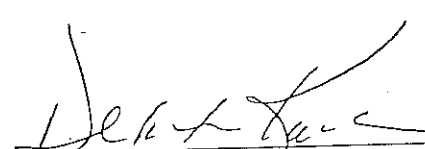
WHEREAS, a total of four (4) bids were received and opened on May 25, 2017; and

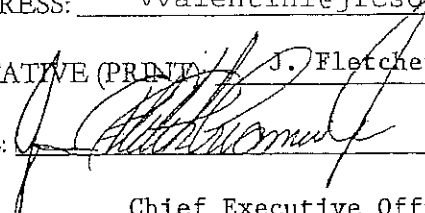

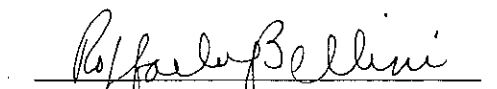

DEFINED TERMS:

Capitalized terms used in Bid Documents have the meanings assigned herein as set forth below.

Terms used in the Bid Documents have both singular and plural meanings.

ADDENDA: shall mean a written or graphic instrument issued by the Contractor before execution of the construction contract that modifies or interprets the bidding documents by additions, deletions, clarifications, or corrections.

BID: shall mean the completed and executed Specification Bid Form, enclosed Bid Security and any and all other information required in Instruction to Bidders.

BID DOCUMENTS: shall mean the Invitation to Bid, Instruction to Bidders, Bid Form, Specifications, and Addenda if issued.

6) BIDS FORWARDED THROUGH THE MAIL:

The City of Hackensack will not assume responsibility for Bids mailed in. Mailed Bids shall be by "Certified Mail" and addressed to the attention of the "City Clerk" with the item clearly marked in the lower left hand corner of the envelope. It is the individual's

responsibility to see that Bids are presented to the City Clerk on the hour and at the place designated. The City WILL NOT be responsible for Bids not arriving on time or misdirected.

7) BID FORM:

Each Bid Proposal is to be submitted on the Bid Form in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the Bidder with the envelope clearly marked. The attached Bid Form constitutes approximate quantities only. Bidders shall set forth all Bid prices in words, and numbers, either handwritten in black ink or typewritten.

8) FAILURE TO SIGN BID GUARANTEE:

On the part of the Successful Bidder as required by Law, shall be sufficient cause to annul the award.

9) ASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER, CONVEY, SUBLET, OR DISPOSAL OF CONTRACT:

The Contractor shall not assign, transfer, convey, sublet or otherwise dispose of this contract or any part hereof to anyone without the written consent of the City of Hackensack.

10) MANDATORY AFFIRMATIVE ACTION CERTIFICATION:

No firm may be issued a contract unless it complies with the Affirmative Action provisions of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-1 et seq. The following information summarizes the full, required regulatory text, which is included as a separate exhibit of this Bid Specification.

Goods and Services (including Professional Services) Contracts:

Each Contractor shall submit to the public agency, after notification of award but prior to execution of a Goods and Services Contract, one of the following (3) three documents:

- i. A photocopy of a valid letter that the Contractor is operating under an existing federally approved or sanctioned Affirmative Action Program (good for (1) one year from the date of the letter); or
- ii. A photocopy of a Certificate of Employee Information Report Approval, issue in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4; or
- iii. A photocopy of an Employee Information Report (Form AA 302) provided by the Division and distributed to the public agency to be completed by the Contractor in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4.

11) AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990: (MUST BE READ):

Discrimination on the basis of disability in contracting for the purchase of Goods and Services is prohibited. Bidders are required to read Americans with Disabilities Language

that is included as of this Bid and agree that the provisions of Title II of the Act are made a part of the contract. The Contractor is obligated to comply with the Act and to hold the owner harmless.

12) STOCKHOLDER DISCLOSURE:

N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 provides that no Corporation or Partnership shall be awarded any contract for the performance of any work or the furnishing of any Goods and Services, unless, prior to the receipt of the Bid or accompanying the Bid of said Corporation or Partnership, Bidders shall submit a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all Stockholders in the Corporation or Partnership who own (10%) ten percent or more of its stock of any class, or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a (10%) ten percent or greater interest therein. The included Statement of Ownership shall be completed and attached to the Bid Proposal. This requirement applies to all forms of Corporations and Partnerships, including, but not limited to, Limited Partnerships, Limited Liability Corporations, Limited Liability Partnerships and Subchapter S Corporations. Failure to submit a Stockholder Disclosure document shall result in rejection of the Bid.

