RESOLUTION 029-2020

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF MEETINGS OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL CONCERNING TIME FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND VIDEO RECORDING OF MEETINGS

WHEREAS, New Jersey law permits municipalities to establish reasonable rules regarding the length of public comment at meetings of public bodies and regarding the video recording of meetings by members of the public; and

WHEREAS, for the orderly operation of its meetings, the governing body of the Borough of Atlantic Highlands finds that it is reasonable and necessary to establish the following rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the Borough of Atlantic Highlands hereby establishes the following rules for the orderly conduct of meetings of the Mayor and Council:

1. ~~Public comment shall be limited to three (3) minutes per person;~~
2. Any person making a video recording of a meeting of the Mayor and Council shall be permitted to use only one (1) recording device.
3. Recording devices shall be unobtrusive and not block aisles, doorways, or other means of ingress or egress into the Council Chambers;
4. Any person making a video recording of a meeting of the Mayor and Council shall not record any person under the age of eighteen (18), unless that individual is a family member, or at the request of a family member of the person being recorded.
