Your district is scheduled to undergo NJQSAC review this year under the New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) process. The Sussex County Office of Education has tentatively scheduled this meeting to occur with you and your QSAC team on **April 2, 2025, at 9:30 am** to discuss the progress your district is achieving towards the overall goal of creating *equitable access to high quality education and achieving academic excellence for all students* through the review of *all* District Performance Review (DPR) areas.

As you know, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) has approved a revised version of the QSAC DPRs and therefore, a revised process for conducting the full visit. In order to prepare for a review utilizing the revised version, we are asking you to ensure the following:

- Your district has submitted all required documentation to the *NJDOE Homeroom* page by **November 15**. This is to include DPR; Excel File; PDF file of signed Declaration Page and signed Board Resolution approving DPR for submission.
- The Sussex County Office has **ELECTRONIC** access to all verification documents that adhere to the respective DPR(s) under review.
- Remote access to indicator documentation is available to the County Office **30 days prior** to the scheduled on-site visit.

It is expected that all relevant support documentation will be available at the time of the scheduled NJQSAC site visit. Any documentation required pursuant to our scheduled visit is expected to be received by the Sussex County Office of Education **no later than 14 calendar days beyond the site visit**.

The county office will be reviewing ALL FIVE INDICATORS in each of the DPR sections of the following QSAC document: <https://nj.gov/education/code/current/title6a/chap30AppA.pdf>. Your colleagues at the Sussex County Office strongly encourage you and your QSAC team to review the

document (https://www.nj.gov/education/qsac/manual/docs/NJQSAC_Manual.pdf) prior to our visit to ensure that you have all of the required documentation. For specific questions regarding the submission of electronic documentation, please contact the staff responsible for overseeing each DPR area: **Governance** (Dr. Gayle Carrick); **Operations** (Dr. Adam Kendler); **Fiscal** (Neil Cramer); and **Instruction and Program and Personnel** (Michael Slattery).

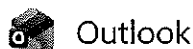

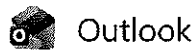

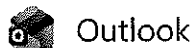

As noted in the 6/5 broadcast:

The due date to submit and certify your agency's Student Safety Data System (SSDS) data for the 2023-2024 school year is August 12, 2024. The SSDS collects incidents of violence, vandalism, weapons, substances, harassment, intimidation and bullying (HIB), restraint, seclusion and other incidents leading to removal, as well as HIB trainings and programs conducted to support anti-bullying efforts.

In addition to submitting data to the SSDS system, Indicator 6 requires:

District board of education minutes indicating that the summary of incidents for Report Period 1, September 1 through December 31, and Report Period 2, January 1 through June 30, are presented to the district board of education by the superintendent or designee at a public meeting once between January and June and once between July and December.
