Affidavit of Probable Cause

On Friday, June 14, 2019, at approximately 10:44 PM, the Asbury Park Police Department (APPD) received 911 calls reporting shots fired in the area of 1101 Atlantic Avenue, Asbury Park, New Jersey. Upon arrival, officers located the victim, identified as J [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] outside of the courtyard at 1101 Atlantic Avenue. The victim reportedly suffered from multiple gunshot wounds to the back, but was breathing upon officers' arrival. The victim was transported by EMS to Jersey Shore University Medical Center where he was ultimately pronounced deceased at 12:14 AM on June 15, 2019. An autopsy was later conducted and the Middlesex County Medical Examiner's Office concluded that the cause of death was gunshot wounds of the torso and left lower extremity and the manner of death was homicide. A canvass of the scene revealed shell casings of varying caliber from multiple handguns.

A review of surveillance footage of the area showed what appears to be a dispute on/near the basketball courts located on Prospect Avenue. The victim is identified on video walking south on Spruce Street subsequent to this dispute. A black male later identified as PRINCE YOUNG ("YOUNG") wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt, stonewashed jeans, and white sneakers is observed moving quickly south on the grass of the complex adjacent to Spruce Street heading towards Atlantic Avenue. Soon thereafter, multiple people in the area begin to scatter. After people scatter, YOUNG runs out of view of the video surveillance video. Additional surveillance footage revealed YOUNG point his arm in the direction of where the victim was seen just before the time of the shooting. Additional surveillance footage of Atlantic Avenue revealed the victim exit Spruce Street onto Atlantic Avenue followed by YOUNG, who runs east on Atlantic Avenue then south on Prospect Avenue.

A further review of surveillance video showed a male matching CHYROD FREEMAN's ("FREEMAN") height, build, and long braids, on the basketball court. This male was wearing a distinctive bright orange shirt with darker and lighter colors as a pattern, light blue jeans with holes ripped in them, as well as black and white sneakers. A review of FREEMAN's Instagram account revealed a post on June 14, 2019, of FREEMAN wearing these exact clothes and standing just outside the fence-line of the basketball courts. A further review of surveillance video showed FREEMAN exit from Spruce Street out onto Atlantic Avenue at the time of the shooting. As FREEMAN crossed the double yellow line, he turned back toward 1101 Atlantic Avenue and a muzzle flash is seen in the area where FREEMAN is standing. FREEMAN then ran southeast and into a different camera view, facing south on Prospect Avenue. FREEMAN crossed Prospect Avenue to the Frederick Douglas Apartments, directly into the vicinity of 142 Prospect Avenue, which was FREEMAN's past residence. FREEMAN then crossed back over Prospect Avenue to the west side and looked around. He then crossed back east once again to the area of 142 Prospect Avenue. This time the video clearly shows a common door at 142 Prospect Avenue open up. Light from the hallway is seen as FREEMAN enters the building.

Body worn camera footage was obtained from several APPD officers from several hours prior to the murder. In the footage, officers approached a group of people on the Prospect Avenue basketball courts while it was still daylight. YOUNG is clearly identifiable by face and is wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt, stonewashed jeans, and white sneakers – the same clothing he is wearing

at the time of the shooting. FREEMAN is clearly identifiable by face and is wearing distinctive bright orange shirt with darker and lighter colors as a pattern, light blue jeans with holes, as well as black and white sneakers – the same clothing he is wearing at the time of the shooting.

On Saturday, June 15, 2019, at approximately 2:56 AM (4 hours after the shooting), APPD officers conducted a motor vehicle stop on a 2015 BMW for multiple motor vehicle violations on Cookman Avenue at Memorial Drive, approximately three blocks from the shooting. After the BMW was stopped, another APPD officer drove past the stop location and recognized this BMW as having been on Jefferson Avenue when he arrived at the area of 1101 Atlantic Avenue in response to the shots fired call. The make, model, and color of the black two-door coupe seen in the surveillance video was also similar to the stopped BMW. The driver of the vehicle was identified as JAHQUAN ALLAH (“ALLAH”). The passenger of the vehicle was identified as SCIMEL JACKSON (“JACKSON”). Consent to search the vehicle was provided to APPD officers by ALLAH. A subsequent search of the vehicle yielded two handguns located in the air vent of the front, driver side dash of the vehicle. The guns were further identified as .40 Kahr and a 9mm Kel-Tec. The registered owner of the BMW was ALLAH’s father. ALLAH and JACKSON were later interviewed and JACKSON stated that he was playing basketball at the basketball courts located on Prospect Avenue, after which he left on foot and walked to Asbury Park Village. At the time of their arrest, ALLAH and JACKSON were still wearing the same clothes they can be seen wearing in the surveillance video. Also at the time of their arrests, JACKSON and ALLAH were swabbed for gunshot residue. Initial preliminary testing and later confirmatory testing was positive for gunshot residue for both ALLAH and JACKSON.

