Which premises are in a Rural/ zone; and WHEREAS, the Board after carefully considering the evidence presented by applicant and of the adjoining property owners and general public, has made the following factual findings:

1. That premises in question are a triangle at the junction of Route #88 and Burrsville

(Squankum) Road, Brick Township;

2. That said triangular premises and the use thereof for a service station serving both Route #88 and Burrsville (Squankum) Road would contribute to and have a dilatorious effect upon the already existing traffic on both roads and will create a definite traffic hazard at an already congested intersection;

3. That the application does not meet the standards set forth in the Ordinance as follows:
 - a. Within 500 feet of a church, it being by actual measurement, 164 feet;
 - b. That the Zoning Ordinance makes no provision under Section F for service stations in the Rural/Agricultural Zone;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the relief requested by applicant (~~xxx~~) (cannot) be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent and purpose of the Zone Plan and Zoning Ordinance of the Township of Brick.
