John W. Pugh, General Manager of CLYDE BEATTY-COLE BROS CIRCUS on tour. Totally in charge of the complete circus operation on the road. Will arrive on the Circus lot ahead of any equipment or animals. He has knowledge of Circus operation, employees and equipment. Also who is responsible for each department.

Art Branning, Manager and is in charge of the front door, ticket takers, circus working men and equipment. Responsible for the "tear-down" and loading out and will be the last man off the lot at the end of the engagement.

Wilson Storey, Secretary-Treasure and Office Manager. Responsible for accounting, payroll, ticket auditing. Has knowledge of the show operation, employees and equipment. Office is located in the front ticket wagon at the entrance to the midway.

(Maria Rawls, Off. secy.)

Harry Rawls, Concession Manager and is responsible for the entire concession department, its employees and equipment. Usually found in the concession-semi located at the entrance to the circus tent.

J. Wendland, Side Show Manager and responsible for the Side Show employees, animals and equipment. Usually in the Side Show tent 30 minutes before and after the Circus performance.

Dave Hoover, Animal trainer for the Circus. Responsible for his own animals. For ELEPHANTS only, see Fred Logan, Supt. of Elephants.

Jimmy James, Circus Ringmaster and Announcer, makes all public announcements. Has knowledge of all performers, their animals and equipment.

John Herriott, Performance Director, Make all contacts for performers thru him.

Ed Ferlin, 24-Hr man for the Circus, arrives ahead of the circus by 24-hrs. to make final lot layout, parking assignments and checks final details for the circus arrival. Does some buying for the circus. He leaves the lot 24-hrs. before the final performance and arrows the next route.

S. Cunningham, Mail Agent for the Circus, handles mail between the PO and Circus.

_____, Local Market Director for the Circus. In residence several weeks ahead of the circus date. Responsible for all local arrangements and final details after the close of the date. Contact thru sponsor

