Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On January 14, 2020, the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, Special Victims Unit was contacted by the Berkeley Township Police Department in reference to an incident that occurred at Central Regional High School. They advised that on January 12, 2020, a juvenile female was at Central Regional High School for an athletic practice. The victim reported that she needed to utilize the bathroom so she entered the girl's locker room via the "team room" door. Upon entering the locker room she immediately encountered the defendant, who was turning the corner from the aisle of lockers that is closest to the showers.

The victim advised that she saw the defendant's chest area and noticed he was holding something "white" in his hand and that his hands were in front of his genitals. According to the victim, no words were exchanged and she continued to walk towards the bathroom stall area which was on her right side. The victim stated that she immediately looked back and saw the defendant entering the area that leads to the showers. The victim advised that when she looked back she saw that the defendant was completely undressed and that she saw his bare legs, back and buttocks.

The victim stated she entered a bathroom stall and waited to see if she could hear the defendant leave the locker room. The victim stated she delayed for a few seconds before exiting the bathroom stall. Upon exiting the bathroom stall she washed her hands and left the locker room through the team room door. The victim returned to the practice and disclosed to her coaches what had occurred.

Video surveillance from Central Regional High School, showed the defendant attempting to enter the boy locker room, but did not enter. The defendant then entered the girl's locker room at which point he leaves the view of the camera. Approximately three to four minutes later, the defendant is seen in the "athletic hallway" and is fully dressed. Through video surveillance the defendant was identified as the individual who the victim encountered in the girls locker room.

Within the jurisdiction of this Court, the defendant did endanger the welfare of [REDACTED] by performing an indecent, immoral or unlawful act or deed, in the presence of a child, that may tend to debauched or endangered or degraded the morals of [REDACTED] specifically by being unclothed in the female locker room of Central Regional High School in the presences of [REDACTED] in violation of 2C: 24-4a(2).

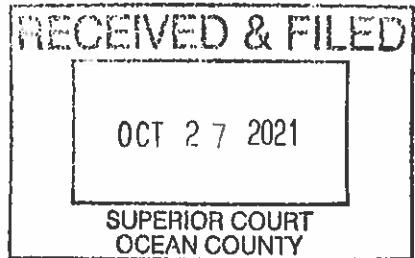

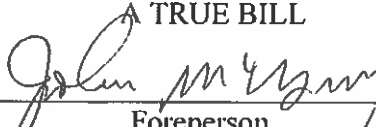
