Chief,

Good evening...

I apologize for the delayed response, I was on the road for most of the day today.

The consolettes in question are based on recommendations from the County. They recommend:

1 Consolette for PD

1 Consolette for FD

1 Consolette for County Operations. This is for special events or situations requiring a multi-agency response. This applies when the County assigns a specific talkgroup/channel for responding agencies to communicate with one another.

According to our records, one mobile control station radio is currently at the desk for Maywood PD. There is another radio, the County alert radio, which the County instructed they will remove when migration is complete. I suggest 2 consolettes (PD & FD) and repurposing the Maywood control station for the County operations radio. Additionally, we can remove the [REDACTED] from the consolettes [REDACTED] to reduce costs.

Regarding the patrol vehicles, the current design supports [REDACTED]. Also, we will remove the existing [REDACTED] radio to avoid potentially confusing the officer in high-stress situations.

We will not impact any recording or logging capabilities. You may want to touch base with BIS if you would like to add the consolleles to the logging recorder. The County records these channels and if you need something, simply send them the request and they'll get it for you. However, having access to radio transmissions on site through your existing logger may be helpful.

We planned to use the existing antenna line for the backup repeaters at PD. Since you are leaving the [REDACTED] and these units aren't covered under the contract there is no need to keep them in place. We would swap out the antenna on the roof and check and replace any grounding connections as required. Before installation, we will sweep the lines. If the antenna line is faulty, we will provide a separate quote for its replacement. Usually, the issue stems from a bad connector, which is easily replaced. This is common and done to help keep costs down.

I hope this addresses your questions and concerns. Please let me know if you would like any changes to the proposal, and I will get it done for you.

All,

Based on the 4th quote, everything looks appropriate except the number of consolleles. Unless anyone identifies a specific reason for installing more than one consollele at the desk, one should suffice. ***The Maywood PD radio at the desk already has all the necessary capabilities, which would give us two base stations at HQ.***

Regarding the mobiles, I feel that having two radios in the patrol car could lead to confusion during high stress situations and possibly cause an officer to call for assistance on the wrong microphone, therefore I am adamant that the dual-band mobile is the best option. The dual-band radio will allow us to continue leveraging the current township radio infrastructure in the future. ***This is because if the DPW and OEM are not assigned talkgroups on the county system,***

capabilities for the PD become absolutely necessary for communications during coordinated responses.

I don't know if there has been any conversation about our , sometimes referred to as ' here in Rochelle Park. Several years ago, I believe an agency used or attempted to use on a county talkgroup and it caused an issue. I'm not sure if that has been resolved or if the county will allow part-time usage. *However, we want to maintain this on the frequency, ; thus, this is yet another reason to keep the existing infrastructure in place.*

It is also noteworthy that if any existing radio system is used in the future, the recording system, including the secure channel recording, must also be maintained. This maintenance has a yearly fee of \$3,090.02 from BIS Digital.

The quote also references utilizing existing antenna cabling for the consolettes. Does this just mean running an antenna to the roof of police headquarters?

If anyone has additional comments, questions, or more technological information about radios than I do (which is likely), please feel free to chime in.

All,

I am currently digesting all of this information, but I have some questions and concerns that I will address in a more comprehensive email shortly.

Some concerns may actually help reduce the overall cost, but in the interim, I want to clearly state, I do not want to "force a new radio into vehicles." Some consoles may not have the spare room and more importantly, I do NOT want to force officers to think about which microphone they are using during critical and stressful moments just to ensure they are on the proper radio. Therefore, a multiband radio is a need, not a want.

We can certainly eliminate [REDACTED], but the new radios must have [REDACTED] for officer safety. This applies to the thirteen mobile radios listed under [REDACTED], ensuring only one mobile radio remains in each patrol vehicle.

I also need to add one more mobile unit for the Special Response Unit, which is an [REDACTED]

Good afternoon...

