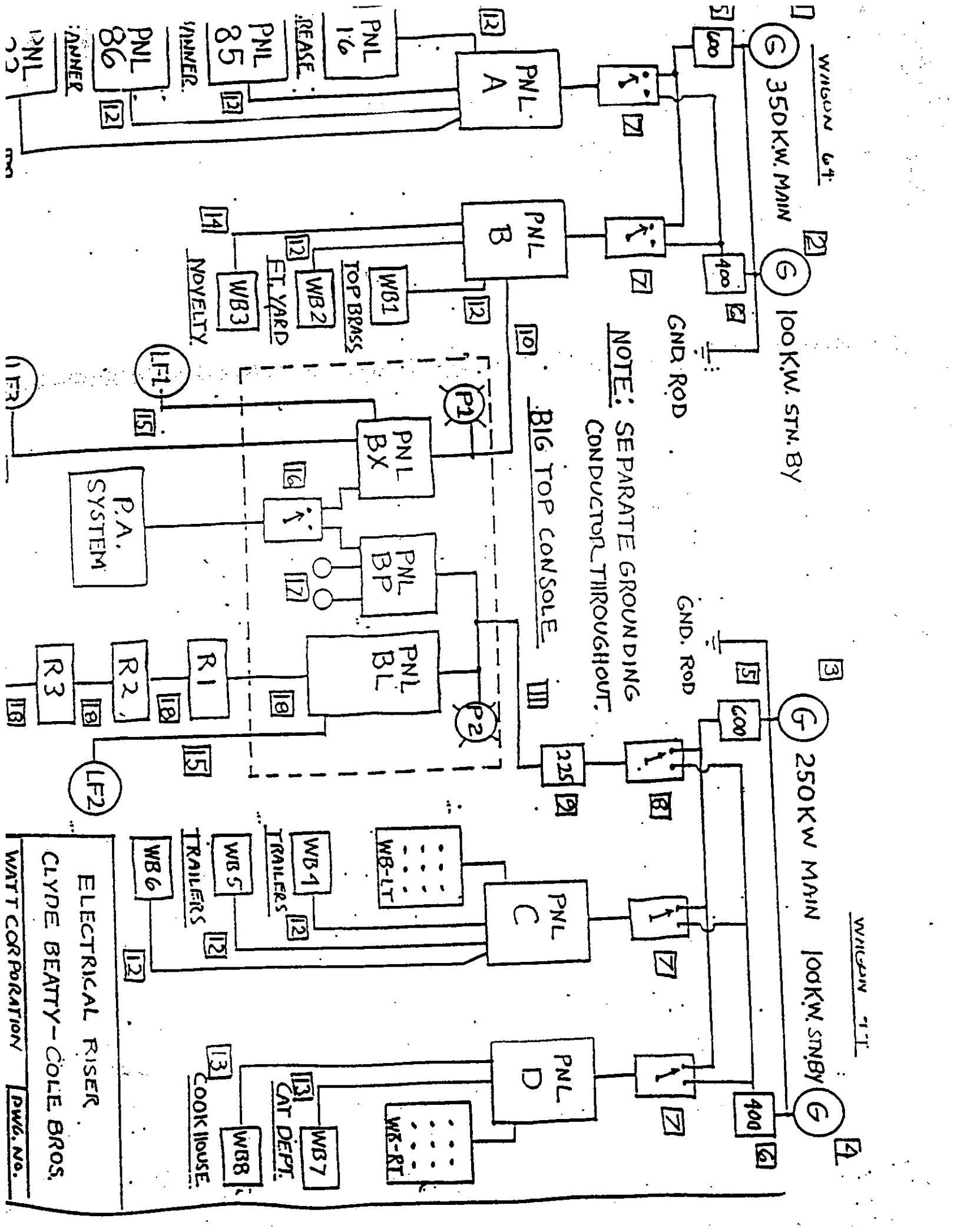

At noon, the Circus is ready for inspection by local officials. Typically, the Circus presents matinee and early evening performances Mondays through Saturdays, and two matinee performances on Sundays. **Evening performances conclude at no later than 9:30 p.m.** Allowing adequate time for patrons to return to their vehicles and exit the show grounds, all is quiet on the circus grounds by 10:00 p.m.

Trained personnel monitor safety in the Big Top and on the show grounds. "No smoking" is imprinted on the top of the interior of the sidewall surrounding the tent, where absolutely no smoking is permitted. RV UNITS HOUSING CIRCUS PERFORMERS AND STAFF

All units housing staff and performers are fully self-contained, with sufficiently large gray water and black water holding tanks. RV Unit owners properly dispose of waste from holding tanks using the sanitation company contracted by Circus, or designated "dump stations" en route.

GARBAGE/TRASH REMOVAL

The Circus or its local sponsor contracts with a local dumpster company to provide a minimum of two 20-yard dumpsters for collection and removal of refuse from the show grounds. Circus personnel collect garbage in plastic bags, depositing bagged garbage in one dumpster. Animal workers place used animal bedding (hay or shavings) and animal manure in the second dumpster. The Circus fills its water truck with water obtained from an approved local source, and supplies the water to the concession trailer.

FIRE/SAFETY EQUIPMENT & OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

No smoking announcements are made prior to each performance and during the performance intermission. Ushers monitor any patron smoking throughout the performance. Permanent "NO SMOKING" signs on canvas wall.

All electrical power provided by two diesel-powered Caterpillar Generators, (1) 250 KW Cat and (1) 300 KW Cat. All electrical cables are either buried, suspended or covered by rubber matting. Two 100 KW emergency generators are available as stand-by.

All elevated end seating sections are banistered by 42" high railings. All aisles within the seating sections are a minimum of 44" in width. When required per code, additional polyurethane crowd-control safety fencing is affixed to the back and side railings of seating sections. Manufactured by Tensar, this is orange 50lb polyurethane flexible netting, 48" high, 1/16" thick with 2" square mesh.

Each of the four portable seat wagons contain four water-type fire extinguishers at each end for a total of 16. Four of the eight centerpoles of the Big Top each have two ABC chemical fire extinguishers mounted on either side for a total of eight. Each generator vehicle contains 2 ABC chemical-type extinguishers. Concession mobile/food trailer also houses 2 ABC fire extinguishers.

The Main ticket wagon show office contains a first aid kit, weather alert equipment and mobile cellular telephone. Local numbers of emergency support (Fire, Police, Ambulance) are kept on file for each locale. The show manager & assistant managers utilize walkie-talkies for constant communication on the Circus grounds in the event of mishap or injury.
