I am writing in response to your request pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (“OPRA”) received by the City on February 3, 2022. The seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your OPRA request is February 14, 2022. As such, the City is timely responding to your request in accordance with New Jersey law.

Your OPRA request seeks the following records:

1. A list of all residential single family, and multi family properties with code violations on them for the last 3 months from today. Address, and owner name provided please.
2. A list of all residential vacant land, single family and multi family properties that are currently in the probate process.
3. A list of all residential single family, and multi family properties that are in the eviction process.
4. A list of all residential vacant land, single family, and multi family properties that are going through the divorce process.
5. A list of all residential single family and multi family properties that are delinquent on their utilities. Address, owner name, and balance owed provided please.
6. A list of all residential single family and multi family properties that are flagged abandoned.
7. A list of all residential single family and multi family properties that are fire damaged in the past month.
8. A list of all residential single family and multi family properties that have had their utilities shut off for 6+ months

The City requires additional time to compile, review, and redact (if necessary) the records that may be responsive to your request. The City anticipates finalizing your request by February 18, 2022. The City also reserves the right to request an additional extension of time if necessary. See Scheeler v. New Jersey Department of Educ., GRC Complaint No. 2014-123 (2016).