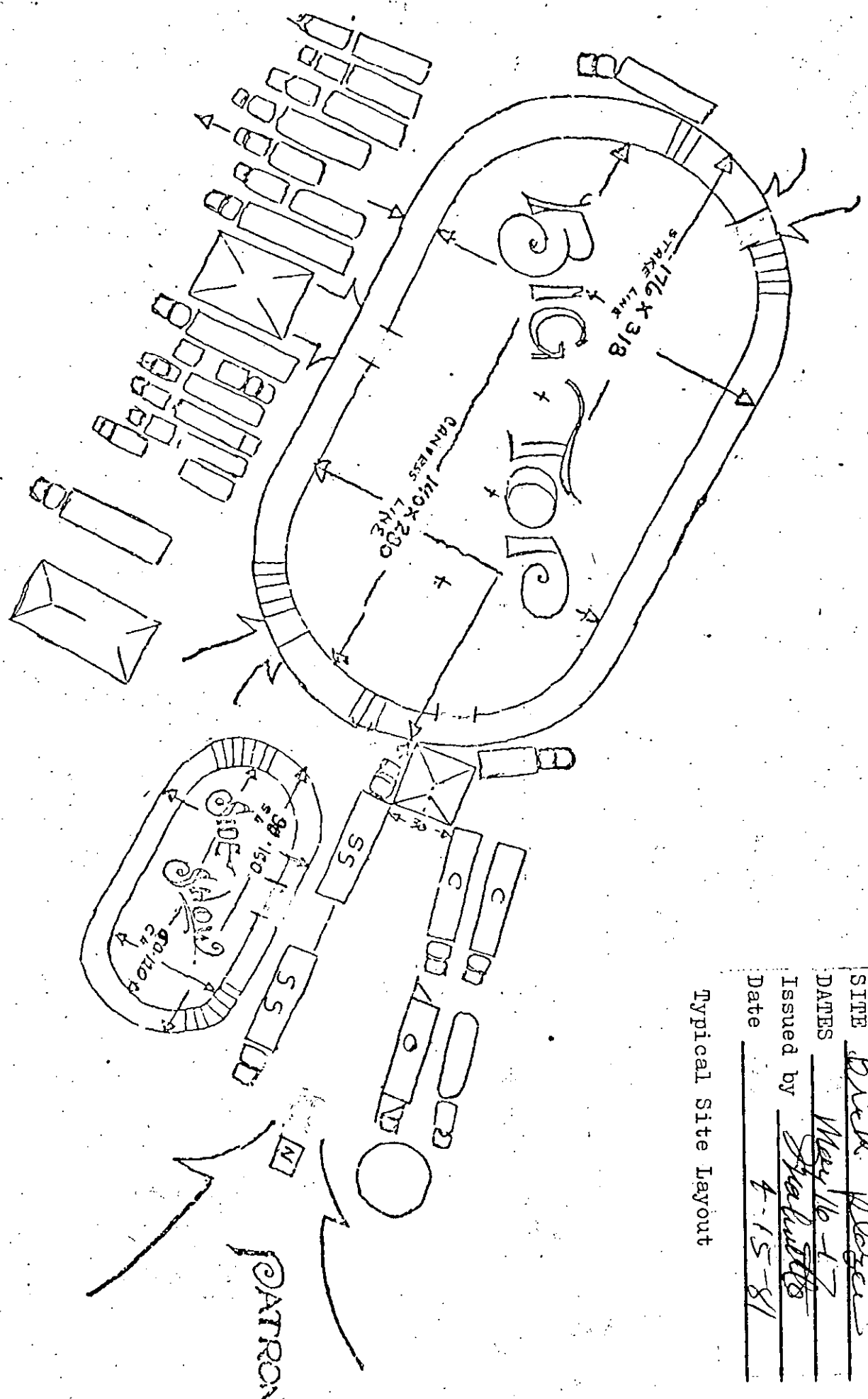

Typical Site Layout



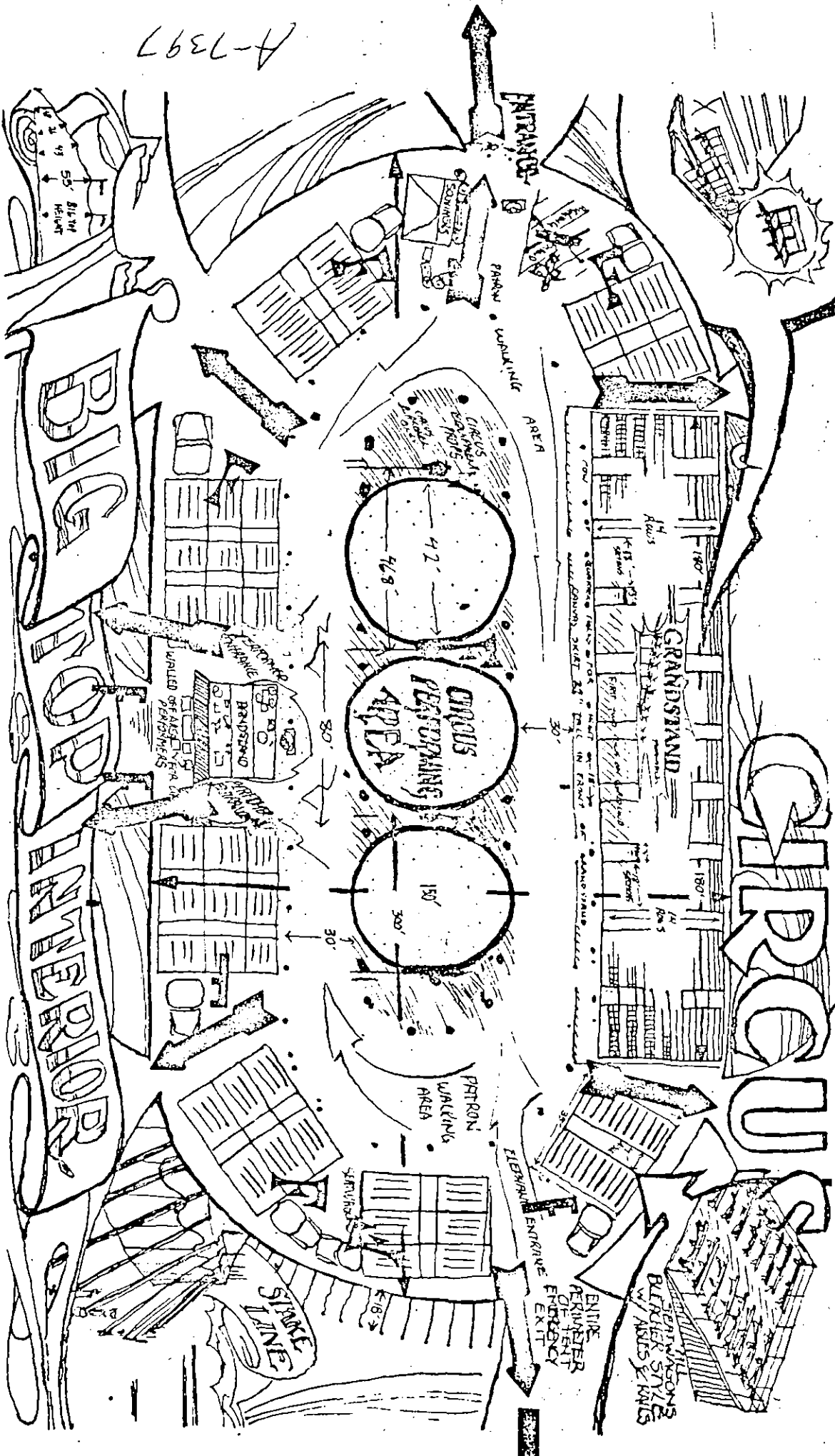

