. Mr. Gorski stated that he has tried to express to Mrs. Chaves that he does not make the decisions about the buses, and is only a line of communication from the Board of Education.

Mr. Gorski stated that he was made aware of the threats from a board member, Mr. Louis Masters. Mr. Masters had been told about the threats from Mrs. Christine Skurbe, who heard the threat directly. Mrs. Skurbe is a parent of a child who attends Oak Tree Elementary School. It was at Oak Tree Elementary School where Mrs. Skurbe reportedly heard Mrs. Chaves make the threat against Mr. Gorski.

Mr. Gorski stated that Mrs. Chaves is a "classroom parent" at Oak Tree Elementary School, which means she is often in the school and participates in organizing classroom events. Mr. Gorski further stated that he does not feel that he is in danger based on the alleged threat, however he is concerned about Mrs. Chaves' conduct regarding her continuing participation as a "classroom parent".

Det. Winn and I advised Mr. Gorski that we would further the investigation by speaking with Mrs. Skurbe and Mrs. Chaves.

I contacted Mrs. Skurbe and she responded to Monroe Township Police Headquarters to speak with us. Mrs. Skurbe stated that she is also a "classroom parent" for her child who is a 1st grader in Mrs. Fedora's class at Oak Tree Elementary School. She stated that Mrs. Chaves is also a "classroom parent" in this particular class. Mrs. Skurbe stated that on 12/22/11, they were in the class room preparing for a class party. Mrs. Skurbe stated that Mrs. Chaves was present along with a few other parents.

Mrs. Skurbe stated that she and Mrs. Chaves were having a

conversation about Mrs. Chaves' issue about Mr. Gorski and the late bus. Mrs. Skurbe stated that as Mrs. Chaves spoke she became visibly upset and looked as if she were going to cry. Mrs. Chaves then stated "I'm just so mad at him, I just want to kill him (Mr. Gorski)". Mrs. Skurbe stated it appeared the comment was made out of frustration. Mrs. Skurbe stated that was the only comment that Mrs. Chaves made of that nature. Mrs. Skurbe stated she was concerned about the comment and felt she should report the comment. She then told Mr. Masters about what Mrs. Chaves had said. Mrs. Skurbe stated that she did not feel the threat was to the level where it would be carried out, or that Mr. Gorski was in imminent danger.

I then contacted Mrs. Chaves and asked her to come to Monroe Police Headquarters. Mrs. Chaves was advised of her Miranda rights and the interview was recorded. Mrs. Chaves stated to the effect that she had been dealing with Mr. Gorski over the past few months, regarding an issue she was having with the school buses and where her children are dropped off. Mrs. Chaves stated that she wanted the school to drop her children off in front of her house instead of at the entrance to the development, which she states is a mile down the road. Mrs. Chaves stated her concern stems from an accident that one of her sons was in when he was 4 years old. Mrs. Chaves stated that he was struck by a car and suffered serious injuries and almost died. Mrs. Chaves stated that her passion about the school bus issue is because she wants to protect her children, and knows what can be a possible outcome.

Mrs. Chaves stated that she recalls being at the classroom party on 12/22/11 and speaking with some of the other parents about Mr. Gorski. Mrs. Chaves stated that she has felt that she was not making any progress with the school bus issue and felt that Mr. Gorski was the reason. Mrs. Chaves stated that she was very frustrated with the current state of the issue. Mrs. Chaves recalls that out of emotion and frustration, she uttered something to the effect of "I'm just so mad. I just want to kill him." Mrs. Chaves contended that she often uses similar phrases regarding her children when they do not clean their rooms. Mrs. Chaves stated that she is indeed frustrated with Mr. Gorski, however she does not intend to harm or wish harm upon Mr. Gorski in any way. Mrs. Chaves stated she realized the seriousness of her comment and was apologetic for making it, especially in a school environment.

Based on the information gained from the interviews, there will be no criminal complaints pursued at this time and this case will be CLOSED.

at 18 Eldorado Way, Amarjit Singh is constantly harassing him for no reason. Mr. Patel advised me at approximately 0900 hours this morning, he was walking back to his house after putting his daughter on the bus and Mr. Singh yelled, "Ye Gandu, Ye Gandu, Ye Gandu!" Mr. Singh advised me this translates into "You Asshole!" Mr. Patel advised me another resident, Christine Skurbe of 8 Seminole Court was also present when this occurred, but she did not understand what the phrase meant. Mr. Patel advised me he did not respond and went home. Mr. Patel advised me he does not know why Mr. Singh would say this to him. Mr. Patel advised me he has previously reported other incidents involving Mr. Singh (See Incident #12006083). I advised Mr. Patel I would speak to Mr. Singh regarding this incident. I then provided him with a Monroe Township Citizen Information card, advised him how to sign a complaint for Harassment with the Court and how to obtain a copy of this report.

