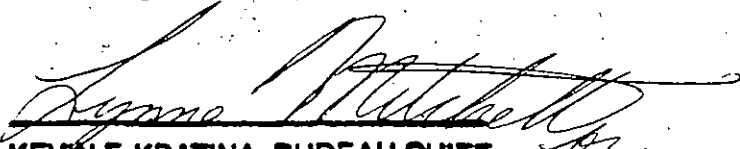

The following is an account of the days inspections for the removal of tanks at Brick High School on Monday, January 17th.

I arrived on the job at 8:30 AM, one tank a 2000 gallon gasoline tank had already been removed. The tank was cut open and was cleaned out inside. There were no holes or decaying of the tank. The engineer from P.M.K. Group, Inc. was on site all day and took soil samples, as per D.E.P. closure approval.

The second tank on site a 15,000 gallon fuel oil was still being pumped out at this time. Apparently there was more fuel oil in the tank than originally reported. The foreman expected to have the tank empty around noon.

I returned to the site at 12:30 PM the tank was now empty and was in the process of being wiped clean. By about 2:30 PM the tank had been pulled from the ground. A hole was cut in the tank and inspection revealed several holes in the sides. An inspection of the hole indicated tainting of the concrete saddle and soils. The engineer from P.M.K. Group again took samples.

Excavation continued throughout the rest of the afternoon. By 5:00 PM it was obvious that the contractor had encountered more contaminated soils than was anticipated. The six loads of clean fill which were on site were not going to be adequate to backfill the hole. At this time darkness had set in and it became clear that the job would not be completed, there were still about two loads of soils to be removed and it was decided to leave that until morning and to secure the area for the night. The contaminated soils have been stockpiled at two locations on site and have been covered. The hole was fenced off and secured for the night. I left the scene at 7:00 PM to return Tuesday morning.

At 7:00 AM Tuesday, January 18th I returned to the site and inspected the remaining backfill which was completed. I worked a total of 9 1/2 hours.

ORDINANCE 728-92

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY
OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND
SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 121 ENTITLED
"CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM" TO ADD
SECTION 121-3 "BUILDERS RESPONSIBILITY."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of
Brick, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 121-3 of the Brick Township Code is
hereby enacted as follows:

121-3. Builders Responsibility

- A. Prior to any permit being issued for construction of
any kind, the person or entity applying for the permit
shall, as a prerequisite to the issuance of that permit,
provide the Construction Official with written
documentation setting forth the person's or entity's
proposal to dispose of all construction debris resulting
from the construction for which the permit is being
issued.
- B. Prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, the
person or entity performing the construction shall
provide the Construction Official with written
documentation setting forth that the person or entity has
complied with the proposal to dispose all of the
construction debris.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances
inconsistent herewith are repealed.

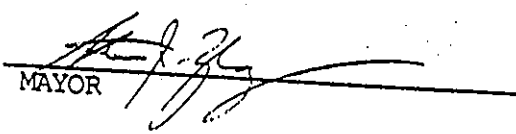
SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause,
phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or
unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion
shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and
such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions
hereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner as
prescribed by law.

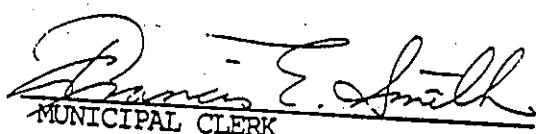