On August 2, 2019, a formal statement was obtained from Witness 1. In summary, Witness 1 stated that he/she was present for the homicide of M██████. He/she stated that prior to the homicide, a dispute arose over a dice game between the Bloods, including YOUNG and FREEMAN, and the Crips including JACKSON and ALLAH. He/she stated that during the dispute, he/she saw JACKSON in possession of handgun in his hooded sweatshirt. Witness 1 stated that after the dispute, people started leaving the area of the basketball courts. Witness 1 stated that he/she then saw ALLAH fire a handgun towards Spruce Street (towards the area where YOUNG can be seen on the video). Witness 1 also stated that he/she then saw YOUNG fire three shots at the victim. Witness 1 stated that he/she saw Witness 2 walking behind the victim around the time of the shooting. Witness 1 also positively identified photographs of ALLAH, JACKSON, and YOUNG.

On August 10, 2019, search warrants for FREEMAN and his residence were executed. FREEMAN was stopped on Prospect Avenue in Asbury Park and found to be in possession of a .380 Kel Tec semi-automatic handgun loaded with hollowpoint bullets. This firearm was sent to the laboratory for ballistics testing and found to be a match for the single .380 shell casing located during a scene canvass the day after the homicide, which was not in the area where any of the shots were fired. FREEMAN was interviewed and confirmed his identity in a photograph located on his Instagram account of him wearing the distinctive bright orange.

On August 29, 2019, a statement was obtained from Witness 2. In summary, Witness 2 confirmed there was a dispute of a dice game preceding the homicide. Witness 2 also stated that he/she saw YOUNG shoot the victim. Witness 2 also positively identified a photograph of YOUNG.

Eleven spent shell casings were recovered from the crime scene in the area of 1101 Atlantic Avenue. More specifically: Four .22 caliber spent shell casings were found on Spruce Street in the area where both witnesses described YOUNG shooting the victim. Three .380 caliber spent shell casings were found near Spruce Street and Atlantic Avenue, in the area where FREEMAN can be seen on the video. Two 9mm caliber spent shell casings and one 9x19 mm caliber spent shell casing were found on the grass or in the street near the intersection of Monmouth Avenue and Atlantic Avenue, near the area where Witness 1 described ALLAH firing his gun. One 9mm shell casing was found near the intersection of Spruce Street and Jefferson Avenue, near the area where ALLAH's car had been parked. One additional .380 caliber shell casing was located the following day on the ground beside dumpster on Jefferson Avenue near Monmouth Avenue.

The 9 mm recovered from ALLAH's car on June 15, 2019 was later compared to the shell casings located at the scene and found to be a match for the casings located in the area where Witness 1 stated that ALLAH was shooting from.

A review of FREEMAN's criminal history reveals a conviction for Aggravated Assault. A review of JACKSON's criminal history reveals a conviction for second-degree Aggravated Assault.

A review of FREEMAN's Instagram account revealed a post on June 14, 2019, of FREEMAN wearing these exact clothes and standing just outside the fence-line of the basketball courts. A further review of surveillance video showed FREEMAN exit from Spruce Street out onto Atlantic Avenue at the time of the shooting. As FREEMAN crossed the double yellow line, he turned back toward 1101 Atlantic Avenue and a muzzle flash is seen in the area where FREEMAN is standing. FREEMAN then ran southeast and into a different camera view, facing south on Prospect Avenue. FREEMAN crossed Prospect Avenue to the Frederick Douglas Apartments, directly into the vicinity of 142 Prospect Avenue, which was FREEMAN's past residence. FREEMAN then crossed back over Prospect Avenue to the west side and looked around. He then crossed back east once again to the area of 142 Prospect Avenue. This time the video clearly shows a common door at 142 Prospect Avenue open up. Light from the hallway is seen as FREEMAN enters the building.

Body worn camera footage was obtained from several APPD officers from several hours prior to the murder. In the footage, officers approached a group of people on the Prospect Avenue basketball courts while it was still daylight. YOUNG is clearly identifiable by face and is wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt, stonewashed jeans, and white sneakers – the same clothing he is wearing

at the time of the shooting. FREEMAN is clearly identifiable by face and is wearing distinctive bright orange shirt with darker and lighter colors as a pattern, light blue jeans with holes, as well as black and white sneakers – the same clothing he is wearing at the time of the shooting.