13) PROOF OF BUSINESS REGISTRATION:

A copy of New Jersey Business Registration Certificate must be included with submitted Bid Proposal. Proof of registration shall be a copy of the Bidder's Business Registration Certificate (BRC). A BRC is obtained from the New Jersey Division of Revenue. Information on obtaining a BRC is available on the internet at www.nj.gov/njbgs or by phone at (609) 292-1730. N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 imposes the following requirements on Contractors and all Subcontractors that knowingly provide Goods or perform Services for a Contractor fulfilling this contract:

- 1) The Contractor shall provide written notice to its Subcontractors and suppliers to submit proof of Business Registration to the Contractor;
- 2) Prior to receipt of final payment from a contracting agency, a Contractor must submit to the Contracting agency an accurate list of all Subcontractors or attest that none was used;
- 3) During the term of this Contract, the Contractor and its affiliates shall collect and remit, and shall notify all Subcontractors and their affiliates that they must collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act, (N.J.S.A. 54:32B-1 et seq.) on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into this State.

14) NON-COLLUSION AFFIDAVIT:

The Affidavit shall be properly executed and submitted with the Bid Proposal.

15) PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION:

A copy of New Jersey Public Works Contractor Registration Certificate must be included with submitted Bid Proposal.

16) ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT OF ADDENDA:

Must be included with submitted Bid Proposal.

17) DISCLOSURE OF INVESTMENT IN IRAN:

New Jersey Public Law 2012, Chapter 25, prohibits Public Contracts by with persons or entities engaged in certain investment activities in the energy and financial sectors of Iran as defined in the Law and implements the authority granted under Federal Law to the States and to Local Governments pursuant to the Comprehensive Iran Sanctions, Accountability, and Divestment Act of 2010, Public Law 111-195.

Under the Law, Bidders are required to certify that they are not identified on a list to be developed by the State Department of the Treasury of persons or entities engaging in certain investment activities in Iran.

18) RIGHT TO TERMINATE CONTRACT:

The City of Hackensack reserves the right to terminate the contract on thirty (30) days written notice to the Successful Bidder without penalty. This right shall be in effect during the term of the contract, and may be exercised if in the judgment of the City of Hackensack, Successful Bidder is failing to fulfill their obligations or to provide adequate service.

19) Each Bid Proposal form must give the full business address, business phone, fax, email if available, the contact person of the Bidder, and be signed by an authorized representative as follows:

- a) Bids by Partnership must furnish the full name of all partners and must be signed in the Partnership name by one of the members of the Partnership or by an authorized Representative, followed by the signature and designation of the person signing.
- b) Bids by Corporations must be signed in the legal name of the Corporation, followed by the name of the State in which incorporated and must contain the signature and designation of the President, Secretary or other person authorized to bind the Corporation in the matter.
- c) Bids by Sole-Proprietorship shall be signed by the Proprietor.

- d) When requested, satisfactory evidence of the authority of the officer signing shall be furnished.
- 20) Prior to this award, or if, during the life of the award, the Successful Bidder, or any other vendor, should be awarded a contract for any commodity contained in this Bid award, by the State of New Jersey or the County of Bergen at a price lower than that quoted herein, the Successful Bidder does hereby agree to extend to the City of Hackensack that price which was awarded to the State of New Jersey or the County of the Bergen, or at the option of the City if the Successful Bidder refuses to honor the above stipulation, the City may purchase under the applicable State or County contract any and all items at the lower price.
- 21) The Specifications sheet included shall be completed in full. Deviations from Specifications shall be noted and explained. Failure to complete the Specifications sheet shall constitute cause for rejecting Bids.
- 22) All prices and amounts must be written ink or preferably machine printed. Bids containing any conditions, omissions, unexplained erasures or alterations, items not called for in the Bid Proposal form, attachment of additive information not required by the Specifications, or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected by the City of Hackensack. Any changes, whiteouts, strikeouts, etc. in the Bids must be initialed in ink by the person signing the Bid.
- 23) Bidder should be aware of the following statutes that represents "Truth in Contracting" Laws:
- a) N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34, et seq. governs false claims and representations by Bidders. It is a serious crime for the Bidder to knowingly submit false claims and/or knowingly make material misrepresentation.

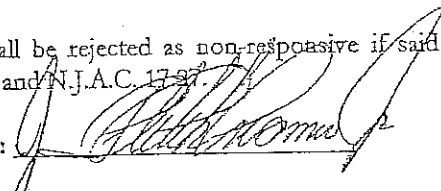

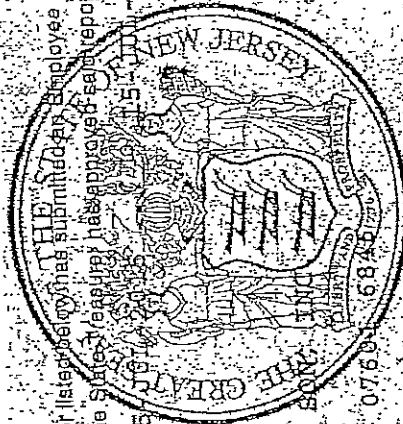

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

During the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that such applicants are recruited and employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Such action shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, up-grading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union or representative of workers with which it has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer advising the labor union or workers' representative of the contractor's commitments under this act and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

