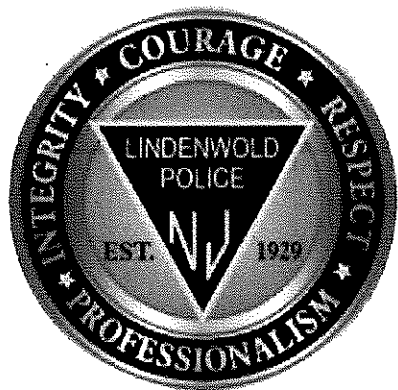

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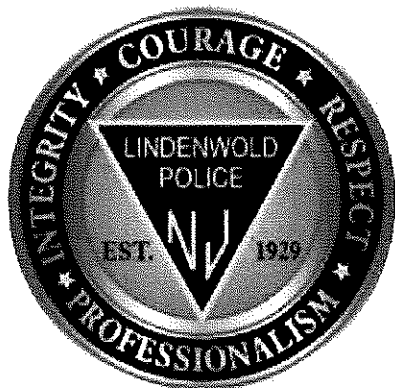

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Good Morning,

I would like to acknowledge Chief McCarthy, Captain Cavallaro, Councilmember DiDomenico, and Borough Administrator Dawn Thompson for meeting with me yesterday to discuss how to "Bridge the Gap" to distressed neighborhoods with community policing strategies.

I would like to thank Chief McCarthy, in particular, for keeping the dialogue open, committing to the evolution of the community policing philosophy and to making positive interactions with law enforcement more accessible to citizens, in addition to ongoing efforts like "Cone with a Cop", Police trading card program, Basketball camp, and the popular "Hooked on Fishing Event".

I've included below, a summary of notes and takeaways from the meeting.

Chief McCarthy Goals:

Coordinate rides for kids for basketball camp and junior police academy who wants to attend, but cannot due to logistics limitations.

Reiterate officer empowered initiation for trading card program.

Increased foot patrol vs vehicle patrol for VTCCA to enable trading card engagement.

Sarah Vellner Goals:

Increase community engagement with LPD by continuing to promote LPD events and initiatives, especially within VTCCA

Enable and empower neighbors to reach out to law enforcement and see them as partners.

Encourage use of mental health crisis resources where appropriate.

Provide strategies and community partnerships for LPD consideration.

Stretch goals:

LPD endorsed, Community driven block party

LPD encouragement to VTCCA to provide safe areas for kids to play

LPD outreach in distressed neighborhoods(pop-up block party, bike safety/repair workshop, joining The Greens and Pine Hill PD for Resident Appreciation Day, Good Citizens program, etc.)

Cross-Complex Basketball Tournament

Your attention to this matter and willingness to engage in finding ways to meet and reach citizens of Lindenwold where they live and play is admirable and greatly appreciated.

I will follow up privately with Chief McCarthy to provide further details on potential community partnerships and strategies for LPD.

Complaints regarding 1801 Laurel Road, Lindenwold NJ 08021, the Village of Timber Creek Condo Association:

Kiddie swimming pool was never repaired. Instead, it was filled in with soil by and unqualified professional, and remains a massive mosquito breeding ground as well as a health risk for other reasons.

Playgrounds: Both one Greenwood Drive and Timber Creek Drive sides are deteriorated to the point of danger. Last summer, kids were getting 3rd degree burns and nasty splinters routinely from playing on the delapidated equipment.

Retaining walls all over the complex are rotten and collapsing. In some places, the ground is completely collapsed into a tunnel.

Trash dumpsters are rarely accessible. I routinely hear from elderly neighbors they they are struggling to dispose of their household solid waste because they cannot open the dumpsters. Management and the association refuse any conversation about making dumpsters and trash/litter disposal more accessible to residents.

Raw sewage routinely bubbles up out of the ground next to the 1000 building.

Sidewalks are dangerous. They are uneven, and often flood, making walkways impassible in the warmer months and hidden, icy fall risks in the colder months.

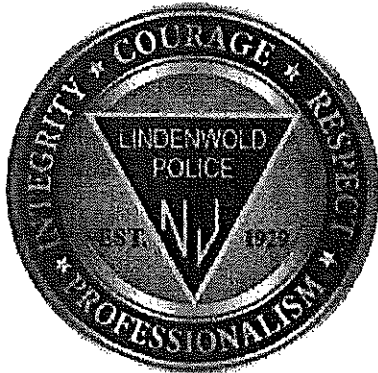

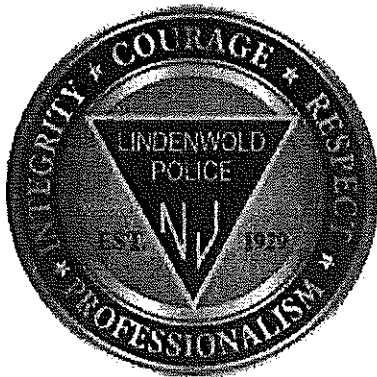

Good Afternoon Dt. Tomasetti,

I am writing to you in reference to Case # 202005152 and an incident that occurred on Sunday, 3/15.