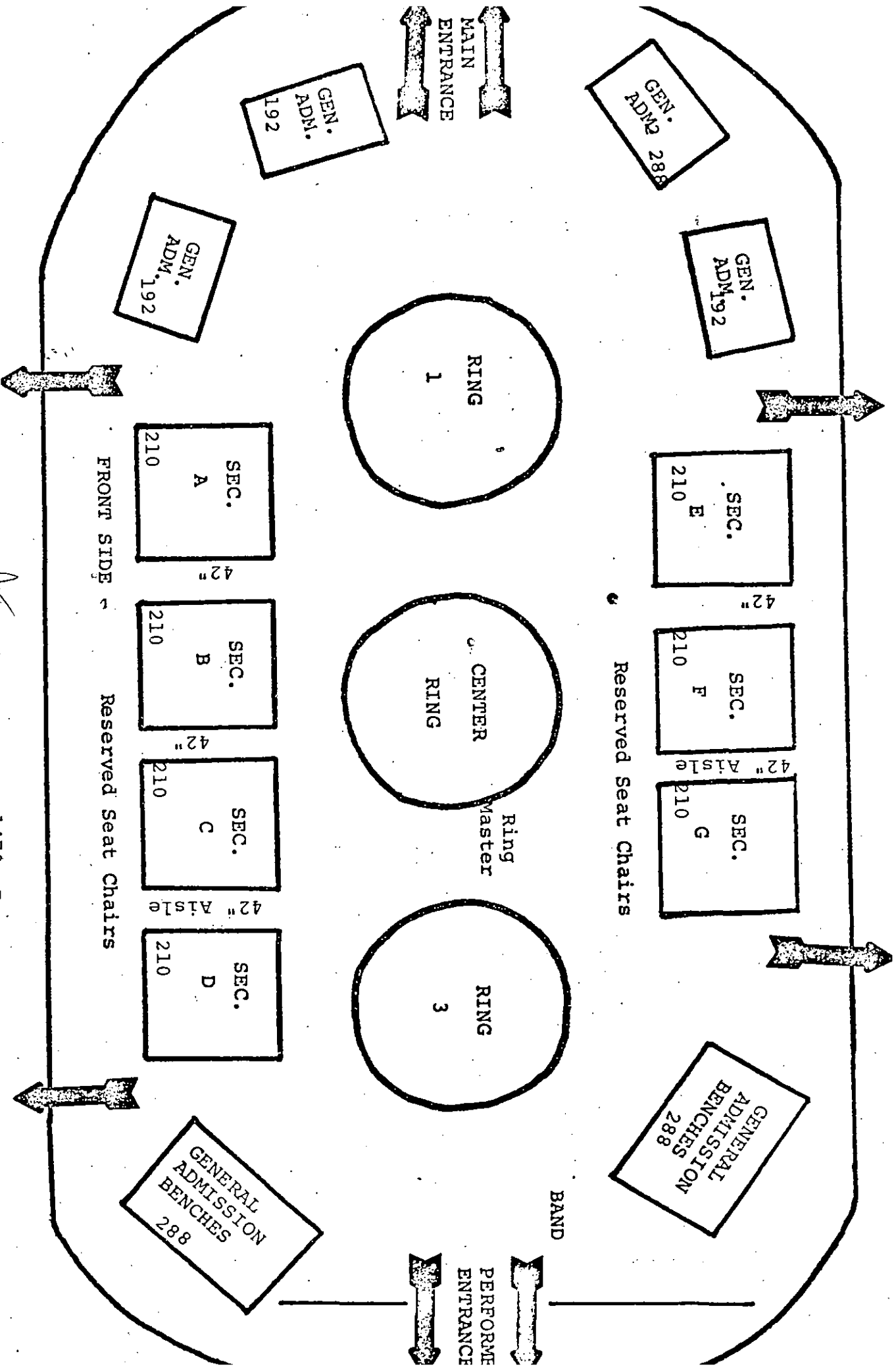

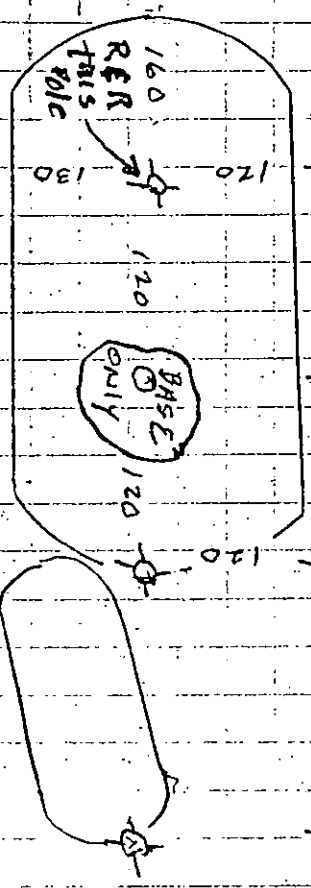
