The County of Salem received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on April 22, 2025. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is May 1, 2025. This response to your request is provided to you on the 5th day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"Records requested: Proposed long form detailed 2025-26 Alloway School District Budget."

The records you are requesting are being denied based on the following:

No Salem County government documents or records exist for this request. Your document will be forwarded to you directly from Jeannette Larkins, Records Custodian for the NJ Department of Education.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Salem to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