On Sunday, March 15, I was at home with all 3 of my children, having initiated our COVID19 social isolation beginning Friday, 3/13.

In the late afternoon of Sunday, 3/16, my children were downstairs in the living room, playing "Just Dance" when a Lindenwold Police Officer appeared in my living. Not at the door. In my living. Inside my house. The officer asked my children, including my daughter(13) and my son(11) to speak to the adult of the house.

I first learned the officer was inside my residence when my kids opened my bathroom door to announce his presence and request to speak with an adult. Before I could wrap up my business on the toilet and speak with the officer, my kids again barreled up the stairs to tell me he was leaving, saying something about "wrong house".

However, from my bedroom window on the second floor, I observed the officer continue to circle and pass by my house, stopping to observe and take notes.

On Monday, March 16th, I called the Lindenwold PD to inquire about the incident on 3/15, and I was given the above referenced case # along with your contact information.

I left 3 voicemail messages asking you to call me back, so I can understand what happened on 3/15 and if my family is safe. I would like to understand why the Lindenwold Police Officer entered my home without permission, invitation or

cause? My 13yo daughter was embarrassed to be caught dancing in her pajama shorts and no bra by an unknown adult male in her own home. I am struggling to understand why the officer left without speaking to an adult after entering without permission, invitation or cause, and after only speaking with my children.

Additionally, is the aspect of the coronavirus and the officer breaking the standards of isolation I had established for my household. When the officer left without speaking to an adult, I lost the ability to identify him. What if he was a carrier for the virus and brought that into my house?

At this point, it has been nearly a month since the incident, so I don't think coronavirus exposure occurred, but, either way, I am disappointed by the officer's behavior and disheartened further by your lack of response over the past month.

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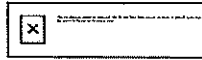

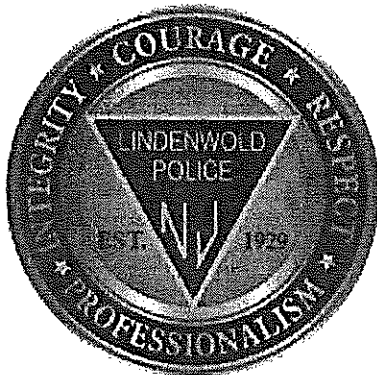

Hello Unit Owners,

Thank you to everyone who responded to our flyers by email, text and phone, and especially to those who joined our Zoom meeting on April 6th.

Your voice and your stories are what make us powerful and will make us effectual.

It is both deeply saddening and frustrating to hear your experiences as well as encouraging. It is encouraging to know that there are so many of us. There is power in numbers.

I want to be clear that this legal action follows MANY months of attempting to work with the BOD, property management and attorneys for VTCCA, only to be met with deflection and retaliation from all VTCCA parties.

For months, access to routine association documents was denied to unit owners. It was eventually revealed by VTCCA attorneys that one of the reasons they are unable to provide access to records of board meetings and financial decisions regarding the shareholders common funds, is that those records were not kept.

Let me repeat that. No records of board meetings, financial or ministerial decisions has been kept under the former AND current treasurer for the VTCCA board of directors.

When the current board asks you to be patient while they learn about the situation at VTCCA, they are lying to you. It is the same people in control of your common funds and common property.

In light of this refusal to honor unit owner rights, we are left with no other choice than to move forward with a shareholder derivative lawsuit.

Our next steps are:

1) Identify the unit owners who are interested in adding your name to the list of Plaintiff's in the shareholders derivative lawsuit against VTCCA.

Please RESPOND to this email with "I'm in" and include your unit number.

2) Establish a private email distribution and meeting series for this group of unit owners to meet and discuss the details and direction of the lawsuit with our legal counsel. This approach will protect attorney client privilege. If you want a front row seat, respond "I'm in!" along with your unit number

3) Once the full list of Plaintiffs for the lawsuit is identified, we will meet privately to determine group rules and discuss with our attorney exactly which demands to include our suit and how to phrase those demands.

4) File the lawsuit complaint. Petition the court to charge our legal fees to VTCCA.

4) Organize a block party or alternative fund raising event to raise funds for potential legal fees. Our attorney has graciously agreed to represent us pro bono; however, there are other nominal fees related to court filings fees, etc. Not a lot, but more than I can cover out of my own pocket. Those filing and deposition transcripts fees will need to be covered in the event the court does not order VTCCA to cover shareholders legal fees.

Any funds raised and NOT used for legal fees will be used to found a 501(c)(3) corporation that will be focused on sustainable development and sourcing alternative funding for neighborhood improvements.

5) Finally, there is a new topic in our facebook group, #RepairsbyBuilding. You can report building and grounds disrepair by posting a photo to the group and including the building #. We will use the posts in this topic to catalog and prioritize repairs.