When hiring or scheduling workers in each construction trade, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to employ minority and women workers in each construction trade consistent with the applicable employment goal prescribed by N.J.A.C. 17:27-7.3; provided, however, that the Division may, in its discretion, exempt a contractor or subcontractor from compliance with

the good faith procedures prescribed by the following provisions, A, B and C, as long as the Division is satisfied that the contractor or subcontractor is employing workers provided by a union which provides evidence, in accordance with standards prescribed by the Division, that its percentage of active "card carrying" members who are minority and women workers is equal to or greater than the applicable employment goal established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-7.3. The contractor or subcontractor agrees that a good faith effort shall include compliance with the following procedures:

(A) If the contractor or subcontractor has a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for a construction trade, the contractor or subcontractor shall, within three business days of the contract award, seek assurances from the union that it will cooperate with the contractor or subcontractor as it fulfills its affirmative action obligations under this contract and in accordance with the rules promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq., as supplemented and amended from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act. If the contractor or subcontractor is unable to obtain said assurances from the construction trade union at least five business days prior to the commencement of construction work, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to attempt to hire or schedule minority and women workers directly, consistent with the applicable employment goal. If the contractor's or subcontractor's prior experience with a construction trade union, regardless of whether the union has provided said assurances, indicates a significant possibility that the trade union will not refer sufficient minority and women workers consistent with the applicable employment goal, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to be prepared to hire or schedule minority and women workers directly, consistent with the applicable employment goal, by complying with the hiring or scheduling procedures prescribed under (B) below; and the contractor or subcontractor further agrees to take said action immediately if it determines or is so notified by the Division that the union is not referring minority and women workers consistent with the applicable employment goal.

(B) If the hiring or scheduling of a workforce consistent with the employment goal has not or cannot be achieved for each construction trade by adhering to the procedures of (A) above, or if the contractor does not have a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for a construction trade, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to take the following actions consistent with the applicable county employment goals:

(1) To notify the public agency compliance officer, the Division, and minority and women referral organizations listed by the Division pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.3, of its workforce needs, and request referral of minority and women workers;

(2) To notify any minority and women workers who have been listed with it as awaiting available vacancies;

(3) Prior to commencement of work, to request that the local construction trade union refer minority and women workers to fill job openings, provided the contractor or subcontractor has a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for the construction trade;

(4) To leave standing requests for additional referral to minority and women workers with the local construction trade union, provided the contractor or subcontractor has a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for the construction trade, the State Training and Employment Service

and other approved referral sources in the area until such time as the workforce is consistent with the employment goal;

(5) If it is necessary to lay off some of the workers in a given trade on the construction site, to assure, consistent with the applicable State and Federal statutes and court decisions, that sufficient minority and women employees remain on the site consistent with the employment goal; and to employ any minority and women workers laid off by the contractor on any other construction site on which its workforce composition is not consistent with an employment goal established pursuant to rules implementing N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq.;

(6) To adhere to the following procedure when minority and women workers apply or are referred to the contractor or subcontractor:

(i) If said individuals have never previously received any document or certification signifying a level of qualification lower than that required in order to perform the work of the construction trade, the contractor or subcontractor shall determine the qualifications of such individuals and if the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce in each construction trade is not consistent with the applicable employment goal, it shall hire or schedule those individuals who satisfy appropriate qualification standards. However, a contractor or subcontractor shall determine that the individual at least possesses the requisite skills, and experience recognized by a union, apprentice program or a referral agency, provided the referral agency is acceptable to the Division. If necessary, the contractor or subcontractor shall hire or schedule minority and women workers who qualify as trainees pursuant to these rules. All of the requirements, however, are limited by the provisions of (C) below.

(ii) If the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce is consistent with the applicable employment goal, the name of any interested woman or minority individual shall be maintained on a waiting list for the first consideration, in the event the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce is no longer consistent with the applicable employment goal.

(iii) If, for any reason, said contractor or subcontractor determines that a minority individual or a woman is not qualified or if the individual qualifies as an advanced trainee or apprentice, the contractor or subcontractor shall inform the individual in writing of the reasons for the determination, maintain a copy of the determination in its files, and send a copy to the public agency compliance officer and to the Division.

(7) To keep a complete and accurate record of all requests made for the referral of workers in any trade covered by the contract, on forms made available by the Division and submitted promptly to the Division upon request.

(C) The contractor or subcontractor agrees that nothing contained in (B) above shall preclude the contractor or subcontractor from complying with the union hiring hall or apprenticeship policies in any applicable collective bargaining agreement or union hiring hall arrangement, and, where required by custom or agreement, it shall send journeymen and trainees to the union for referral, or to the apprenticeship program for admission, pursuant to such agreement or arrangement.
