On September 4, 2024 at 9:10AM (0910 hours) Ptl. Shick (5382), Ptl. Sicknick (5165) and I were dispatched to a report of a deceased body in a parking lot surrounded by pills and alcohol at 730 Jamaica Blvd. Upon arrival Ptl. Shick (5382) was met by Michael Elkins, the reporting party, while Ptl. Sicknick (5165) attempted to secure the scene. Medic truck #533 and #570 arrived at approximately the same time as officers. I along with medics began to assess the person who was found laying face down. The woman felt cold to the touch but was not showing signs of rigor mortis, as a result we rolled the female onto her back. Once on her back it became apparent she was still breathing, so paramedics began life saving measures. While paramedics began to work on the female I was able to find her ID identifying her as [REDACTED] South Toms River First Aid truck #376 then arrived on scene. [REDACTED] was loaded onto the ambulance and intubated. She was taken to Community Medical Center, and Ptl. Sicknick (5165) is staying with her at the hospital.

Ptl. Shick (5382) was able to get a statement from the witness, Michael Elkins, which read "I parked my car in the Wells Fargo parking lot exited my car saw what I thought was a bunch of garbage turned out to be a body I believed dead at least 6 bottles of empty pills booze." While Ptl. Shick (5382) collected the sheet from the witness Sgt. Colletti (5120) and I began investigating the scene when we found an obituary that she wrote for herself. As a result of this being an attempted suicide the Berkeley Township Detective Bureau was contacted and Detective Mayer (5131) and Detective Mulvihill (5112) responded.

Detective Mayer (5131) and Detective Mulvihill (5112) both photographed the scene and CSI and OCPO were requested. Both CSI and OCPO determined that they would not be responding at this time. I then took inventory of the evidence, which I will list at the bottom of the report and packaged it to take back to headquarters. Once back at headquarters I grouped the evidence together into different bags and logged them for evidence in Locker 1A. An evidence voucher was created for the property. At this time we are still waiting for an update on [REDACTED] condition, and this matter is still being actively investigated.
