The Blairstown Police Department is in receipt of your OPRA Request, dated March 4, 2021. You have requested "a list of the number of patrolman on duty, in patrol cars, during a normal weekday, 10 hour shift."

We do not have a list or "Patrol Shift Roster" that dictates our officers' schedules. Our patrol officers work twelve-hour shifts, either from 6AM-6PM or 12PM-12AM. On a twelve-hour shift, one to two patrol officers will be on-duty. We have an overlap of patrol on duty from 12PM-6PM daily. Our Detective works an eight-hour shift, Monday through Friday. On a given day, we may have 3-4 officers on duty using patrol cars.
