- 2 1. Applicant shall obtain certification by the Local Soil Conservation District of a plan for soil erosion and sediment control in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 251, "Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Act."
2. All materials, methods of construction, and details shall be in conformance with the current Township of Brick "Engineering Specifications and Construction Details", available at the office of the Township Engineer.
3. Applicant shall obtain any other approvals with respect to submission to any other federal, state, county or municipal agency having jurisdiction over same. Upon receipt of the approval, the applicant shall supply a copy of said permit or permits to the Board. In the event that any other jurisdictional agency requires a change in the applicant's plans, the applicant must reapply to the Brick Township Planning Board for approval of that change.
4. Applicant shall resubmit this entire proposal should there be any deviation from this Resolution or the submitted documents which are hereby made a part hereof and shall be binding on the applicant.
