

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 8th day of January 2019 by and between the TOWNSHIP OF WESTAMPTON, in the County of Burlington, a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as the "Township" having its principal office at 710 Rancocas Road, Westampton, NJ 08060 and David Minchello of Rainone Coughlin Minchello, hereinafter referred to as "Township Solicitor" having their principal office at 555 U.S. Highway One South, Suite 440, Iselin, New Jersey, 08830.

WHEREAS, Westampton Township enters this contract without formal bids as a professional services contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i) and under a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.: and

WHEREAS, upon review of Westampton Township's policies and provisions with respect to criteria for selecting professionals under the fair and open process set forth above, Westampton Township finds David Minchello of Rainone Coughlin Minchello to be well qualified and possessing the required professional skill and ability to provide legal services.

WITNESSETH:

1. AGREEMENT TO HIRE AND PERFORM: The Township agrees to hire and employ attorney, and attorney agrees to perform the duties of Township Solicitor.
2. SCOPE OF DUTIES: Attorney shall perform all duties required and to take any and all necessary action with respect to the following matter: as designated by the Township Committee.

3. COMPENSATION: Upon performance of his duties, Attorney shall be compensated as follows:

- a. A flat salary in the amount of \$36,000 paid in twelve (12) regular monthly installments plus out of pocket expenses.
- b. Reimbursement for all necessary costs in the handling of the township business.
- c. Litigation which the Township wishes to pursue or in which the Township is named as a defendant, as well as any special projects that the Township may assign are not included in the flat fee arrangement and will be billed at an hourly rate of \$140.00 per hour, plus expenses.

4. TERM OF CONTRACT: This contract is effective immediately and shall expire December 31, 2019 or until a replacement is named.

5. REPORTING OBLIGATIONS: Attorney acknowledges and agrees to abide by the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27 which require a business entity who has made any contribution of money or any other thing of value, including an in-kind contribution, or pledged to make a contribution of any kind to a candidate for, or the holder of any public office having ultimate responsibility for the awarding of public contracts, or to a political party committee, legislative leadership committee, political committee or continuing political committee, which has received in any calendar year Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars or more in the aggregate through agreements or contracts with public entities, shall file an annual Disclosure Statement with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("NJELEC") in the format and within the time prescribed by NJELEC.

6. INDEMNIFICATION AND LIABILITY INSURANCE:

a. Each party agrees to indemnify the other party hereto, and save harmless the other party and its officers, officials, agents, servants and employees against and from any and all claims, suits and costs of every kind, type or description, and any and all damages and liability to which they may be subjected, by reason of injury to the person or property of third parties resulting from or in any way arising out of the negligent performance or lack of performance of this Agreement by the indemnifying party and its agents, employees, affiliates, successors and/or assigns.

b. As further assurance to Township, but not in any way limiting Attorney's liability for indemnification, Attorney shall, during the performance of the work to be performed pursuant to this agreement, keep in force at least the following insurance:

- 1) Workers compensation and employees liability insurance.
- 2) Commercial general liability covering both bodily injury with limits of \$1,000,000 per person and \$1,000,000 per accident and property damage with limits of \$1,000,000 per accident.
- 3) A professional errors and omissions policy covering Labor Attorney for public liability in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.

c. Attorney shall supply Township with a certificate evidencing coverage and shall from time to time provide Township with such further assistance as may be requested to substantiate that such insurance is in full force and effect.

7. **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:** During the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

- A. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sex, disability or sexual orientation. The Attorney will take affirmative

action to ensure that such applicants are recruited and employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sex, disability or sexual orientation. Such action shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The Attorney agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this non-discrimination clause.

