CHAPTER I: Scope of Work

Scope of Work

Work shall consist of the complete removal and disposal of approximately 800 square feet of asbestos containing duct insulation from the attic located at the Osbornville Elementary School in Brick, New Jersey. The abatement shall be completed utilizing full containment procedures.

Full Containment Procedures

Full containment procedures shall be utilized in the specified area and in accordance with NJAC 5:23-8 ASBESTOS HAZARD ABATEMENT SUBCODE. This shall include but not be limited to performing the following procedures.

1. All HVAC and Electrical systems within the work area shall be shut down and locked out prior to the commencement of abatement activities..
2. A fully operational decontamination unit consisting of a clean room, shower room and equipment room shall be constructed at the entrance to the work area. Each room shall be 4'x4' in size. Hot and cold water operable at the source shall be supplied to the shower unit. A sign-in log shall be present at the decontamination unit to document the ingress/egress of all personnel. All authorized personnel permitted to enter the area shall wear protective clothing and proper respiratory equipment.
3. The contractor shall detach and wet clean removable electrical, heating and ventilating equipment and other items which may be connected to the asbestos surfaces. These items shall be returned upon satisfactory air clearance.
4. All openings inside the work area (windows, vents, floor drains, etc.) shall be sealed with critical barriers consisting of two layers of six mil polyethylene plastic. The contractor shall also add 1 additional layer of six mil plastic to the critical barriers to represent walls. The walls and critical barriers shall be taped to the deck and the floor 2"x4" studs shall be utilized as additional support.
5. The floors of the work area shall be covered with two layers of six mil polyethylene plastic.
6. The Asbestos Safety Technician shall calculate and record the number of required negative air units for the work area. The negative air units shall be capable of creating at least one air change every 10 minutes. The exhaust capacity from the work area shall be sufficient to establish a pressure differential between the work area and all adjacent spaces greater than or equal

to 0.02 inches w.c. Make up air shall be drawn through the decontamination unit.

7. The contractor shall begin abatement activities only after a written "notice to proceed" is granted by the on site Asbestos Safety Technician.
8. ACM materials shall be wet with a fine low pressure spray of amended water to prevent fiber disturbance preceding removal. Once wet the materials shall be removed and sealed in properly labeled six mil polyethylene bags. All free water shall be added to the asbestos waste in sealed bags. All surfaces from which asbestos was removed shall be scrubbed using nylon or bristle brushes and wet sprayed or cleaned by an equivalent method to remove visible ACM.
9. After a satisfactory pre-sealant inspection by the Asbestos Safety Technician, the contractor shall encapsulate the entire area with a distinct colored encapsulant. After allowing sufficient drying time the wall and floor plastic shall be removed and disposed of as contaminated waste. Surfaces inside the area shall then be wet wiped and HEPA vacuumed.
10. After finding the area free of visible asbestos debris. The Asbestos Safety Technician shall perform Aggressive Final Air Test. Analysis of air test shall be performed utilizing Transmission Electron Microscopy. The area shall not be released until all clearance test reveal airborne fiber concentration of less than 0.01 fibers per cubic centimeter of air.

General Conditions

- 1.) The contractor shall be responsible to verify all site conditions and amounts of material prior to the submission of his bid. The material amounts listed are estimates only.
- 2.) The contractor shall be responsible for compliance with all applicable regulations, including but not limited to, EPA 40 CFR 61 and OSHA 1926.1101. In addition, the contractor shall be responsible to perform all personal monitoring required in OSHA 1926.1101 Appendix A and supply analytical results to the project supervisor within twenty-four (24) hours.
- 3.) The contractor shall be responsible for all pre-removal and post-removal cleaning requirements as per N.J.A.C. 5:23-8, Asbestos Hazard Abatement Subcode.
- 4.) The contractor is responsible for the removal of all tape and glue residue at the completion of the project.
- 5.) The contractor shall be liable for any expenses incurred by the owner for additional services of the Project Supervisor, the Asbestos Safety Technician,

and additional cleaning of the site, if and when the air samples are collected for final clearance exceed the limits set forth in 5:23-8, Asbestos Hazard Abatement Subcode.

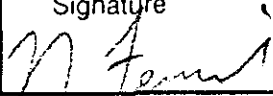
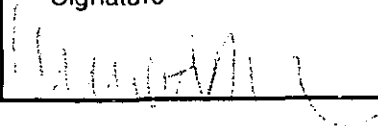
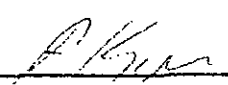
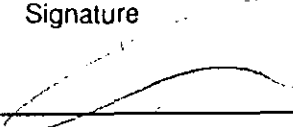
