The Township of Hamilton received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on May 23, 2023. Your response is being supplied on June 1, 2023.

3. Radio log. This information will incur a special cost total of \$219.99 in order to review, redact, and supervisory review the information prior to dissemination. This will be supplied after receiving payment in the amount listed.
4. Reports are attached. Reports 22-29210, 20-31859, 20-26174, 20-24965, 20-24196 have been redacted protecting the name of the juvenile and other personal identifying information as well as for privacy concerns. Report 20-23465 is denied due to the report involving an investigation of domestic violence. We have determined that this record is confidential pursuant to the confidentiality provisions of the Prevention of Domestic Violence Act of 1991, per N.J.S.A. 2A:25-33, and the Open Public Records Act, per N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9, because they relate to a domestic violence incident covered by the PDVA. We also refer you to the following decisions of the New Jersey Government Records Council: Daniel VanBree v. Bridgewater Tp. Police Dept., Complaint No. 2014-122 (Final Decision, Oct. 28, 2014) and Karen Jean Butala v. Tp. of Aberdeen (Monmouth), Complaint No. 2014-194 (Final Decision, Feb. 24, 2015).
5. Please be more specific in your request, "Etc".

1. All government records are subject to public access under the Open Public Records Act ("OPRA"), unless specifically exempt.

2. A request for access to a government record under OPRA must be in writing, hand-delivered, mailed, transmitted electronically, or otherwise conveyed to the appropriate custodian. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.g. The seven (7) business day response time does not commence until the records custodian receives the request form. If you submit the request form to any other officer or employee of the Township of Hamilton, that

officer or employee must either forward the request to the appropriate custodian, or direct you to the appropriate custodian. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.h.

3. Requestors may submit requests anonymously. If you elect not to provide a name, address, or telephone number, or other means of contact, the custodian is not required to respond until you reappear before the custodian seeking a response to the original request.

4. The fees for duplication of a government record in printed form are listed on the front of this form. We will notify you of any special service charges or other additional charges authorized by State law or regulation before processing your request. Payment shall be made by cash, check or money order payable to the Township of Hamilton.

5. *you may be charged a 50% or other deposit when a request for copies exceeds \$25.* The Township of Hamilton custodian will contact you and advise you of any deposit requirements. You agree to pay the balance due upon delivery of the records. Anonymous requests in excess of \$5.00 require a deposit of 100% of estimated fees.

6. Under OPRA, a custodian must deny access to a person who has been convicted of an indictable offense in New Jersey, any other state, or the United States, **and** who is seeking government records containing personal information pertaining to the person's victim or the victim's family. This includes anonymous requests for said information.

7. By law, the Township of Hamilton must notify you that it grants or denies a request for access to government records within seven (7) business days after the agency custodian of records receives the request. If the record requested is not currently available or is in storage, the custodian will advise you within seven (7) business days after receipt of the request when the record can be made available and the estimated cost for reproduction.

8. You may be denied access to a government record if your request would substantially disrupt agency operations and the custodian is unable to reach a reasonable solution with you.

9. If the Township of Hamilton is unable to comply with your request for access to a government record, the custodian will indicate the reasons for denial on the request form or other written correspondence and send you a signed and dated copy.

10. Except as otherwise provided by law or by agreement with the requester, if the agency custodian of records fails to respond to you within seven (7) business days of receiving a request, the failure to respond is a deemed denial of your request.

11. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Hamilton to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at PO Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

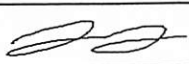

interfering with a custody order and stated that it is none of her business in regards to his vehicle situation. Juan went on to advise me of the history between him and Sarah in regards to the previous [REDACTED] Juan advised that he does have a court date with Sarah set for 10/15/2020.

Both parties wanted the incident documented. Both parties were given a business card with a case number. Sarah then left and turned [REDACTED] over to Juan.

I then left the lobby area. While I was walking out to my patrol vehicle dispatch advised that Juan wanted to speak to an officer again. I then walked back out to the lobby and spoke to Juan. Juan advised that he believes that Sarah is stalking him again. Juan indicated that Sarah drove into the parking lot across the street to observe him leave with [REDACTED] Juan indicated that he felt threatened by Sarah's presence and that this interaction is now causing [REDACTED] to be distracted from [REDACTED] online school work.

I then walked across the street and observed Sarah sitting in her vehicle. I watched as Sarah pulled a laptop onto her lap, but I noticed that it was not turned on. I advised Sarah of Juan's concerns and asked if she could go somewhere else. Sarah appeared offended and stated that she was trying to do her work and send off a few emails. Sarah eventually agreed to leave and left the area. I then left the area as well.

Shortly after entering the police department Juan came over and advised that Sarah came back. Sgt. Schnurr escorted Juan and [REDACTED] into the secure side of the police department while I stayed in the lobby to speak to Sarah. Sarah came into the lobby and advised that she was only coming in to use the bathroom. While Sarah was using the bathroom Sgt. Schnurr transported Juan and [REDACTED] to a different location so there would be no issue while Juan waited for a his transportation to arrive.

Patrol cleared, nothing further.

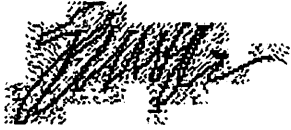