On Saturday, June 15, 2019, at approximately 2:56 AM (4 hours after the shooting), APPD officers conducted a motor vehicle stop on a 2015 BMW for multiple motor vehicle violations on Cookman Avenue at Memorial Drive, approximately three blocks from the shooting. After the BMW was stopped, another APPD officer drove past the stop location and recognized this BMW as having been on Jefferson Avenue when he arrived at the area of 1101 Atlantic Avenue in response to the shots fired call. The make, model, and color of the black two-door coupe seen in the surveillance video was also similar to the stopped BMW. The driver of the vehicle was identified as JAHQUAN ALLAH ("ALLAH"). The passenger of the vehicle was identified as SCIMEL JACKSON ("JACKSON"). Consent to search the vehicle was provided to APPD officers by ALLAH. A subsequent search of the vehicle yielded two handguns located in the air vent of the front, driver side dash of the vehicle. The guns were further identified as .40 Kahr and a 9mm Kel-Tec. The registered owner of the BMW was ALLAH's father. ALLAH and JACKSON were later interviewed and JACKSON stated that he was playing basketball at the basketball courts located on Prospect Avenue, after which he left on foot and walked to Asbury Park Village. At the time of their arrest, ALLAH and JACKSON were still wearing the same clothes they can be seen wearing in the surveillance video. Also at the time of their arrests, JACKSON and ALLAH were swabbed for gunshot residue. Initial preliminary testing and later confirmatory testing was positive for gunshot residue for both ALLAH and JACKSON.

On August 2, 2019, a formal statement was obtained from Witness 1. In summary, Witness 1 stated that he/she was present for the homicide of M[REDACTED]. He/she stated that prior to the homicide, a dispute arose over a dice game between the Bloods, including YOUNG and FREEMAN, and the Crips including JACKSON and ALLAH. He/she stated that during the dispute, he/she saw JACKSON in possession of handgun in his hooded sweatshirt. Witness 1 stated that after the dispute, people started leaving the area of the basketball courts. Witness 1 stated that he/she then saw ALLAH fire a handgun towards Spruce Street (towards the area where YOUNG can be seen on the video). Witness 1 also stated that he/she then saw YOUNG fire three shots at the victim. Witness 1 stated that he/she saw Witness 2 walking behind the victim around the time of the shooting. Witness 1 also positively identified photographs of ALLAH, JACKSON, and YOUNG.

On August 10, 2019, search warrants for FREEMAN and his residence were executed. FREEMAN was stopped on Prospect Avenue in Asbury Park and found to be in possession of a .380 Kel Tec semi-automatic handgun loaded with hollowpoint bullets. This firearm was sent to the laboratory for ballistics testing and found to be a match for the single .380 shell casing located during a scene canvass the day after the homicide, which was not in the area where any of the shots were fired. FREEMAN was interviewed and confirmed his identity in a photograph located on his Instagram account of him wearing the distinctive bright orange.

On August 29, 2019, a statement was obtained from Witness 2. In summary, Witness 2 confirmed there was a dispute of a dice game preceding the homicide. Witness 2 also stated that he/she saw YOUNG shoot the victim. Witness 2 also positively identified a photograph of YOUNG.

Eleven spent shell casings were recovered from the crime scene in the area of 1101 Atlantic Avenue. More specifically: Four .22 caliber spent shell casings were found on Spruce Street in the area where both witnesses described YOUNG shooting the victim. Three .380 caliber spent shell casings were found near Spruce Street and Atlantic Avenue, in the area where FREEMAN can be seen on the video. Two 9mm caliber spent shell casings and one 9x19 mm caliber spent shell casing were found on the grass or in the street near the intersection of Monmouth Avenue and Atlantic Avenue, near the area where Witness 1 described ALLAH firing his gun. One 9mm shell casing was found near the intersection of Spruce Street and Jefferson Avenue, near the area where ALLAH's car had been parked. One additional .380 caliber shell casing was located the following day on the ground beside dumpster on Jefferson Avenue near Monmouth Avenue.

The 9 mm recovered from ALLAH's car on June 15, 2019 was later compared to the shell casings located at the scene and found to be a match for the casings located in the area where Witness 1 stated that ALLAH was shooting from.

A review of FREEMAN's criminal history reveals a conviction for Aggravated Assault. A review of JACKSON's criminal history reveals a conviction for second-degree Aggravated Assault.

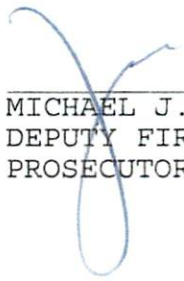
