On the above date and time, I (Ptl. Robertazzi) was dispatched to a first aid call at 220 Atlantic City Blvd for the report of an unconscious male on a NJ Transit Bus.

Upon my arrival, I boarded the bus and was directed to the male, who was sitting down in the first row of seats. I conducted a series of Sternum rubs, and repeated attempts to elicit a response from the male, who at the time was still currently breathing. With the male's present condition, NARCAN was retrieved from my AED box and administered into the male's right nostril.

Within a short amount of time, the male started to move his arms and become more conscious. I attempted to speak with the male again, to which I got a response. The male was highly uncooperative, and would give little information and also refused medical attention. The male identified himself as [REDACTED] and would only state that he was born in January. [REDACTED] provided his phone number as well ([REDACTED]). The male then walked off the bus stating that he had to use the restroom.

I then spoke to the Bus Driver, who was identified as Tracey Weal who stated that the male was picked up in Lakewood, and asked her to stop at this WaWa. Ms. Weal then stated that when she went to wake the male up, he was not responding, thus prompting her to call for emergency services. I was then clear with a report.
