The City of Brigantine has received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request dated December 22, 2017. The official Records Custodian, Lynn Sweeney, RMC, received your request on December 22, 2017. This response is being provided to you within the time required by OPRA.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

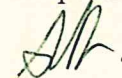
Please provide police squad schedule, roster for scheduled year 2012 and any personal changes throughout the year.

N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10 limits access to personnel files to the following information: an individual's name, title, position, salary, payroll record, length of service, date of separation and the reason therefor, and the amount and type of any pension record. OPRA does not authorize the disclosure of "duty assignments of law enforcement officers" as this information falls squarely within OPRA's general exemption for personnel records. See New Jersey Second Amendment Society v. Div. of State Police of the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, No. A-2396-11T3 (App. Div. May 14, 2015) (slip op. at 13). Furthermore, "exempting the duty assignments of law enforcement officers from disclosure is consistent with the officers' protection and that of the public." Id.

The information which you requested which is permitted to be disclosed pursuant to OPRA is attached hereto. The three documents provided encompass the entire roster for the City of Brigantine's Police Department for the 2012 calendar year. The documents cover the time periods of (1) January through August, 2012; (2) September through November, 2012 and (3) December, 2012.

This completes this OPRA request.
