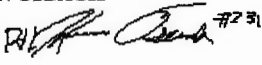
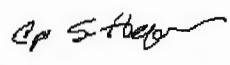

I responded to 5 Forest Drive for the report of a male threatening the caller over something he had bought from the caller. Upon my arrival, I made contact with the caller Tarek Elshayeb. Tarek said that over the weekend he had sold his quad through Facebook Market Place. Tarek said it was a Yamaha Raptor 700, and he had sold it for \$6,300.00. Tarek said the male, who's name on Facebook was Elvys Durant had come to his house and taken the quad for a test drive and decided to buy it. Tarek said the quad was pretty much brand new and had a lot of people interested in buying it. Tarek said earlier in the day today, the buyer called him and said that after riding the quad all day Sunday it began to overheat and needed about \$800.00 to a \$1,000.00 in repairs. Tarek told him that unfortunately the quad was sold as is, and he would not be refunding him any money. Tarek further stated the quad was pretty much brand new, and the buyer must have done something to it to cause the issue. While on the phone with the buyer, the buyers cousin got on the phone and began threatening Tarek, saying he was going to come to his house and beat him up. After having this conversation Tarek decided to call the police. While I was on scene, the buyer again called asking for money back. At this point, I got on the phone and told the buyer, who refused to provide me with his name or any other pedigree information, that unfortunately the quad was sold as is. I further advised him that if he wanted any type of money from Tarek, his only option would be through civil court. The buyer did apologize for his cousins behavior, and said he had only said those things out of frustration. I then disconnected with the buyer. I advised Tarek to block the buyers phone number and instant messenger on Facebook. I further advised him that I would document the incident for him, and if anything else were to occur, to contact the police immediately. I then cleared the scene. No further action.
