THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL - FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

On the above date and time Ptl. Hester and I responded to 17 Aztec Ct for a report of an overdose. Upon arrival Ptl. Hester observed the victim identified as [REDACTED] laying on the ground of the residence. Ptl. Hester asked the son, identified as Robert E Greaux, what [REDACTED] took and he advised he took a pill but doesn't know what kind of pill. Ptl. Hester administered 4mg of Narcan which yielded negative results. Ptl. Hester then administered a second dose of 4mg Narcan which [REDACTED] became alert and conscious. Upon [REDACTED] becoming alert and conscious we asked him what he took which he responded by saying he didn't take anything.

[REDACTED] was then transported to Community Medical Center by Berkeley Township First Aid (555). No evidence was observed on scene. And Narcan was left behind. An Arrive together referral form was filled out and emailed to arrive@brightharbor.org. No further action was taken at this time.