Attached is the revised proposal. After discussions with county representatives and the PD we made a few changes.

-Additional radios and consolettes were added to the proposal to fulfil the police department's needs.

-The patrol vehicles will use the [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] frequency for county system dispatch. These patrol cars already have equipment in place to handle [REDACTED] communications.

- The [REDACTED] will have [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].
- A few software options/features were removed as suggested by the county
- We adjusted installation and programming services for the additional equipment added to the proposal.

Other items to note with this proposal:

- All radios will have [REDACTED] for in-town and mutual aid needs.
- The proposal includes all equipment, parts, and labor for integration with the existing dispatch console.
- All of the radios can be upgraded in the field should the police department require any options later.

The pricing complies with the Motorola NJ state contract # 83909.

The purchase order should be made payable to Motorola Solutions and include Motorola's NJ state contract # 83909. The PO should be sent to me for processing through the Motorola purchasing portal.

Motorola will ship the equipment to the shipping address provided on the PO. Typically equipment ships 3 to 4 weeks from order acceptance. Once the equipment is received, we will coordinate with the police department to pick up the radio equipment for programming. We will coordinate with the county and the PD to ensure the programming includes all mutual aid and related talkgroups. Once programming is confirmed and accepted by Rochelle Park PD, we will begin installing the mobiles and consolettes. Based on the number of radios purchased, we expect this to take about a week or 2.

Based on the 4th quote, everything looks appropriate except the number of consolettes. Unless anyone identifies a specific reason for installing more than one consolette at the desk, one should suffice. ***The Maywood PD radio at the desk already has all the necessary capabilities, which would give us two base stations at HQ.***

Regarding the mobiles, I feel that having two radios in the patrol car could lead to confusion during high stress situations and possibly cause an officer to call for assistance on the wrong microphone, therefore I am adamant that the dual-band mobile is the best option. The dual-band radio will allow us to continue leveraging the current township radio infrastructure in the future. ***This is because if the DPW and OEM are not assigned talkgroups on the county system, capabilities for the PD become absolutely necessary for communications during coordinated responses.***

I don't know if there has been any conversation about our [REDACTED], sometimes referred to as [REDACTED] here in Rochelle Park. Several years ago, I believe an agency used or attempted to use partial encryption on a county talkgroup and it caused an issue. I'm not sure if that has been resolved or if the county will allow part-time usage. ***However, we want to maintain this [REDACTED] on the [REDACTED] frequency, [REDACTED]; thus, this is yet another reason to keep the existing infrastructure in place.***

It is also noteworthy that if any existing radio system is used in the future, the recording system, including the secure channel recording, must also be maintained. This maintenance has a yearly fee

of \$3,090.02 from BIS Digital.

The quote also references utilizing existing antenna cabling for the consolettes. Does this just mean running an antenna to the roof of police headquarters?

I am currently digesting all of this information, but I have some questions and concerns that I will address in a more comprehensive email shortly.

Some concerns may actually help reduce the overall cost, but in the interim, I want to clearly state, I do not want to "force a new radio into vehicles." Some consoles may not have the spare room and more importantly, I do NOT want to force officers to think about which microphone they are using during critical and stressful moments just to ensure they are on the proper radio. Therefore, a multiband radio is a need, not a want.

We can certainly eliminate [REDACTED] but the new radios must have [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] for officer safety. This applies to the thirteen mobile radios listed under [REDACTED], ensuring only one mobile radio remains in each patrol vehicle.

I apologize for the delayed response, I was on the road for most of the day today.

The consolettes in question are based on recommendations from the County. They recommend:

1 Consolette for PD

1 Consolette for FD

1 Consolette for County Operations. This is for special events or situations requiring a multi-agency response. This applies when the County assigns a specific talkgroup/channel for responding agencies to communicate with one another.

