The Camden County Custodian of Records received your Open Public Records Act request on 5/26/2023. To access your request and retrieve your records please click [here](#).

The Camden County Board of Elections provided the following responses to each portion of your request.

Your request: "1. Informed by Section 3 of P.L. 1995, c.195 (C19:59-14 as amended), copy of all and inclusive overseas voter or overseas federal election voter's or overseas State and federal election voter's statement of certification, executed and certifying the subject voter's signature by pledge."

Custodian's response: The Board of Elections conducted a search of their files and provided records responsive to this portion of your request. The records provided contain redactions which are indicated at the end of each applicable document, as is required by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6.

Your request: "2. Informed by Section 4 of P.L. 1995, c. 195 (C.19:59-15 as amended), copy of written protocol and list of all and inclusive overseas voter or overseas federal election voter's or overseas State and federal election voter's ballots which were subject to investigation, extending to judicial imposition and impound of such documents, further informed by (cf: P.L. 2017, c.39, c.16)."

Custodian's response: The Board of Elections informed our office that no ballots were subject to investigation and there is no written protocol for investigating these voters. Therefore, no records exist for this portion of your request.

As such, this correspondence and the records provided constitutes completion of your request.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq. if your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Camden to deny access. As provided by law, you have the right to either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing their Denial of Access Complaint Form located at the GRC's website at www.state.nj.us/grc.
