The Carteret Borough Hall received your OPRA Records Act (NJSA 47:1A-1) dated October 28, 2019. The official Police Records Custodian, Captain Michael Dammann received your OPRA request on October 28, 2019. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is November 7, 2019. This response is being provided on the **Seventh (7th)** business day since the Carteret Police Departments records custodian received said request.

The following specific records have been requested:

“Please provide the redacted incident and/or police reports for all calls for harassment or possible harassment that police responded to with the call narratives. Please include 11/3/18 to 11/13/2018.”

Records responsive to this request have been located

These records are criminal investigatory records, and such are exempt from release under OPRA. Pursuant to NJSA 47:1A-1.1, criminal investigator records are “records which are not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file that are held by a law enforcement agency which pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding.”

For those reason listed above your request is denied.

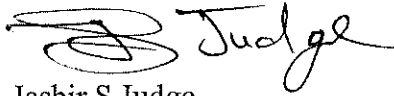
If you are requesting under common law, you must articulate your legal interest in the subject matter contained in the material, then the material may be disclosed if under a balancing act your right of access outweighs the State's interest in preventing disclosure.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days by law, you have the right to challenge the decision by the Carteret Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint form. In addition to the website, information can be
