Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On December 12th, 2021, the Jackson Police Department were contacted in reference to a sexual assault. At approximately 0257 hours on this day, Jackson Police were dispatched to a report of an active physical altercation at [REDACTED]. Upon arrival officers spoke with the victim, identified as [REDACTED] who related that he was concerned that the suspect, Ramon Cruz, sexually assaulted [REDACTED]. On scene, officers called first aid to examine the victim. She did not wake up for the duration of the time that the police and medical staff were on scene. [REDACTED]

On Monday, December 13, 2021, Agent Valdes took a statement of [REDACTED] M. According to [REDACTED] on Saturday, December 11, 2021, Ramon Cruz and Daniel Cruz came to his house to eat and drink alcohol. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the victim had consumed approximately 10 or more beers and that at some point during the night, the victim passed out. At some point during the night, the suspect got up stating he was going to use the bathroom. Mr. [REDACTED] noticed that the suspect was taking too long and decided to go look for him. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he entered the bedroom and saw the victim was laying on the bed unconscious, while the suspect had his pants and underwear below his knees, holding both of the victims' legs up in the air while the victim's leggings and underwear were down to her ankles. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he yelled at the suspect, which prompted the suspect to pull up his pants. Mr. [REDACTED] said he saw the suspect button up his pants and Daniel and the suspect began to beat Mr. [REDACTED]. His daughter, J. [REDACTED] arrived at the house and proceeded to called 9-1-1. Mr. [REDACTED] states that Police officers arrived at the scene shortly after and they attempted to wake the victim but were not successful.

2. I am aware of the facts above because: (Included, but not limited to: your observations, statements of eyewitnesses, defendant's admission, etc.)

Agent Valdes also took a statement from the victim. The victim stated that she consumed approximately 10 or more beers that evening. The victim states that her husband told her that she fell asleep on him, so he proceeded to carry her in to their bedroom. The victim stated that her husband told her what transpired after he put her to bed; however, the victim stated that she is concerned because she did not wake up and she did not feel anything or was aware at any point of what was happening. The victim stated that she does fall asleep sometimes, but she is able to wake up when her husband and her children wake her up. [REDACTED]

3. If victim was injured, provide the extent of the injury:

The victim placed a consensual telephone to suspect, Ramon Cruz. During said call the victim asked the suspect what happened the night of the incident. The victim told the suspect that her husband, [REDACTED] saw what he was doing to her in the bedroom. The suspect stated he does not remember what happened, but that if they are saying he took off her clothes, maybe he did but his heart tells him he didn't have sex with her. The suspect apologized for whatever happened. [REDACTED]

On December 28th, 2021, Det. Bonilla conducted a statement of the suspect. During the statement, the suspect said he went into the bedroom where the victim was asleep. He stated he took off her pants and he lowered his, exposing his penis. He stated there was contact between his penis and her vagina. He stated she was asleep when this occurred.