- B. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sex, disability or sexual orientation.
- C. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union or representative or workers with which it has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer advising the labor union or workers' representative of the Attorney's commitments under this act and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.
- D. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, C.127, as amended and supplemented from time to time.
- E. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to attempt in good faith to employ minority and female workers consistent with the applicable county employment goals prescribed by section N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2 promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant P.L. 1975, C.127, as amended and supplemented from time to time or in accordance with a binding determination of the applicable county employment goals determined by the Affirmative Action Office pursuant to section N.J.A.C. 17-27-5.2 promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, C. 127, as amended and supplemented from time to time.
- F. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to inform in writing appropriate recruitment agencies in the area, including employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sex, disability or sexual

orientation and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

- G. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personnel testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.
- H. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sex, disability or sexual orientation, and conform with the applicable employment goals, consistent with the statutes and court decisions and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.
- I. The Attorney or subcontractor, where applicable, shall furnish such reports or other documents to the Affirmative Action Office as may be requested by the office from time to time in order to carry out the purposes of these regulations, and public agencies shall furnish such information as may be requested by the Affirmative Action Office for conducting a compliance investigation pursuant to Subchapter 10 of the Administrative Code (N.J.A.C. 17:27).

8. AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990:

Discrimination on the basis of disability in contracting for the purchase of goods and services is prohibited. Bidders are required to read Americans with Disabilities language that is included below and agree that the provisions of Title II of the Act are made a part of the contract. The contractor is obligated to comply with the Act and to hold the owner harmless.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990
Equal Opportunity for Individuals with Disability

The contractor and the Township, (hereafter "owner") do hereby agree that the provisions of Title II of the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 (the "Act") (42 U.S.C. S121 01 et seq.), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by

public entities in all services, programs, and activities provided or made available by public entities, and the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant there unto, are made a part of this contract. In providing any aid, benefit, or service on behalf of the owner pursuant to this contract, the contractor agrees that the performance shall be in strict compliance with the Act. In the event that the contractor, its agents, servants, employees, or subcontractors violate or are alleged to have violated the Act during the performance of this contract, the contractor shall defend the owner in any action or administrative proceeding commenced pursuant to this Act. The contractor shall indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner, its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages, of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of the alleged violation. The contractor shall, at its own expense, appear, defend, and pay any and all charges for legal services and any and all costs and other expenses arising from such action or administrative proceeding or incurred in connection therewith. In any and all complaints brought pursuant to the owner's grievance procedure, the contractor agrees to abide by any decision of the owner which is rendered pursuant to said grievance procedure. If any action or administrative proceeding results in an award of damages against the owner, or if the owner incurs any expense to cure a violation of the ADA which has been brought pursuant to its grievance procedure, the contractor shall satisfy and discharge the same at its own expense.

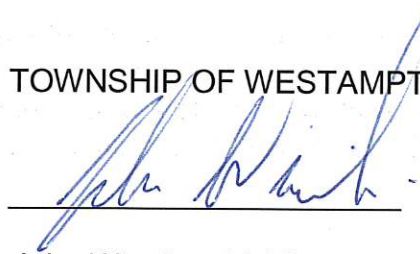
The owner shall, as soon as practicable after a claim has been made against it, give written notice thereof to the contractor along with full and complete particulars of the claim. If any action or administrative proceeding is brought against the owner or any of its agents, servants, and employees, the *owner shall* expeditiously forward or have forwarded to the contractor every demand, complaint, notice, summons, pleading, or other process received by the owner or its representatives.

It is expressly agreed and understood that any approval by the owner of the services provided by the contractor pursuant to this contract will not relieve the contractor of the obligation to comply with the Act and to defend, indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner pursuant to this paragraph.

It is further agreed and understood that the owner assumes no obligation to indemnify or save harmless the contractor, its agents, servants, employees and subcontractors for any claim which may arise out of their performance of this Agreement. Furthermore, the contractor expressly understands and agrees that the provisions of this indemnification clause shall in no way limit the contractor's obligations assumed in this Agreement, nor shall they be construed to relieve the contractor from any liability, nor preclude the owner from taking any other actions available to it under any other provisions of the Agreement or otherwise at law.

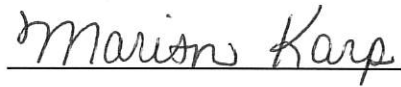