I then responded to 18 Eldorado Way, but was unable to speak with Mr. Singh. I then left a Citizen Information Card in Mr. Singh's mailbox, advising him to contact me.

I then returned to headquarters and spoke to Mr. Singh. Mr. Singh advised me he did not say anything to Mr. Patel today. Mr. Singh advised me he does not have a problem with Mr. Patel and advised me Mr. Patel harasses him. I advised Mr. Singh to avoid Mr. Patel to prevent further confrontation.

I then contacted Mr. Patel and advised him I spoke to Mr. Singh regarding this incident. Mr. Patel advised me he would sign a complaint against Mr. Singh if this continues. No further information. Cleared scene.

She said that she believed that Amarjit was harassing her because she requested the Board of Education move her children's bus stop away from Amarjit's driveway. At this time I spoke with Amarjit at his residence. I advised him why I was there and he stated that Christine and him were having an ongoing issue along with several other people in the community. He also said that Christine was the one that stopped in front of his house on 05-16-2012. He stated that once she stopped he called him an "ass hole" and that is when he "gave her the middle finger". I advised Amarjit to try and stay away from Christine and he was also advised how to sign complaints with the court if he wished. I then cleared the scene without incident.

I was advised that this information will be forwarded to a manager, and that the manager will contact me this evening to resolve this problem. I again explained to the customer service representative that I need someone to contact me this evening since this situation has to be addressed before school starts tomorrow.

At approximately 2245 hrs. I checked the above stated intersection, and observed that the sidewalks were still covered with snow. I made another attempt to contact Reliance Property Management Group, but their office was closed for the day.

On Monday morning October 15, 2018 I was contacted by Detective Nick Chiorello of the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office (MCPO). He contacted me to advise they had been in contact with a resident of Monroe Twp. named Christine Skurbe. She had reported to MCPO she believed Monroe Twp. PD reports had been improperly released to an unknown

person and then those same reports were utilized against her at a Monroe Twp. Board of Ed meeting. Det. Chiorello advised me his office had preliminarily reviewed her complaint and the copies of the reports, along with the OPRA forms she turned in to them associated with her complaint. At this time they do not feel a "Criminal" law had been violated and he was turning over what he had via e-mail to me for this agency to review and take what ever action we deem appropriate.

I made contact with Captain Biennas and turned over what I had to him. A short time later Captain Biennas advised me to look into the matter and see if anything was done wrong.

I reviewed the file of police reports along with the OPRA forms. It appeared the reports which were released were "Public" versions of the reports which are the appropriate version to be released to the public and do not include sensitive information which should not be released.

I then reviewed the proper directives for the release of public records which indicate police reports can be requested by a verbal, written, or OPRA request.

On Tuesday October 16, 2018 at 0959 hours I made contact via telephone with Mrs. Christine Skurbe. I advised her the matter she had brought to the attention of the MCPO had been turned over to this agency and I would be looking into the matter. I asked her to explain what her concerns were so I would be able to properly investigate the issue which was important to her.

Mrs. Skurbe explained she was trying to create a new Parent Association and someone provided police reports and letters to all of the members of the Board of Education as a "smear" against her to persuade the members to deny approval of her new organization based on her character they tried to paint poorly. She stated she OPRA'd the OPRA to see who requested the reports and she found Mrs. Regina Giacomini had requested the reports on August 3, 2018. Mrs. Skurbe states the police reports were requested specifically involving her name and for years of 2009-2012 and 2014-2015. Her issue is there were more reports in the packet for 2018 which were not requested and she believes someone improperly received police reports about her and she wanted to know who did this to her. She stated she spoke with Mrs. Giacomini who denies having ever received the 2018 reports.

I advised Mrs. Skurbe police reports are not always received through an

OPRA request and I briefly explained Executive Order 69 regarding the release of public records. I further advised the report copies she is referencing all have an August 3, 2018 date at the bottom meaning they were all printed the same day and I would assume the records clerk just printed all reports regarding what topic was requested and is not uncommon. Our agency's concern of improper conduct would be not providing the minimum of what was requested. I advised her the clerk who handles the records requests was currently out due to a death in the family and I would speak to her to find out if she knew what had been released when she returned. Mrs. Skurbe thanked me for my assistance.

On the Wednesday October 17, 2018 I spoke with records clerk Mrs. Teri Miller. I showed her the file of reports along with OPRA forms. I asked her if she knew how the added 2018 reports regarding Mrs. Skurbe were released and to whom they were released. Mrs. Miller advised me she had printed them and provided them to Mrs. Giacomini per the OPRA request. She explained she often will provide more than what is requested regarding specifically requested information because she will often have more requests for the same information if the requester finds out there is more available. Therefore she will print what she finds initially and provide the copies in addition to the original request.

Later this same date at 1329 hours, I contacted Mrs. Skurbe and explained what the records clerk had told me regarding this incident.

She thanked me for my assistance and advised she was pursuing an ethics complaint about this regarding the Board of Education. No further information.
