The following is an account of the inspection conducted February 7, 1994 at Brick Memorial High School. Between inspections plan review was done on new building permit applications. Attached is a copy of my inspection sheet with addresses of permits that were reviewed.

8:00 AM	Digging started
10:00 am	Two tanks out 8000 gallons each.. Contaminated soil found.
12:00 am	Still removing contaminated soil. Placed on vinyl near entrance to football field blacktop removed from site.
2:00 pm	Still removing contaminated soil and draining pipes.
3:00 pm	All contaminated soil removed filling hole started.
5:00 pm	Machinery blocking remainder of hole. Protective fence installed
5:30 pm	Tanks were clear and removed from site. Contaminated soil covered with vinyl. Went back to office.
6:00 pm	Left for the day.

Re: O.T. Tank Inspection

On Tuesday, April 19th I was needed to work overtime due to a tank removal job at Brick Memorial High School. The contractor had anticipated removing two tanks, one 1000 gallon and one 250 gallon. The inspection had been requested for the A.M. I arrived at the site at approximately 11:00. The 1000 gallon tank had been pumped out and purged and was in the process of being cleaned. The 250 gallon tank was in the process of being excavated.

The contractor requested that I return later in the afternoon. I returned to the school at 3:00, both tanks were now removed, cleaned and ready for inspection. At this point I was informed that a third tank had been discovered and work had been started on the removal of it. The process of removal was slowed a bit since the contractor was unaware of the size of the tank we were dealing with. They pumped out approximately 525 gallons from the tank and were estimating its size to be 550 gallons, which proved to be accurate. Once the tank was removed and cleaned my inspection revealed several holes in the tank. The project engineer began taking readings and contaminated soils were removed. The soils were stock piled on site and clean fill was placed in the hole. The contractor anticipates black topping the areas today to complete the job. All three tanks have been inspected and were taken away for salvage. The salvage receipts and engineers soils report are to follow and are prerequisites to issuing any approval certificated. I returned to the Municipal Building at 6:30 PM (2 hours O.T)

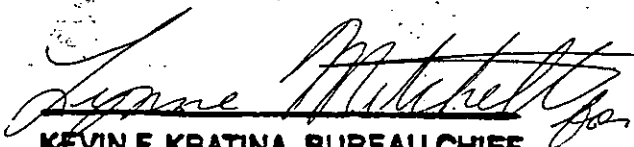

ORDINANCE 728-92

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY
OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND
SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 121 ENTITLED
"CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM" TO ADD
SECTION 121-3 "BUILDERS RESPONSIBILITY."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of
Brick, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 121-3 of the Brick Township Code is
hereby enacted as follows:

121-3. Builders Responsibility

- A. Prior to any permit being issued for construction of
any kind, the person or entity applying for the permit
shall, as a prerequisite to the issuance of that permit,
provide the Construction Official with written
documentation setting forth the person's or entity's
proposal to dispose of all construction debris resulting
from the construction for which the permit is being
issued.
- B. Prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, the
person or entity performing the construction shall
provide the Construction Official with written
documentation setting forth that the person or entity has
complied with the proposal to dispose all of the
construction debris.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances
inconsistent herewith are repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause,
phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or
unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion
shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and
such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions
hereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner as
prescribed by law.
