The City of Hackensack ("City") records custodian received your Open Public Records Act ("OPRA") request on February 20, 2018. The seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request was March 1, 2018. As you know, on February 28, 2018 the City emailed you to request an extension until March 16, 2018. As such, the City is timely responding to your request.

Your request seeks the following:

- *All executed contracts for work awarded to J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc. from 2010 to the present;*
- *All contract amendments for contracts for work awarded to J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc. from 2010 to the present;*
- *All bids submitted on contracts for work awarded to J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc. from 2010 to the present, pursuant to a Request for Proposal (RFP);*
- *All Prevailing Wage Rate determinations for contracts for work awarded to J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc. from 2010 to the present; and*
- *All Certified Payrolls Reports submitted by J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc. from 2010 to the present.*

The following projects were awarded to J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc. from 2010 to present:

Anderson Street Emergency Sewer Replacement (July 2011)

Emergency Storm and Sanitary Sewer Repairs within the City of Hackensack (May 7, 2015)

Removal and Replacement of Catch Basins within the City of Hackensack (May 7, 2015)

Two (2) Four (4) Yard Rubber Wheel Front End Loaders to Plow Snow from Parking Lots and City Streets located in the City of Hackensack, New Jersey. (February 4, 2016)

Removal and Replacement of Catch Basins within the City of Hackensack (May 25, 2017)

Emergency Storm and Sanitary Sewer Repairs within the City of Hackensack (July 19, 2017)

Attached are records found in the City's files for each of these projects.

Please be advised that said records have been redacted in accordance with New Jersey law. Specifically, employee names, employee home addresses, social security numbers and employee codes have been redacted from all certified payroll reports. See John Does & PKF-Mark III, Inc. v. City of Trenton Dep't of Pub. Works – Water Div., 565 F. Supp. 2d 560 (D.N.J. 2008) (noting that employee names and home addresses should be withheld from certified payroll records pursuant to OPRA's privacy provisions); Ott v. Cape May County, GRC Complaint No. 2010-77 (2011) (holding that employee names and home addresses referenced on certified payroll records are exempt from public access under OPRA); Feasel v City of Trenton (Mercer), GRC Complaint No. 2008-103 (2009) (same); see also N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 (providing that social security numbers are exempt from public access under OPRA).

Your OPRA request is now deemed answered and closed.
