On 09/21/2024 at 2038 hours I, Ptl. Wahl (#5125) of the Berkeley Township Police Department, responded to [REDACTED] in the Bayville, NJ section of Berkeley Township for report of an overdose. Berkeley Township Dispatch advised officers responding that the caller stated that their was a 16 year old female at this location who had ingested approximately 8-10 Aleve pills. Dispatch also advised that the female was alert and conscious.

Upon my arrival, I observed several people on scene. I located the female, identified as [REDACTED] was visually upset and crying. I asked her what she had taken and she stated that she took 8 Aleve pills. I asked her why she did it and she at first did not respond. I asked [REDACTED] if she took them to harm herself and she responded acknowledging that she did. [REDACTED] Heather Macri, was on scene. I asked Heather if she wished for [REDACTED] to be transported to Community Medical Center in Toms River, NJ for a medical and psychological evaluation. Heather advised me that she would like for her to be transported. I asked Heather where [REDACTED] parents were. Heather advised me that they were at a concert and already notified and were on there way home. [REDACTED] and Heather were then transported to the hospital via Berkeley Township EMS.

At the house, I spoke with [REDACTED] and Anthoy Artale, They all stated that they received a communication from [REDACTED] that she had taken some pills which is when they all responded to her house. They advised me that there was no apparent physical or psychological abuse in her home or from her boyfriend, but she was having issues with her current boyfriend. They advised me that she was battling an eating disorder and that it did have some affects on her mental health. They advised me that she has been struggling with her mental health for some time. I then advised DCP&P who advised me that they were not responding at this time. A CARES form was also completed and faxed over to Toms River Police Department as she attends [REDACTED]. I also spoke with Mark Manley, [REDACTED] who was advised of the incident.
