Incident Report



On Friday, November 10, 2023, at approximately 23:04 hours, patrol units were dispatched to [redacted] for a report of a disturbance/altercation. Dispatch advised that a male subject pulled up to the caller's residence and was instigating a fight. The male subject used mace on the caller, and another subject on scene then left the scene in a black four-door Camry bearing NJ registration [redacted]. That vehicle came back to a Casey Longo out of [redacted].

Upon arrival, I met and spoke with the caller/victim, later identified as Joseph Scott, who advised me of the following:

Prior to officer arrival, Scott related that the above-mentioned vehicle pulled up in front of his residence. He stated that he heard shouting and repeated honking coming from the vehicle. Scott went outside to see what was going on, and that's when he encountered a male subject who was later identified as Maximilia Lombardo (the defendant). Scott relayed that Lombardo was initially in the driver seat of the vehicle but exited when he saw Scott walk outside. Scott stated that Lombardo was highly intoxicated and was yelling, insisting that he fight Scott's younger brother, Ayden Bryant. Scott advised that Ayden does not live at this residence anymore and that he tried telling Lombardo that. During the verbal altercation, the rest of the subjects who reside at [redacted] came outside to see what was going on as well. The other victim, Kristopher Sanborn, stated he went to get in between the two to break the verbal altercation up. During this time, Lombardo took out Mace pepper spray and began to utilize it on both Sanborn and Scott. Immediately after spraying the two in the face, Lombardo got into the passenger seat of the vehicle, and a female subject he was with got into the driver seat and fled the scene.

Further, I spoke to two other witnesses, Eric Rodriguez and Gregory Srsic. Both stated that they heard Lombardo screaming outside and that he was antagonizing everyone. They both witnessed Lombardo spray both of the listed victims in the face with pepper spray for no reason. Srsic advised that Lombardo has been showing up at his residence for the last several weeks, causing problems. He stated that Lombardo will show up unexpectedly and will damage the front yard and even egg the house. All parties on scene also relayed that their one neighbor came outside because he heard all the commotion coming from Lombardo.

Due to the above-described circumstances, Stafford EMS arrived on scene to attend to the victims and to help ease the pain caused by the pepper spray. Both victims refused further medical treatment at this time.

Moreover, patrol units searched for the vehicle that Lombardo came in but had negative results. The Barnegat Police Department responded to [redacted] but relayed that the vehicle was not there. Lombardo currently resides at [redacted] with his friend. Patrol units responded to that address, and Patrolman Caporrino spoke with the homeowner via the ring camera. She stated that she has not seen or spoken with Lombardo since this morning. She relayed that she would contact us when he arrived. Lombardo was unable to be located or contacted at this time.

I responded to police headquarters and contacted the Stafford Township court administrator, at which time an arrest warrant (1530 W 2023 000442) was issued for Lombardo. Lombardo was charged with the following:

Incident Report



On December 22nd, 2023, at approximately 16:18 hours, I was dispatched to the Stafford Police Lobby regarding a male individual inquiring about any warrants against him before the holidays.

Upon arrival, I encountered Maximilian Lombardo, who had come to the police headquarters to ascertain if there were any active warrants against him. Stafford Police Dispatch informed me that Lombardo had an active warrant from the Ocean County Sheriff's Department, originating from an incident in Manahawkin, NJ, on 11/11/2023, with the warrant number 1530W2023000442. Upon confirming this warrant, I proceeded to place Lombardo under arrest.

Lombardo was escorted to the rear of my patrol vehicle, where I applied handcuffs, ensuring they were securely double-locked. A search incident to arrest yielded no weapons or contraband. Subsequently, I verified the absence of potential hazards in the back seat of my patrol vehicle before placing Lombardo in the rear compartment of vehicle 3042 and securing him with a seatbelt.

Patrolman Marc Povlosky and I then transported Lombardo to the Ocean County Jail. Upon arrival, he was fingerprinted and turned over to the Ocean County Jail staff.
