To whom It may concern,

I am having an issue getting an old open permit closed on my home. I purchased the house March 2004 and we had the above ground oil tank removed and gas heat installed. A permit was taken out by Tonks Waste oil Service on behalf of my ex- partner, Steven Van Pelt. however, there does not seem to be any conclusion to the rest of the process.

It appears that Tonks un-installed the tank but at this time we have no documentation to what happened after that.

I have exhausted every avenue to obtain documentation on the tank/ oil/ sludge removal. Tonks stated they only keep records for 7 years, and my ex now lives out of state and has no recollection either of what came of the tank after it was removed. I cannot imagine anything other than the proper removal happened and this is a paperwork issue of some sort.

the tank clearly has been removed- it is no longer on the property and has not been for 14 years. I need to know what can be done to resolve this as I am in the process of selling my home and this is becoming an impediment.

Any consideration on this matter would be appreciated!
