3. Your request for notice of abatement our township does not do residential abatements.
4. Your request for fire damage you would have to contact the fire department.
5. Your request for residential properties with delinquent property taxes please see attached.
6. Your request for residential properties with delinquent water and sewer bill you would have to contact the MUA.
7. Your request for all residential properties with an active municipal owned lien please see attached.
8. Your request for all residential properties that have had a code enforcement complaint, your request does not call for a readily identifiable record as per OPRA and the MAG Entertainment case. The only way for the Township to provide the records you seek is for government officials to engage in significant research to identify and siphon information (See MAG Entertainment). This exercise is not required to be undertaken by the Township.
9. Your request for all residential properties that have had a landlord file for eviction please contact the County.
10. Your request of all residential properties for which a Lis Pendens Notice has been filed you would have to contact Gloucester County for that information.