According to our records, one mobile control station radio is currently at the desk for Maywood PD. There is another radio, the County alert radio, which the County instructed they will remove when migration is complete. I suggest 2 consolettes (PD & FD) and repurposing the Maywood control station for the County operations radio. Additionally, we can remove the [REDACTED] from the consolettes ([REDACTED]) to reduce costs.

Regarding the patrol vehicles, the current design supports [REDACTED] operations. Also, we will remove the existing [REDACTED] radio to avoid potentially confusing the officer in high-stress situations.

We will not impact any recording or logging capabilities. You may want to touch base with BIS if you would like to add the consolettes to the logging recorder. The County records these channels and if you need something, simply send them the request and they'll get it for you. However, having access to radio transmissions on site through your existing logger may be helpful.

We planned to use the existing antenna line for the backup repeaters at PD. Since you are leaving the [REDACTED] system and these units aren't covered under the contract there is no need to keep them in

I apologize for the delayed response, I was on the road for most of the day today.

The consolettes in question are based on recommendations from the County. They recommend:

1 Consolette for PD

1 Consolette for FD

1 Consolette for County Operations. This is for special events or situations requiring a multi-agency response. This applies when the County assigns a specific talkgroup/channel for responding agencies to communicate with one another.

According to our records, one mobile control station radio is currently at the desk for Maywood PD. There is another radio, the County alert radio, which the County instructed they will remove when migration is complete. I suggest 2 consolettes (PD & FD) and repurposing the Maywood control station for the County operations radio. Additionally, we can remove the UHF/VHF from the consolettes (700MHz only) to reduce costs.

Regarding the patrol vehicles, the current design supports UHF & 700MHz operations. Also, we will

remove the existing [REDACTED] radio to avoid potentially confusing the officer in high-stress situations.

[REDACTED]

We will not impact any recording or logging capabilities. You may want to touch base with BIS if you would like to add the consoles to the logging recorder. The County records these channels and if you need something, simply send them the request and they'll get it for you. However, having access to radio transmissions on site through your existing logger may be helpful.

We planned to use the existing antenna line for the backup repeaters at PD. Since you are leaving the UHF system and these units aren't covered under the contract there is no need to keep them in place. We would swap out the antenna on the roof and check and replace any grounding connections as required. Before installation, we will sweep the lines. If the antenna line is faulty, we will provide a separate quote for its replacement. Usually, the issue stems from a bad connector, which is easily replaced. This is common and done to help keep costs down.

I hope this addresses your questions and concerns. Please let me know if you would like any changes to the proposal, and I will get it done for you.

All,

Based on the 4th quote, everything looks appropriate except the number of consolettes. Unless anyone identifies a specific reason for installing more than one consolette at the desk, one should suffice. ***The Maywood PD radio at the desk already has all the necessary capabilities, which would give us two base stations at HQ.***

Regarding the mobiles, I feel that having two radios in the patrol car could lead to confusion during high stress situations and possibly cause an officer to call for assistance on the wrong microphone, therefore I am adamant that the dual-band mobile is the best option. The dual-band radio will allow

us to continue leveraging the current township radio infrastructure in the future. ***This is because if the DPW and OEM are not assigned talkgroups on the county system, [REDACTED] capabilities for the PD become absolutely necessary for communications during coordinated responses.***

I don't know if there has been any conversation about our [REDACTED], sometimes referred to as [REDACTED] here in Rochelle Park. Several years ago, I believe an agency used or attempted to use partial encryption on a county talkgroup and it caused an issue. I'm not sure if that has been resolved or if the county will allow part-time usage. ***However, we want to maintain this [REDACTED] on the [REDACTED] frequency, [REDACTED] thus, this is yet another reason to keep the existing infrastructure in place.***

It is also noteworthy that if any existing radio system is used in the future, the recording system, including the secure channel recording, must also be maintained. This maintenance has a yearly fee of \$3,090.02 from BIS Digital.

The quote also references utilizing existing antenna cabling for the consolettes. Does this just mean running an antenna to the roof of police headquarters?
